

BOARD COMMENTARY

The Sixth meeting of the Board was opened by the President, Mr. Joe Caslake.

The minutes of the previous meeting were signed. During Matters Arising, Mr. Lambert stated that he did not agree with the manner in which the Board had dealt with the non return of entry fees by the Bourne Club. He felt that the Finance Committee should have continued to deal with this matter. He had also contacted the Club, who said they would attend the meeting, but no Bourne Club member was present. There had been no reply to the Secretary's letter. Mr. Gale wished it recorded that he was against the decision.

Roll Call revealed 13 Officers, 53 Delegates, representing 23 Clubs were present.

- 1. Jurisdiction: Held under the G.C.R.'s and S.R.'s of the A.C.U. and the Standing Regulations for Grass Track racing of the Southern Centre together with the following Regulations.
- 2. Eligibility: Open to registered members of the Southern Centre Clubs.
- Course: A Grass Track circuit approximately 600 yards. Chicane for Sidecars. Solo's to run anti-clockwise. Sidecars to run clockwise. The Clerk of the Course can change the course at his discretion.
- 4. Laps: All Solo and Sidecar races will be over 4 laps except the finals of events 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9 which will be over 6 laps.
- 5. Practice: Controlled practice will take place between 12.30 p.m. and 1.30 p.m. and drivers must complete 2 laps to qualify. No machines to be started before 12.25 p.m.
- 6. Starting: Clutch start by elastic gate or flags. Any driver not on the starting line within two minutes of his number being called will be excluded from that race. Warning to drivers Any driver who deliberately breaks the starting tapes will be excluded from that race.
- 7. Entries: To be made on the official form and sent to the Secretary of the Meeting. Opening date 7th July; Closing date the first post on the 18th July. S.A.E. for reply. Entry fee will be 30p for Sidecar and Solos and all drivers and passengers and people in competitors' cars will be charged 35p admission to the meeting which will include a Programme. - 1. Jurisdiction: Held under G.C.R.'s and Standing Regulations for all trials of the A.C.U. and the following Supplementary Regulations.
- 2. Eligibility: Open to all members of the Southern Centre riding solo machines. Intermediates will be classed as Experts.
- 3. Entries: To be sent to the Secretary on the form provided, accompanied by the fee of 60p (which includes P.A. insurance cover), and 2 LARGE S.A.E.'s. Entries will open on 1st July and close on 7th July. Entries will be limited to 40 in each class.
- 4. Venue: Will be at Maddoxford Farm, Botley, Hants (signposted off the Botley/Winchester road A3051).
- 5. Course: Will be approx. 1 mile and is on private land. Any rider exceeding an average speed of 24 m.p.h. will be excluded.

Novices to ride one session of 12 laps approx. starting at 1.00 p.m. Experts to ride one session of 20 laps approx. starting at 3.00 p.m.

- 6. Numbers: Competitors must provide front number plate, black on white, numerals 6" x 3½" with 1" stroke.

Should the Clerk of the Course decide to stop a race in the interests of safety then that race will be re-run.
