ONCE a year the best 750 racers in Britain line up on what must be the most spectacular and hair-raising circuit in Britain for the Motor Cycle News/Brut Superbike race.

Oliver's Mount, Scarborough, is nothing more than a mountainside track so narrow and twisty that it provides the most dramatic kind of big bike racing possible.

It's incredible hairpins are adored by some riders but loathed by others. One man who revels in the Scarborough atmosphere is Yorkshireman Mick Grant, an evergreen favourite with his local crowd.

His preference for open road type circuits means he is always capable of pulling off a win against the daunting opposition of Barry Sheene and Dave Potter.

Sheene, on his 640 works Suzuki, is going for a fifth Superbike trophy and will also be out to prove a point to the crowd that booed him last year.

Joining he and Grant in a likely top three is Dave Potter, born in Yorkshire but now living in Orpington, Kent. Dave rides one of the best prepared and officially backed Yamaha 750s in Britain.

His sponsor, Ted Broad, was not in Britain to see Dave win the Superbike round at Donington Park but stands a good chance of a repeat here.
