

INFORMATION

Conditions of Admission

Rules are made for the good of the competitor and must be strictly observed at all times. Please read your rule books.

Signing In

All Expert plus riders must sign themselves in to comply with insurance requirements. Those riders under the age of 18 must be signed in by a parent or guardian. Your licence must be produced upon request when signing on.

Novice / Beginner Riders

A novice schoolboy / girl must wear a yellow bib for his / her first 5 meetings. (This is also recommended for adult riders)

Fire Extinguishers

All vehicles carrying petrol stored in anything other than vehicles own fuel tank must carry a fire extinguisher suitable for use on all fuel fires. Minimum requirement is a 1.5kg dry powder or equivalent. All fire extinguishers must be clearly marked with rider's name, riding group and number.

Marshalling

Marshals are vital for the efficient running of the club and therefore it is important they know the rules and regulations and follow them accordingly. From the 2007 season all marshals must undertake a briefing session to obtain a certificate to marshal. Once this certificate has been awarded then no further briefing sessions are necessary (unless circumstances change) for that season. Only marshals holding a valid certificate can sign on to marshal or relieve another marshal from their duties.

Marshals are responsible for the safety of the track between their point and the next their duties include;

- BEING over 16 years of age
- ALWAYS looking in the direction that the rider is travelling
- MAKING sure that the next marshal point is clearly visible
- NEVER abandoning your point to assist a fallen rider
- RAISING the yellow flag in a motionless manner if a rider falls in your area.
- YELLOW flags warn other riders to proceed with caution and maintain their position.
- WAVING the yellow flag energetically if the incident is of a serious nature.
- RAISING the Red Cross flag if the rider appears to require medical attention.
- ONLY the person signed on (holding a current certificate) as a marshal is allowed on their point
- NO children or dogs on marshal points
- YOU are duty bound to advise unauthorised persons from entering the prohibited area and to inform the clerks or officials of any overtaking on yellow and/or course cutting incidents.

If you are booked in to marshal at a meeting and due to unforeseen circumstances you can no longer proceed with your duties YOU MUST INFORM THE CHIEF MARSHAL. If you cannot locate him/her then officials in the signing in trailer can inform him/her on your behalf.

Flags

Gentle reminder to ALL parents; please ensure your rider understands and is aware of the flag system and what they mean. Thank you.

Stopping a race

If a race is re-started after being stopped due to a fallen / injured rider, the rider who caused the stoppage may not continue within that race. He / she can then only take part in the following race if checked by the medics and their bike has been checked over where deemed necessary. Please remember a red flag means STOP; only continue around the track if instructed to by an official.

Booking in for future meetings

All riders must book in for each meeting in advance. Groups will close when full, 40 riders guaranteed to ride in each group. All visitors will be placed on a reserve list until booking in has closed; they will be contacted if there is a spare gate. All bookings are done on a first come first served basis.

<u>DOGS</u> – To ensure the health and safety of everyone at a meeting please ensure your dog is kept on a lead at all times and restricted to the pit area. Please also clean up after your dog. Thank you.

<u>Bad Language</u> — Bad language will not be tolerated whoever it may be directed at. We are a school boy club and therefore have a strong family orientated following. Bad language not only offends those it is directed at but those innocent bystanders unlucky enough to be able to hear it. Anyone found to be verbally abusive will be asked to return to their vehicle to cool down and may be asked to leave the meeting altogether.

Results – All results on the day, on the website and in the TMX are provisional and not fully checked. The 3 bonus points are only applicable to 3 block meetings (see rule book) the official results will be published in the following meeting magazine. Any queries should be addressed to the chief lap scorer only. Lap sheets are the ONLY OFFICIAL RECORD of the race.

<u>Changing Bikes</u> – Borrowed bikes must be of the correct cc for the group. Any change of bike must be reported to the chief lap scorer or no points will be allocated, this change must be reported before the start of the race
