- Jurisdiction:** Open to registered members of clubs affiliated to the S.C. A.C.U., organised under Permit No. U743 to the S.C., subject to the G.C.R.'s and Standing Regulations of the A.C.U., the S.C. Speed Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.
- Course:** Grass Track circuit incorporating an 'S' bend for sidecars only, approximately 500 yards in length. Solos to run anti-clockwise, sidecars clockwise.

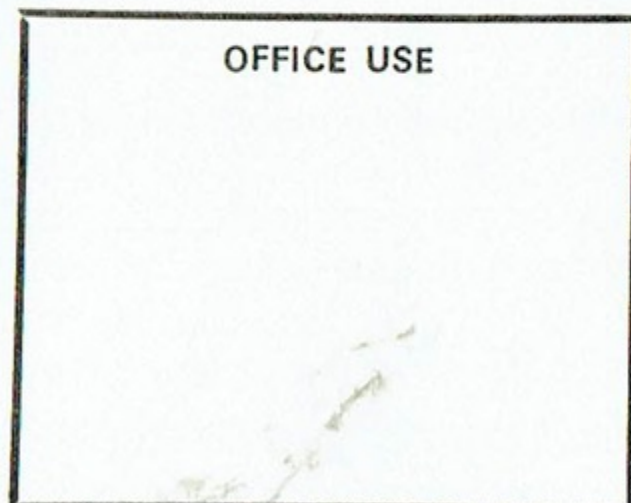

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:

- Announcement:** This event will be run in two stages: stage 1 observed only; stage 2 time and observed and is open to all members of Clubs affiliated to the Southern Centre riding Solo machines.
- Jurisdiction:** Held under the G.C.R.'s and the standing regulations for all Trials of the A.C.U. and these supplementary regulations.
- Entries:** Will open 7th May and close 26th May. A Fee of 70p and two S.A.E., Foolsap size. Entries limited to 90 riders.
- Course:** Approximately 2 miles in length, consisting of 10 sections. Any rider exceeding an average speed of 20 m.p.h. or deliberately course cutting will be excluded.
- Venue:** Is Weavers Down, Longmoor, signposted from A325 Greatham area and A3 Liphook area.
- Penalties:** Stage 1: 2 laps of 10 sections, 0, 1, 2, 3, 5, marking. 2 hr. limit. 2 marks per minute late to a maximum of 30 marks. Course closes 15 minutes after last riders due in time. Stage 2: A number of laps (to be shown in Final Programme) over same 10 sections, widened. Marking 0, 3, 5. Bogey time will be 2 hrs. 2 marks per minute late.

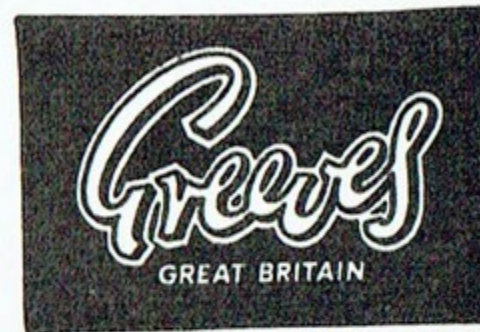

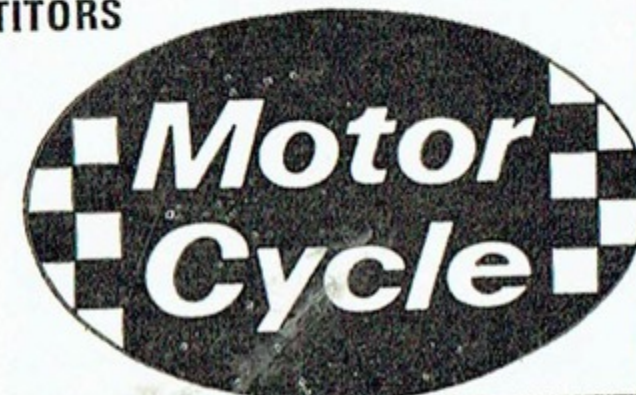
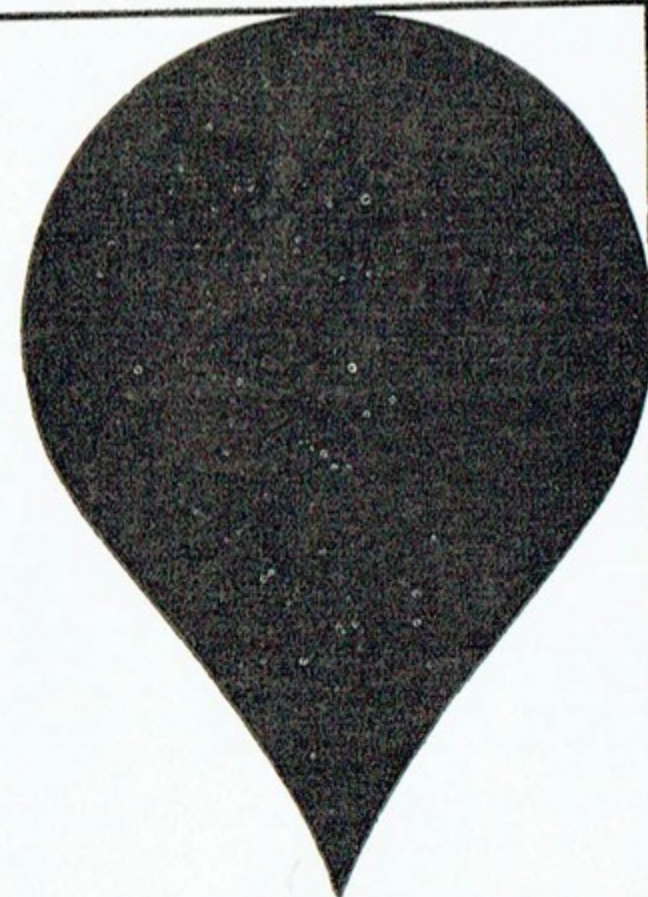
