With three rounds left in the Motor Cycle International Sidecar Championship the series is shaping up for a highly entertaining climax.

At the time of writing (before the Bank Holiday Monday round at Oulton Park), Jeff Gawley has a 10 point lead over our world sidecar championship hero George O'Dell. Although a big comedown from the excitement and tension of the world scene, George wants desperately to end the year with the Motor Cycle crown and so Jeff can expect a tough ride from his rival. But the title chase is by no means a two horse race. Just 10 points behind O'Dell is Bill Hodgkins. His form this season fully justifies his third ranking in the table and it would be no surprise to see him fighting it out for the cash at the end of the series.

Then in fourth spot we have Mick Boddice, whose fine performance in the wet at the Snetterton round brought him into the running. He holds a six point lead over Scottish pair Jock Taylor and Lewis Ward and behind them comes Dick Greasley, whose position is bound to improve before the end of the series.

Foreign contenders Rolf Biland of Switzerland and Sweden's Gote Brodin, have proved sensational in their limited appearances in the series. Rolf cake-walked the Post TT round and smashed the absolute lap record to pick up his five bonus points and Brodin hammered the opposition in the wet at the King of Brands meeting.

Joint seventh with our foreign friends is Brian Webb, perhaps the most improved driver this year who is a man to watch during the rest of the rounds.

HYVARINEN LAP RECORD 1 56.5 sec 74.58 MPH. 33

WELCOME to one of Britain's most exciting circuits and to Britain's most prestigious road race championship, the Motor Cycle News/Brut 33 Superbike series.

Our famous 'Supergirls' are here again to set the scene for what promises to be a thrilling duel between two works teams, the Suzukis of world champion Barry Sheene, Pat Hennen and Steve Parrish, and the Kawasakis of last year's winner Mick Grant and Barry Ditchburn.

The Kawasaki team's decision at the start of the season not to contest all the Superbike rounds gave the all-conquering Sheene a clear field to build up a healthy lead in the points stakes but now the green meanies have returned and will be out to prove that Sheene can be beaten.

Grant has two grand prix wins to his credit on the 250 Kawasaki and his team-mate Ditchburn is as good on his day as any rider in the land.

The twisty, narrow Oliver's Mount circuit is a great bike leveller and the incredibly quick 680cc Suzukis will have no great advantage over the better handling 750 three-cylinder Kawasakis on a circuit that is full of short straights and hairpins that test every rider's nerve in the braking stakes.

And it's nerve, courage and riding skill that will triumph at Scarborough and apart from those works riders there are plenty of men with the same qualities on private bikes that could make this race one to remember.

Roger Marshall is determined to be recognised as one of Britain's top riders and his recent signing by the works Honda team will give him the confidence boost that could see him dramatically improving the points total that put him in second place after the Snetterton round.

He will be out to beat that other man who rode a Honda at Silverstone, crowd favourite Ron Haslam. Ron is without doubt one of the most popular riders in Britain today and the special atmosphere at Scarborough with his fans urging him on will be as good as a ten yard start to the 21 year old charger from Nottinghamshire.

And there are still more riders who could be in with a good chance at the finish. Dave Potter, for instance on Ted Broad's Yamaha.

Or former works Suzuki riders John Williams and John Newbold. Williams, after some early season crashes has settled down to a consistent rhythm and could find the Scarborough circuit to his and his Yamaha's liking.

Newbold has turned in some impressive performances this year on one of the very few Suzuki 750-3s still racing, not least his third place overall in the F750 grand prix at Brands Hatch in July.

Two top riders not normally seen on a Superbike grid will line up on the Oliver's Mount start line.

Grand prix regular Chas Mortimer, who rode brilliantly at this meeting last year to win the 250 and 500cc races, is one, and the other is an intriguing prospect, Irishman Joey Dunlop. Still fresh from his Southern 100 win in the Isle of Man and at present ruling the roost on his home Ulster open road circuits, he will certainly find himself at home at Scarborough.

There it is. An impressive line-up of riders on a circuit that's full of surprises. Question is, who are the ones to be surprised today?
