

Directions to Canada Heights: From Junction 3 of the M25, take the Brands Hatch signs onto the old A20 (note, not the M20). Straight on at the "Teardrop Centre" roundabout, then turn left 300 vards later into Button Street, signposted Swanley Village. Canada Heights is on the right after one mile.

Final Instructions

The paddock will be at the top of the hill, with signing on in the Barn.

The trial will consist of THREE laps of 14 sections per lap. ODD numbered riders will start from section 1: EVEN numbered riders will start from Section 8. One odd and one even rider will start each minute.

Sections will be clearly numbered - please make sure you visit each one on all three laps. Because of the "compact" nature of Canada Heights, awards have been missed by bypassing a section by mistake.

elcome to the first running of the Dick Dickenson Trial, also the umpteenth running of the Simmons Cup Trial. Last years trial was held just after the death of our friend, clubmate, and trials enthusiast Dick Dickenson. 'His' trial was always the Simmons Cup, so it was an easy decision to rename it in his memory.



We want to retain the 'Simmons Cup' in the title as it was the first trial open to other clubs run by the Sidcup Club way back in November 1929 - just seven months before Dick was born!

That first Simmons Cup Trial started from "The Wings of the Morning" Filling Station, Wrotham Hill, the site of which is now probably buried under the M20.

The Dick Dickenson Trial begins the Sidcup Club's annual run of trials. A Wobblers on 22nd November is followed by the Jack Thompson British Bikes Trial on 6th December and the 79th Sidcup Sixty Trial on 17th January. With our summer Evening Trials, club members trials and the Timber Woods Long Distance Trial, we run far more trials than any other sports. And we are still largely considered as a motocross club!



Open to all riders on (almost) any bike. Not difficult sections - no observers ride each section until you get it right! **Enter on the day at Canada Heights**


