Directions to Canada Heights: Postcode for SatNav **BR8 8DX**. From the M25 Junction 3, take the Brands Hatch signs onto the A20 (note: **not** the M20). Straight on at the 'Teardrop Centre' roundabout, then turn next **left** into Button Street, signposted **Swanley Village**. **Please drive slowly down Button Street**, it is narrow and there are blind bends. Canada Heights is on the right side, nearly one mile from the A20.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Signing on will be in the **BARN** at the back of the paddock.
2. **Start time for the first 3 riders is 09:30am. Bikes will be scrutineered as you come to the start. Rider number 1 will go to Section 1; number 2 to section 9; number 3 to section 15. Subsequent trios of riders will go to those same sections.**
3. Two laps of 20 sections will be ridden – Experts use **WHITE** cards, Intermediates (Adult, Over 40, Youth) use **BLUE** cards, Novices (Adult, Over 50, Youth) use **RED** cards. Variations for Elite Experts will be shown with black crosses on white cards.
4. **MARKING WILL BE TSR22B – NON-STOP rules. It is your responsibility to read the 2018 or 2019 ACU Handbook to understand the rules.**
5. **There is NO BREAK between laps one and two, but if you do have a pause, don't be too long!**
6. Don't forget that you score **10 FOR A MISSED SECTION**. Don't miss any sections - awards have been lost by riders not realising they have by-passed one or two sections!
7. **SPECIAL NOTE** - if, for any reason, you decide not to tackle a section, **DO NOT JUST RIDE AWAY**. Tell the observer who will mark you down as a "5", which is better than the 10 you would get if you don't say anything!

Please Note: **NO MACHINES** are to be ridden before any riders start time. Engines may be warmed up, but **NO RIDING** except by the shortest route to the start area.

Refreshments and toilets will be available all day.

Welcome to the 2019 Sidcup Sixty Trial and many thanks to James Burroughs of Body Clinic for sponsoring our biggest trial of the year.

For the second year, we have accepted 144 riders, but this year, that number was reached before Christmas – that's never happened before! We used Facebook to appeal for Observers for the 20 sections, and it looks like the power of Social Media has worked. Other clubs should perhaps make a note!

The 2018 winner, **Sam Connor** is back to try for an eighth win and a Hat Trick. However, the 'Young Guns' are massing, as two of the eight Expert Elites are in their teens and three in their twenties. It will be a battle of Youth versus experience – the latter being headed by 11-time Sixty winner, **Ashley Newbery**.

The only other previous winner of the Youngs Cup who is riding in 2019 is 5-times winner, **Gavin Cooper**, now in the Expert class. Gavin won in 1986, then 4-times in a row from 1993 to 1996. The only other rider to string 4 wins in a row was **Gordon Jackson** back in the 1950s and 60s.

Having the on-line entry system means that I can analyse the entries. This year, no less than 82 riders are over 40, with 61 of them over 50. Kent is home to 65 riders, and 19 have come over the bridge from Essex, just beating the 18 from Surrey and 15 from Sussex. Long-distance awards go to Experts Adam Juffs from Derbyshire and Matthew Dixon from Leicestershire. Welcome to Canada Heights to you and all first-timers here.

Have a good day at Canada Heights.
