Final Instructions

The paddock will be at the top of the hill, with signing on in the container on the left.

The trial will consist of **THREE** laps of **13** sections per lap - provided we get sufficient observers.

Sections will be clearly numbered - please make sure you visit each one on all three laps. Because of the "compact" nature of Canada Heights, awards have been missed by bypassing a section by mistake.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- No machines are to be ridden before that rider's actual start. Engines may be started for warming up, but NO riding, except to the start by the shortest route.
- All riders must wear crash helmets while riding between, and in sections.
