ONCE a year the best 750 racers in Britain line up on what must be the most spectacular and hair-raising circuit in Britain for the Motor Cycle News/Brut Superbike race.

His sponsor, Ted Broad, was not in Britain to see Dave win the Superbike round at Donington Park but stands a good chance of a repeat here.



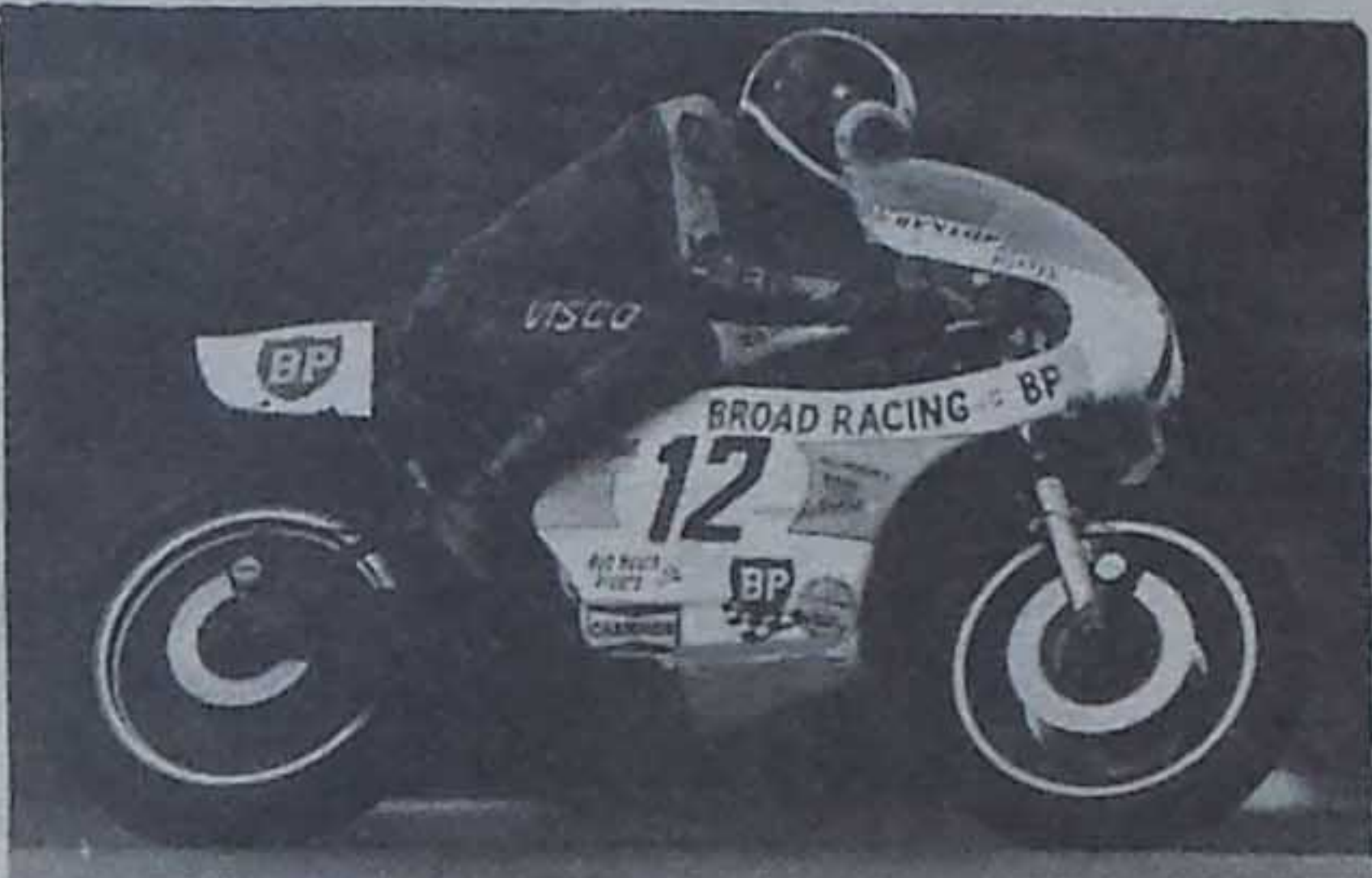
