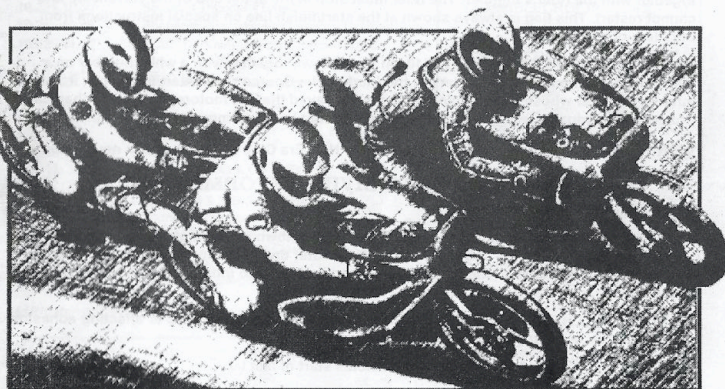

Important Notice FLAG SIGNALS USED AT ALL NEW ERA EVENTS

FLAGS GIVING INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

RED FLAG OR RED LIGHTS: The Race or Practice is being interrupted for safety reasons. Riders must immediately cease racing and return slowly to the Pits, or as directed by the Marshals acting on the instructions of the Clerk of the Course.

YELLOW FLAG: Danger on this section of the track. When shown motionless riders must prepare to slow down. When shown waved, the danger is imminent and riders must slow down and be prepared to stop. In both cases overtaking is forbidden up until the point where the green flag is shown.

BLACK: This flag is designed to convey instructions to one rider only and is displayed together with the rider's number. The rider must stop in the at the end of the current lap and cannot restart. This flag is always shown at the start/finish line on special instructions from the Clerk of the Course.

BLACK WITH ORANGE DISK (40 cm dia.) Shown together with a white number on a black signalling board, on the orders of the Clerk of the Course at the start/finish line, it informs the rider whose motorcycle number is displayed that his motorcycle has mechanical problems likely to endanger himself or others, and that he must immediately leave the track.

WHITE FLAG: This flag is not applicable to New Era Club Meetings and is never used.

FLAGS & LIGHTS GIVING INFORMATION

UNION JACK: Start of a race.

GREEN: Course is clear of all hazards. This flag is shown on the first lap of each practice session, on the sighting lap and the warm-up lap. After the last yellow flag, the green flag will be shown motionless at the following flag marshal's post to indicate that the circuit is now clear ahead.

YELLOW WITH RED STRIPES: Oil, water or another substance is affecting adhesion on this section of the track.

YELLOW WITH BLACK CROSS: Denotes start of last lap.

BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED: Finish of Race or Practice session.

SLOW MOVING VEHICLES ON THE TRACK

In accordance with ACU Standing Regulations, the NEW ERA Club **NEVER** despatch an Ambulance, Fast Intervention Vehicle (FIV), or any other slow moving vehicle on the track whilst Practice or Racing is taking place on any part of the circuit. If such a vehicle is required on the circuit, the Red Flags are first displayed and the race or practice brought to an actual & effective halt before the vehicle is deployed.

EXCEPTION: Stationary or moving Ambulances, Fast Intervention Vehicles, Recovery Vehicles and the like, may be encountered anywhere on the circuit when riders are despatched from the Assembly Area on their "Sighting Lap" to the Startline prior to the start of a race. This "Sighting Lap" is not considered to be either Practice or Racing and riders must always be prepared to encounter such vehicles. When such a vehicle or vehicles are on the track the Yellow Flags will be displayed in the appropriate section of the course.

New Era SuperClub at Silverstone

Seven rounds gone and still four to go in this year's New Era Superclub series and the pressure is now very much on for the championship hopefuls.

Even Sean Baker (Yamaha), who tops the Formula 600 class by a clear 54 points, knows it is far too early to relax. There are still 200 points to be won and injury or mechanical problems in just one of the four meetings could let the opposition closed that lead down.

For interested neutrals this event at Silverstone is one meeting, like Oulton Park and Donington Park that has extra appeal. There is no one in the line up who can claim superior circuit knowledge and in fact there are riders deeply involved in the championships who may not have raced here before.

Darren North (Suzuki) is Baker's closest rival but he is one of five men still in contention.

North is in sparkling form with four wins and two seconds to his credit from the last six races. He will be just a little more nervous than usual arriving at Silverstone, because he is first reserve in a packed, single-race Formula 600 event.

By the law of averages he will almost certainly get his races in, because someone will not turn up or hit problems in practice. But I would bet that he would prefer to be sure of his start, than just hoping.

One point behind North is Brian Bartlett (Yamaha) and provided it does not rain he will add a

bucket full of points to his score.

