TRIALS - The summer trials are all held on Closed Circuit so bikes do not need to be taxed and insured. These events are designed to encourage the beginner and are usually held on a Saturday afternoon.

Midland clubs who have Trials Licence holders are sent entry forms but any A.M.C.A. Moto Crosser can ride as his licence covers both scrambles and trials. If you want to ride and your club has not received any entry forms two weeks before the event ask your Club Secretary to contact the A.M.C.A. Office for an entry form or entries will be accepted on the day.

Any Club who has a piece of land suitable for 10 to 15 sections and is willing to run an event can have help in laying out sections if they wish.

MOTOCROSS - RULE REMINDERS

Would Riders please note the following Rules

No. 111. BIBS

All Riders to have a numbered bib to use at meetings when the Clerk of the Course decides the conditions warrant better identification i.e. muddy or very dusty conditions. Bibs must have Black Numbers on White background. **NUMBERS BACK AND FRONT** and to be a minimum height of 6 inches.

No. 112. If the Clerk of the Course calls for bibs to be worn, riders will not be allowed to ride unless bibs are worn.

No. 129. RIDING IN THE PADDOCK is not allowed. Penalty will be that the offender marshals at two A.M.C.A. Scrambles before he may compete again. If the offender wishes he may ask for a personal hearing.

No. 130. No riding will be allowed off the track unless in specially roped off runs from the track. Engines will be stopped when pushing machines and there should be a roped off alley

for riders to the highest point in the paddock. Riding in this alley should be at walking pace.

No. 177. It is an offence to leave litter at an event, and will be considered an infringement of the rules.

No. 178. Any rider attending an event will be considered responsible for the vehicle in which he arrives, including any litter left by the occupants, even if the rider was not the driver of the vehicle.

No. 202. In the event of a Club cancelling a scramble and being unable to re-run the meeting then the A.M.C.A. will consider any claims towards any expenses which cannot be deferred such as advertising. The entry fees for such an event are normally returnable to the riders so any claims which the A.M.C.A. Executive or Racing Committee may consider justified would have to be met by the A.M.C.A. General Fund.

ENDUROS - The first Midland Enduro will be staged at Condoover, near Shrewsbury on Saturday 2nd July.

This event is open to any A.M.C.A. Licence holder and will include classes for Trail, Trial, Moto Cross, Enduro solo bikes and Sidecars and any three wheelers including A.T.C.'s.

The course will be about 3 miles in length and the event will last 5 hours with a break, all classes ride together and a special test will be included.

Scrutineering will be at 8.00 a.m. to 9.15 a.m. with the Start at 10.00 a.m.

Clubs with riders entering will be asked to provide marshals and the event will be the Midland regional qualifier for the A.M.C.A. Clubman Enduro final to be held in October.

Any rider who may have ridden at Matchams Park in the Southern Qualifier held on April 23rd can still enter for this

event.

Northern riders may also enter if they wish although a Qualifying event is hoped to be run in September in the North of the country.

Entry forms are available from clubs now and will close on Monday 27th June and the fee will be £5. for A.M.C.A. Licence holders and £10. for non A.M.C.A. Licence holders which includes Insurance.

SIGNALS START

Union Jack or Green Flag to be used for handicap events, all other races to have an elastic type gate or approved starting gate
Yellow flag with black diagonal stripes

COMMENCING LAST LAP CHEQUERED FLAG RED FLAG

(Finish) to be white with black squares.
To be used only for stopping races and all riders should then stop and cut engine.

YELLOW FLAG

Caution do not overtake but take extreme care there may be someone injured on the circuit.

BLACK FLAG

A rider signalled with a black flag should stop at once.

BLUE FLAGS

For directing riders off the course after the finish of a race and practice

TRACK CLEAR

At end of race. When travelling marshal is not used, recommended that the Yellow and Red Flags be held overhead in a crossed position

WHITE WITH A DIAGONAL RED CROSS

For attracting the First Aid to distant parts of the track
