Who makes this organisation tick, who sends these programmes along with the slickness of a card sharper, as smooth as oiled silk? primary responsible are: **Les Eaton**, Mr. Stock Car, over here he is a household name, where in these Isles, can one talk Stock Cars, without mentioning his name? Imagine talking Boxing without the name of Jack Solomons !!! The name of Les Eaton is now freely mentioned in such distant places as New York, Cincinnati, Adelaide, Melbourne, besides almost daily anywhere on the Continent. When you meet Les, you quickly realise that he is no ordinary man, he works, works, and works, literally eating the hours away, with all his problems and headaches, he remains calm, always ready to listen to drivers and officials, sorting out their problems as only he can. Realising that he has lost 10 or so minutes, which to you and I would represent an hour's work, he gets stuck in without more ado. If you arrive early, and notice someone with a hammer or a paint brush working against time, yes you are right, it's Les Eaton.

Roy Cecil, pipe smoking, cool, calculating, very efficient, Les relies on this man for the general running of the outfit. He is smooth, real smooth, never frustrated, give him a real teaser, such as Les may say, "Roy we are opening in Tokyo Monday evening," first reaction, light up the old pipe, then start phoning air lines etc., just routine, to Roy the impossible is just normal.

Jumbo Allen, Pit Marshall supreme, Starting Marshall, second to none. His presence sends everything along in top gear. You see this man starting every race, you also see him encouraging you to clap each winner on his lap of honour. But you never see him working in the confined space of the pits, controlling 45-60 cars, getting them lined up, nursing them like an old hen with her chicks, getting each one in the correct place, to be ready for the next race.

Dick Cotterill our scrutineer, he is truly a backroom boy, never taking the curtain, always with his head inside the cars, with his torch looking for snags to safety. He has to satisfy himself, and everyone, that each car is abiding by the rule book. Paying special attention to safety harness, roll bars, petrol tanks etc. When it rains, he always goes home with his backside soaking wet.

Gwen Cecil. Every promoter's dream, not in the romantic sense (Roy would see to that) but from the lap scoring angle. Stand near her when the race is on, you witness the greatest act of concentration ever. Try to speak to her, you get her elbow coming right into your ribs (I know, got any more strapping, please nurse !!) With nearly 100 meetings tucked under her belt (suspender?) she is the most capable lap scorer in the world.

Jack Holt. Steward, fearless but fair, the only man who would drop places to both Stan Ingle and Eric Taylor in the same race, this was done at Reading last season when our stars drove against the B.S.C.D.A. stars at Wimbledon, their steward declined the invitation to officiate alongside Jack. During the meeting, occasion arose to send off their captain, the fabulous Johnny King, to Johnny's credit, he went off, without a murmur, accepting the judgement as correct. Jack is known and respected wherever oil and wheels meet. He only accepts you, the public, as his boss.

It is with such a team that Spedeworth goes into action, today, it is being linked with other greats in the field of sport. The Mercedes team of the early fifties, Moscow Dynamos, Harlem Globe Trotters, Jack Kramer's Tennis Circus, perfectionists all, acknowledged by all.
