

BOARD COMMENTARY

The August meeting of the Southern Centre Board started with the President calling for one minutes silence in memory of the two riders killed in the sport recently. There were 13 officers and 54 delegates representing 25 clubs present.

UNDER MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

No further applications for return of entry fees from cancelled Bourne Event will be accepted by Centre.

Chairman reported a verbal ruling from A.C.U. on Schoolboys. They need not be members of affiliated clubs and under 16's need not be included in club membership lists for A.C.U.

No further development on issue of National Licences to Novice Scramble and Grass Track riders.

A.C.U. proposals to align Centre boundaries with new county boundaries now includes our northern boundary. It was suggested that the Wallingford area be swapped for Swindon area.

North Gloucs Club cancelled August Road Race Date due to Keevil no longer being available for racing.

No further development reported on alleged practice in Long Valley area. Southern 67 Club had already paid its affiliation fees in May.

The St. Pauls Trophy Grass Track had to be cancelled as Gosport had lost the course. The promotion of the event is once again open to offers from Clubs.

UNDER CORRESPONDENCE

Wimborne Club have decided not to run any further speed events without a doctor present. Referred to Comps Committee for their comments. Cambrian Council asked for Centre support to A.C.U. to run ISDT in Wales this year. N. Goss stated no actual request had been made by FIM for the event to be run in this country this year. Board decided that it would support the Mid Wales Club's application to run the event next time it was this country's turn.

Clubs reminded that A.C.U. 3% levy is subject to V.A.T. Post card type form must be used when sending in this levy.

A.C.U. proposed to send copies of New Letter to Club Secretaries and asked if any other Centre officials required copies. Board to request it be sent to all Stewards and Scrutineers.

A Notice must be inserted in all race programmes reminding riders of the serious consequences that could occur through unauthorised riding in the paddock area. Liability for any accidents are the responsibility of the owner of the vehicle and the driver (or the parents in the case of minors). A.C.U. insurance does not cover any accidents or damage caused by an unauthorised rider.

ADDITION TO ALL RACE PROGRAMMES

The Union's insurers have once again drawn attention to the serious consequences of allowing unauthorised riding by small children in the paddock and other areas at meetings and refer to a recent accident to a child who suffered serious head injuries. It can not be stressed strongly enough that liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owner of the vehicle and the driver (or the parents in the case of a minor) and the union's insurers could quite legitimately repudiate any claim arising out of an accident caused by an unauthorised driver.

ALL clubs must place a notice to this effect in the programmes and be on the look out and stop this practice at once before another serious accident occurs.
