

## **Final Instructions**

- The paddock will be at the top of the hill, with signing on in the Barn. .
- The trial will consist of THREE laps of 13 sections per lap. Two riders will start each minute and will be directed by the starter either to Section 1 or Section 7.
- Sections will be clearly numbered please make sure you visit each one on all three laps. Because of the "compact" nature of Canada Heights, awards have been missed by bypassing a section by mistake.

elcome to the second running of the Dick Dickenson Trial, named in memory of of Sidcup's Trials 'guru' for many years until his death in 2014. He was on the Sidcup Committee for 28 years, of which fifteen was as our Trials Secretary and four as Club Chairman.



The Simmons Cup Trial was the first 'Open' trial run by the Sidcup Club in 1929. There had been a few Club trials and a hill climb in the Club's inaugural year of 1928, but the minute book shows that the Committee decided there were insufficient funds to buy awards for an 'Open' trial that year.

By early 1930, the Club's bank balance had reached £30-10-2d, that's £30.51 in today's money. The Club Treasurer then absconded with the whole lot and the President made a generous donation to restore the full amount! Fat chance of that happening if the present balance disappeared in 2016!

Today's trial is the 19th event of 2016 run by the Sidcup Club - just two trials to go as well as an Awards Presentation Evening! That's an average of one event every 16.6 days!
