**Black with number displayed** .. **Driver bearing that machine number to stop**

## NUMBERS

Regulation size. One in front, plus one each side, following colours:

125 cc - White on Black  
250 cc - White on Green  
350 cc - White on Blue  
351-500 cc - Black on Yellow  
Over 500 cc - Black on White

Make sure your numbers are readable - remember the lap scorers.

This competition is held under the National Sporting Code of the A.C.U., together with any approved Supplementary Regulations.

## RIDING IN THE PADDOCK

Once again attention is drawn to the serious consequences which could arise following an accident caused by unauthorised riding of any sort of machine in the Paddock.

All too frequently at meetings children are allowed to ride machines in the mistaken belief that because a race paddock is on private property and outside the jurisdiction of the Road Traffic Act, no insurance is necessary. It cannot be stressed too strongly that **liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owners of the vehicle and the driver.** (Or the parent in the case of a minor.)

The Union's insurers will quite legitimately repudiate any claim on them for damages arising out of the accident caused by an unauthorised driver.

## Crossing the Course

Under no circumstances should you cross the course whilst racing is in progress. At such points where it is permissible to cross the course, a marshal will indicate when it is safe to do so.
