THE NORTH v. SOUTH SCRAMBLE

In 1946, Graham Walker, then editor of Motor Cycling, sponsored, at the suggestion of the late Charles Markham, the first North v. South Scramble, and sportingly presented a Challenge Trophy, to be competed for annually by representative teams. The event is each year in two legs, one in the North of England and one in the South of England, and the side which aggregates the highest number of points at the two meetings in the year wins the competition. Today, the second leg of the sixteenth contest is being held, and each side will consist of one team, each having ten riders: there will be three separate races, with all members of each team competing.