Rick Ellis (Honda), Rob Barber (Suzuki), James McBride (Suzuki), Shaun Sinnott (Yamaha), Duncan Burns (Honda) and John Dieterman (Yamaha) have all won championship races already this year and none will not give up hope of winning the series till it becomes mathematically impossible.

Phil Bevan, the Welshman with his rapid 996 Ducati is looking even better in the Sound of Thunder championship. He has a 110 points lead over Jamie Poole (996 Ducati), with Julien Stock (996 Ducati) third, ten points further down.

That pair will not let Bevan have an easy time and to the serious opposition you can add Paul Newton, who notched a couple of second places in the opening round at Mallory Park.

Leighton Walker (250 Suzuki) has just graduated from university and says that he can now concentrate more on winning the Formula 400 Superclub series.

That could be bad news for the opposition, because Walker already has a 76-points lead over the rest, despite only having won two of the 12 races so far.

Walker is fast and consistent, though. He has finished in every race and only once, at Snetterton earlier in the year, did he finish out of the top three, when he was fourth over the line.

Lack of consistency has been the downfall of his closest rival, Sean Carrison (400

Yamaha) who has failed to score three times and includes a 13th and an eighth in his tally of 151.

Dave Alsop (400 Yamaha) is one point behind Carrison and still very much in contention.

Add Matt Doughty (250 Aprilia), the fast, stylish tall racer from York and Darren Cook (400 Yamaha), who has scored 106 points in the last six races and forecasting the outcome becomes difficult.

Series leader Steve Kuenne (Honda) and the men second and third in the standings on their Hondas, Ian Parkin-Coates and Ian Brookman seem to be the only men in with a real chance of taking the 250GP crown.

The three have won all twelve races between them, with Kuenne taking nine of them.

But Kuenne has failed to finish twice and the others have been very consistent, which is why the gap between first and second is only 43 points, with Brookman another 28 points adrift.

That small a lead is something Richard Murphy, who tops the 125GP class, does not have to worry about.

The rider from the Isle of Man is 100 points ahead of Steve Wrathall, 270 to 170, thanks to a remarkable run of six wins and six second places.

Unless Murphy strikes cruel misfortune that class could be one of the few where the title could be decided early.

Stephen Thompson, who tops the Honda CB500 points' table, is another who might be able to start clearing a place on the mantle-piece.

He has scored in every round and won all but two of the races. He holds a 60-points advantage over Jonathan Harrison, who

fed up to the back-teeth with chasing Thompson home.

Beating him here at Silverstone would help take the pain away, even if it does not affect the eventual outcome.

At the time of writing Dijon Compton has not entered the Hornet class.

He badly broke his thumb in practice at the recent Snetterton double header and saw his lead disappear as he missed four races.

He was back in action in the last round at Oulton Park and closed the gap between himself and new leader Tim Booth, who has a 17-points lead.

If Dave Joyner can get back to his best form, he, Mark Cronshaw, Ashley Joice and Michael Nibblett could yet play apart in the final outcome.

But it is the Pro-Bike Open series that looks the most likely to be a nail biter to the final round.

The lead has swapped around several times this season, but Jonathan Lester (750 Suzuki), who led after the opening round at Mallory Park, is back on top of the standings after Oulton Park.

He grabbed a second and a fourth place at the Cheshire to push Craig Fitzpatrick (1000 Suzuki) down to second in the points.

Only seven points separate the pair, with Greg Lewis (1000 Yamaha) third, 35-points behind Lester.

But all three must be peering over the shoulders to see what Peter Baker (1000 Suzuki) can do.

Baker has 134 points, 62 less than Lester, in a season he would like to forget about. Remember, though, there are 200 points still to be won in every class. Everything could still change.

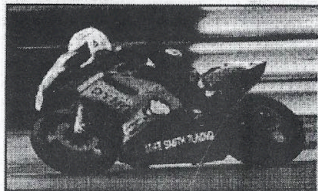

At the very successful opening round of this Bikesport News supported Championship at Brands Hatch on Sunday 22nd June, a number of Formula 600 riders were invited to join the Pro-Bike Class in New Era's Open Grand Slam race. As a result of this the Club has decided to open the race to more Formula 600 riders in future rounds. A separate 600 Cup will be added to the list of end of season awards if sufficient interest is shown.

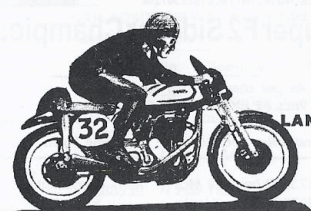

Welcome to the 5th and penultimate round of the 2003 Lansdowne Classic series and the heat for the top championship positions has really been turned up.

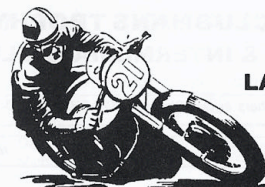
