<u>Directions to Canada Heights</u>: Postcode for SatNav BR8 8DX. From the M25 Junction 3, take the Brands Hatch signs onto the A20 (note: not the M20). Straight on at the 'Teardrop Centre' roundabout, then turn next left into Button Street, signposted Swanley Village. Please drive slowly down Button Street, it is narrow and there are blind bends. Canada Heights is on the right side, nearly one mile from the A20.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Signing on will be in the container on the left at the top of the hill. YOU MUST SIGN
 OFF, even if you retire early. YOU MUST SHOW YOUR 2011 A.C.U.
 MEMBERSHIP CARD WHEN SIGNING ON.
- 2. Start time for the first three riders is 09:30am. Bikes will be scrutineered as you come to the start. Rider number 1 will go to Section 1; number 2 to Section 6; number 11 to Section 3. Subsequent numbers will go to sections 1, 6 and 11.
- 3. Three laps of 15 sections will be covered Experts (Adult and Youth) using WHITE cards, Intermediates (Adult and Youth) using BLUE cards, Novices using RED cards.
- 4. MARKING WILL BE <u>TSR22A STOP PERMITTED</u> rules. It is your responsibility to read the 2010 ACU Handbook page 200 and 201 to understand the rules.
- 5. There is NO BREAK between laps one and two. ALL SECTIONS WILL CLOSE PROMPTLY AT 3:30pm, so if you do have a break, don't be too long!
- 6. Don't forget you score 10 FOR A MISSED SECTION. Don't miss any sections awards have been lost by riders not realising they have by-passed one or two sections!
- 7. SPECIAL NOTE if, for any reason, you decide not to tackle a section, DO NOT JUST RIDE AWAY. Tell the observer who will mark you down as a "5", which is better than the 10 you would get if you don't say anything!

 Also your Secretary of Meeting spends hours going through observers cards looking for possible errors because no points are recorded at one or two sections in an otherwise completed course.

Please Note: NO MACHINES are to be ridden before any riders start time. Engines may be warmed up, but NO RIDING except by the shortest route to the start area.

Refreshments and toilets will be available all day.

Welcome to the 2011 Freestyle Sidcup Sixty

elcome to the seventy-fourth running of the Sidcup Sixty Trial – first held eighty years ago in 1931. Many thanks to Freestyle of Mark Cross, East Sussex for once again sponsoring our biggest trial of the year.

We are pleased to be hosting the first round of the South Eastern Centre 2011 Trials Championship and for the first time at Canada Heights including the Expert Elite class. Maybe having Championship rounds in the Sixty has attracted more riders than last year, or maybe it's a sign of good financial times ahead!

The Sidcup Club is honoured to have for the first time riders from two brand new South Eastern Centre clubs, Estuary Off Road and Hookwood Trials. There are riders from twenty other SE Centre clubs established a lot longer ago and seven from other Centres.

Sidcup Sixty Champion, **Ben Wibberley** is back to defend the Youngs Cup he won last year, but faces the might of the Freestyle Sherco riders, Simon Bird, **Adam Farley**, **Thomas Moss** and up from Youth Elite, **Mark Cottingham**. Two other previous winners are back this year; the 2004 winner **Richard Ely** and **Kevin Morphett**, whose success was way back in 1985.

All fifteen sections will close at 3:30pm, which will give around five and a half hours for riders to complete the three laps. Please don't spend too long studying sections or chatting during the day – observers will be told to call riders into the section, and there is a 5 mark penalty for not doing so when called!

This year we are using **TSR22A** rules for marking in sections. Stops are permitted, but no backwards movements – the 2010 ACU Handbook pages 200 to 201 tells you what you can and cannot do.

Although Sidcup puts on more trials than any other motorcycle sport, our trials membership is very small. However, things are improving with seven Sidcup riders in this year's Sixty, the highest number for many years!
