





RACE DAY INFORMATION

HOSPITAL: For information concerning the nearest facility, consult Start/Finish.

INSURANCE: AFM riders are insured with a \$10,000 medical policy.

BENEVOLENT FUND: This fund is kept to help injured riders pay the \$100 deductible insurance. Donations are accepted at Registration or Scoring.

HELMETS: Must meet 1975 Snell Standard.

MINI BIKES: Mini bikes and dirt bikes are not allowed.

BIKE NUMBERS: Bike must display the number provided by the race secretary.

Riders not in compliance with this ruling will not be scored.

ENTRY REFUNDS: All refunds are for credit on future races. 100% no show.

PROTESTS: Must be filed in writing with the Race Director no more than 30 minutes after race.

BEER AND LIQUOR: Not allowed until after the final event of the day.

PRE-ENTRIES: North: 3601 Dumbarton St., Concord, CA 94519

South: 3051 Hillside Avenue, Norco, CA 91760

WHAT THE SIGNAL FLAGS MEAN:

GREEN: Start.

YELLOW, MOTIONLESS: Caution.

YELLOW, WAVING: Great danger, something blocking the track.

YELLOW/RED STRIPPED: Oil on track.

RED: Stop as soon as safe. Hold position until directed by race official.

WHITE W/RED CROSS: Ambulance or emergency vehicle on course (or impart area of track apron), proceed cautiously.

CROSSED GREEN AND WHITE: Halfway Point.

WHITE: Last lap.

CHECKERED: Finish.

BLACK: Complete lap and see starter. (Usually displayed with offending rider's number.)





SEARS POINT INTERNATIONAL RACEWAY

Sears Point Raceway is well known as a very difficult track. The 2.5 mile length includes 11 turns and slopes as steep as 15 percent grade. The longest straight is only 1100 feet and naturally leads into the slowest turn in the course, turn 11. It is a rider's course, not a horsepower track. It is also a good spectator course. Good spots to watch from include the top of the grandstands and the hillsides above turns 2 and 3 or above the esses (turns 8 & 9).


