1. ENTRIES. Closing date for entries is first post on Monday, 10th May, 1948, and will only be accepted with the fee of ten shillings (10/-) to cover all classes. Entry fees will be returned in full to all competitors who come under the Starter's Orders, on application to the Secretary on the day of the Meeting. Competitors and Passengers will be insured by the Midland Centre's Insurance Scheme.

The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry.

The Club reserves the right to abandon or postpone the meeting or to modify the awards in a class for which there are less than six starters. If abandoned, entry fees will be returned in full.

- PASSENGERS. In passenger machine events the passenger must be carried throughout the event.
- 3. THE COURSE is roughly "Kidney-shaped" and includes left and right hand bends, a straight and varying gradients. It is approximately 700 yards per lap and will be marked out with flags. Riders deviating from the set course will render themselves liable to exclusion.
- METHOD OF RUNNING. Anti-clockwise. Heats and Finals of classes will consist of five laps standing start.
- 5. COMPETITORS. (a) Not ready to start when required will forfeit their run. Immediately the heat prior to their own has started, riders must report to the Paddock Marshal with their machines and then draw for starting stations. Riders neglecting to report will be excluded from their heat. No race will be held up for any rider or mechanic to effect any repairs after the first machine in the heat has left the paddock.

(b) Drivers and Passengers must wear an approved Crash Helmet and Protective Clothing during all practising and racing, for which they must make their own arrangements.

(c) Persistant "looking back" while racing may involve exclusion.

- 6. MACHINES may be ridden in any trim provided they have no spiked tyres or any other non-skid attachment and possess two efficient internal expanding brakes of not less than 5 inches diameter, operating on both wheels. The front brake to be operated from an accepted type of lever from the right handlebar, and the rear brake to be foot operated. Registration plates and lamps must be removed. Each machine may be ridden by one rider only in each class. Throttle control must be freely adjusted and self closing.
- 7. NUMBERS. All Competitors must come provided with three stiff black discs, two of which must be not less than 10 inches in diameter and the other one not less than 7 inches on which their riding numbers are to be painted in white. These discs must be securely attached, the smallest one in front of the machine not protruding above or exceeding the height of the handlebars, and the larger ones on either side, clear of all obstructions. Competitors retain the same number throughout the meeting. Competitors already possessing numbers should state same on entry form, and where possible will be allowed to retain same for this event.

In the paddock each rider may be accompanied by one assistant only. No ladies admitted to the paddock under any circumstances.

8. FLAGS. Competitors will be signalled by flags as follows:-

RED—Stop immediately.
GREEN—Course Clear.
YELLOW—Last Lap.
BLACK with NUMBER—Motor-cycle bearing that

-Motor-cycle bearing that number stop immediately

CHEQUERED—Finish.

PRACTISING will be allowed on the day of the meeting only, between the hours of 2 and 3 p.m.
