

FOREWORD

Although only introduced three years ago the popularity and interest of the 250 c.c. European Championship series of Grand Prix Moto-Cross events now certainly equals the older established 500 c.c. Championship Grand Prix. This is hardly surprising when it is remembered that, on the Continent, the 250 c.c. machine has almost entirely replaced the larger capacities, and even here in Great Britain, the stronghold of the 350 c.c. and 500 c.c., the rapid increase in its numbers is very noticeable. Tradition dies hard with us in the motorcycling world, but the power of the modern "250" puts it on a par with the "500's" of very recent years.

Particularly is this noticeable on the moto-cross courses of Europe and the phenomenal power outputs now being obtained, allied to the lighter weight of the bicycles, make the performance of the machines you will see in action to-day something at which to marvel. Particularly pleasing is the fact that British engines, both two-stroke and four-stroke, in this class have been developed to a pitch where they compete successfully with the best of the continental products, although it is only comparatively recently that our manufacturers have really begun producing 250 c.c. engines for the job in hand.


As regards the riders, these we have always had, and, although the continent also has superb riders with very "winning ways" I believe that our boys, given equal machinery and with the usual modicum of luck without which no sport is complete, need not fear unduly the foreign competition. We have assembled here to-day riders from 8 different countries, each one chasing the crown of the 250 European Championship for 1960, and it is with anticipation of keen international racing that we look forward to what should prove a memorable day's sport.

The organisation of this, one of the major events of the British motorcycling calendar, is the culmination of months of planning, ably handled by the Ipswich M.C. & C.C. on behalf of the Auto-Cycle Union. It only remains for fine weather to prevail here at Shrublands and the success of the day will be assured.
