





In race 1 Matt Gordon started off 3rd but gradually dropped to finish 7th which was by far the best, the next home was David Dunn in 11th followed by Aled Humphreys in 12th, Mike Allport was 19th and Adrian Bradley retired after a first lap prang. In the 2nd race Bradley had a flier coming round in 2nd place on the first lap eventually finishing in 8th place, followed by Gordon 9th, Humphreys 12th, Dunn 16th and Allport who retired with sprocket problems. In the final race Bradley again started well before the sand took its toll and again he finished 8th, Gordon rounded off a consistent day in 9th place, Humphreys 12th, Allport 18th, and Dunn 21st. Championship positions are still good for the British riders but the Dutch and Belgiums have closed the gap.




