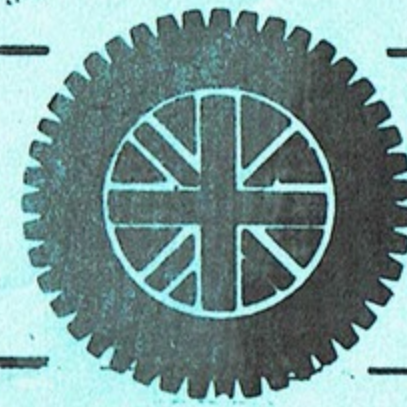

SUPER CLASS

The 3 remaining Super Class Championship races will be run at one event on October 2nd or 9th and will be by invitation only.

ONE DAY LICENCES

As from September 1st for the remainder of this season any One Day Licences issued on the morning of the event will cost £20. Anyone who applies through the A.M.C.A. Office in advance will still pay £15.

Most Groups do not issue One Day Licences on the day but for those who do a reminder that a rider can only have a maximum of 3.

Over 1000 - One Day Licences have been issued for this year, the Teignbridge Club near Exeter have gained quite a few new members through this system whereby a new rider can try the A.M.C.A. before joining a club.

SURVEY

Later in the year a check will be made to see how many one day licence holders actually do join a club after having taken a licence.

Several comments have been expressed that any former A.M.C.A. riders should not be allowed a day licence so no doubt this subject will be aired at the Association's Annual General Meeting later in the year.

I.M.B.A. 125 cc CHAMPIONSHIP

The 3rd round took place last Sunday (7th August) at Berghem in Holland, as usual the going was very sandy and the British lads found it very hard work. In race 1 Matt Gordon started off 3rd but gradually dropped to finish 7th which was by far the best, the next home was David Dunn in 11th followed by Aled Humphreys in 12th, Mike Allport was 19th and Adrian Bradley retired after a first lap prang. In the 2nd race Bradley had a flier coming round in 2nd place on the first lap eventually finishing in 8th place, followed by Gordon 9th, Humphreys 12th, Dunn 16th and Allport who retired with sprocket problems. In the final race Bradley again started well before the sand took its toll and again he finished 8th, Gordon rounded off a consistent day in 9th place, Humphreys 12th, Allport 18th, and Dunn 21st. Championship positions are still good for the British riders but the Dutch and Belgians have closed the gap.

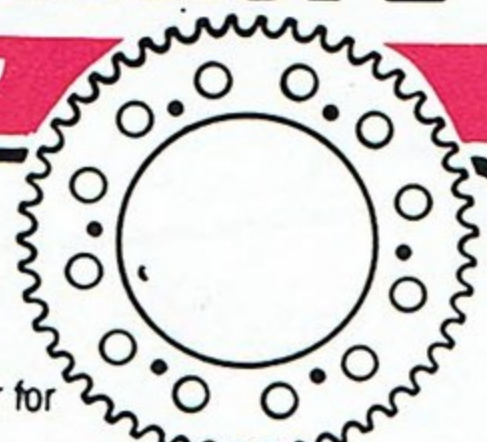

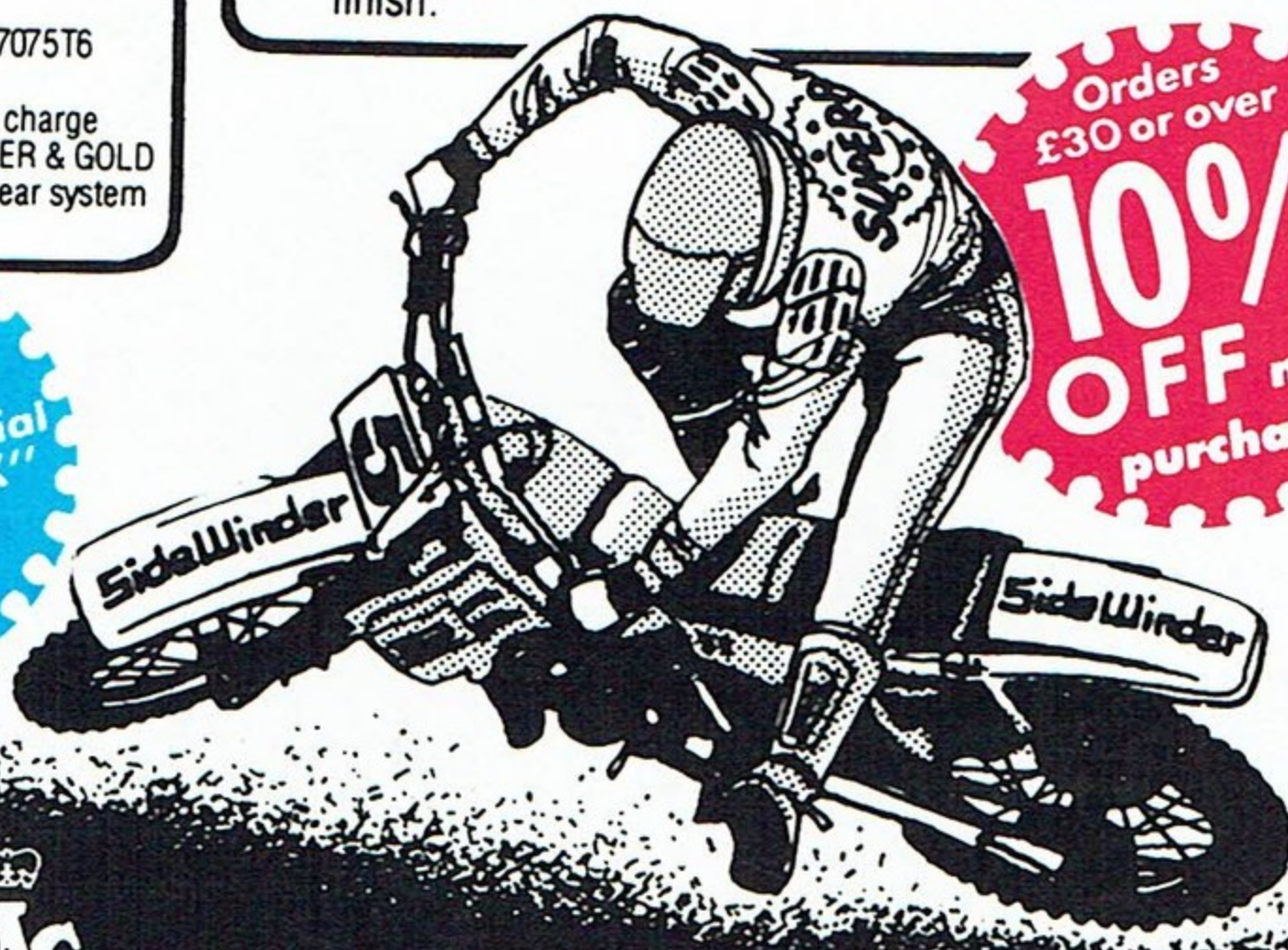
