

BOARD COMMENTARY

On Thursday 6th July the Southern Centre Board met at the Abbey Hotel, Romsey. The meeting was opened by the President and the Chair taken by the Centre Chairman. There were 12 officers and 44 delegates present representing 21 clubs. Not quite so many as usual but the meeting went on a bit late.

Under Matters Arising from the Minutes of the last meeting the following items were discussed:

A letter was read from the Bourne Club stating their views on the 'Non-return of Entry Fees Saga' — they feel the Board has acted somewhat harshly.

Southampton & District objected to Bridport running on 30th September. Bridport (in letter to Centre Sec. read at the meeting) asked for 2nd September (also a Soton & Dist. date). As time was short Centre approved Bridport running on this date subject to All Clubs concerned giving their approval.

Under Correspondence:

Centre Boundaries. Wessex still wish to annex part of our western area. Southern Centre have asked A.C.U. for meeting between them and both centres to allow Clubs concerned to put their points of view forward.

Keevil Road Races for 15th July cancelled.

Sunbeam Club asked permission to run Graham Walker Run at Beaulieu on 12th August and a Trial on 4th November. Both approved.

Gosport Club has not yet received money from Centre promised for cancelled Trial.

Basingstoke Grass Track 14th October cancelled.

North Berks Grass Track date changed from 26th August to Sat. 11th August. Report of alleged unofficial practising at Long Velley. Clubs in area asked to make spot checks and note names or numbers.

North Hants complained of non receipt of results of Farnham Mason Cup Trial. Farnham delegate replied that a lot had gone astray in the post. They were still available from Sec. of Meeting.

A.C.U. asked for return of Rally Trophy.

A.C.U. not received affiliation fees from Southern 67 Club. Sec. to write to Club.

Suspension. A. Burdett of Basildon one month from 15th July. 2nd offence.

REPORT OF SCRUTINEER PANEL MEETING

Helmets. Complaints that A.C.U. transfers wear off Scrambles and Grass Track riders helmets very quickly. 'Pudding Basin' helmets are OUT for all speed events; there is no exception for riders in 'Old Timer Events'. BS1869 standard must be worn.

Number Plates. Scrutineers should check side and front numbers for legibility and class colours.

Clubs are asked to provide covered accommodation for scrutineers wherever possible.

Grass Track Sidecars. Present rule needs to be more specific. It was hoped to include drawing in Gazette of what was and what was not allowed. A.C.U. Grass Track Committee to be asked to look again at rule.
