



THE MELLANO (HUTCHINSON) TROPHY. The Club's oldest challenge trophy from which the meeting derives its name. Presented by A. V. Mellano, Esq., the cup will be awarded to the B.M.C.R.C. driver making the biggest improvement on his handicap times in events 7, 8, 9 and 10.

Originally presented to the club in 1925, the cup was competed for at Brooklands from that year until 1939. On the close of hostilities, Brooklands passed out of the possession of Motor and Motor Cycle Racing interests but the good old Hutchinson Hundred race has carried on having been held at Dunholm, Lincoln in 1947 and 1948 and at Silverstone in 1949, when it was won by H. B. Ranson, and in 1950 by Cyril Smith on a sidecar outfit.

THE A.M.C. CHALLENGE TROPHY. Presented to the Club by Associated Motor Cycles Ltd. To be held for one year, with replica for retention—to the winner of Race 9.

THE AVON TROPHY. Presented to the Club by the Avon India Rubber Co. Ltd. To be held for one year, with replica for retention—to the winner of Race 7.

THE WATSONIAN ANNUAL TROPHY. Presented to the Club by R. G. J. Watson, Esq. To be held for one year with memento for retention, and awarded to the sidecar driver gaining the highest number of points for performances at race meetings and hill climbs organised by the B.M.C.R.C. throughout the current year, including and terminating with this meeting.

THE RICKARD TROPHY. Presented to the Club by K. Rickard, Esq. To be held for one year, with replica for retention. For the best performance by a private owner who is a member of the B.M.C.R.C. The final decision in making this award to rest with the committee of the B.M.C.R.C.

THE CLUB CUP. Presented by B.M.C.R.C. To the winner of event 5—350 c.c. 5 lap scratch race.

THE BEMSEE CUP. Presented by B.M.C.R.C. To the winner of event 1—125 c.c. 3 lap scratch race.

THE MINNIE GRENFELL MEMORIAL TROPHY. Presented by J. Granville Grenfell, Esq. To the B.M.C.R.C. rider gaining the highest aggregate number of marks for wins or places in certain races that are named each year by the B.M.C.R.C. 




