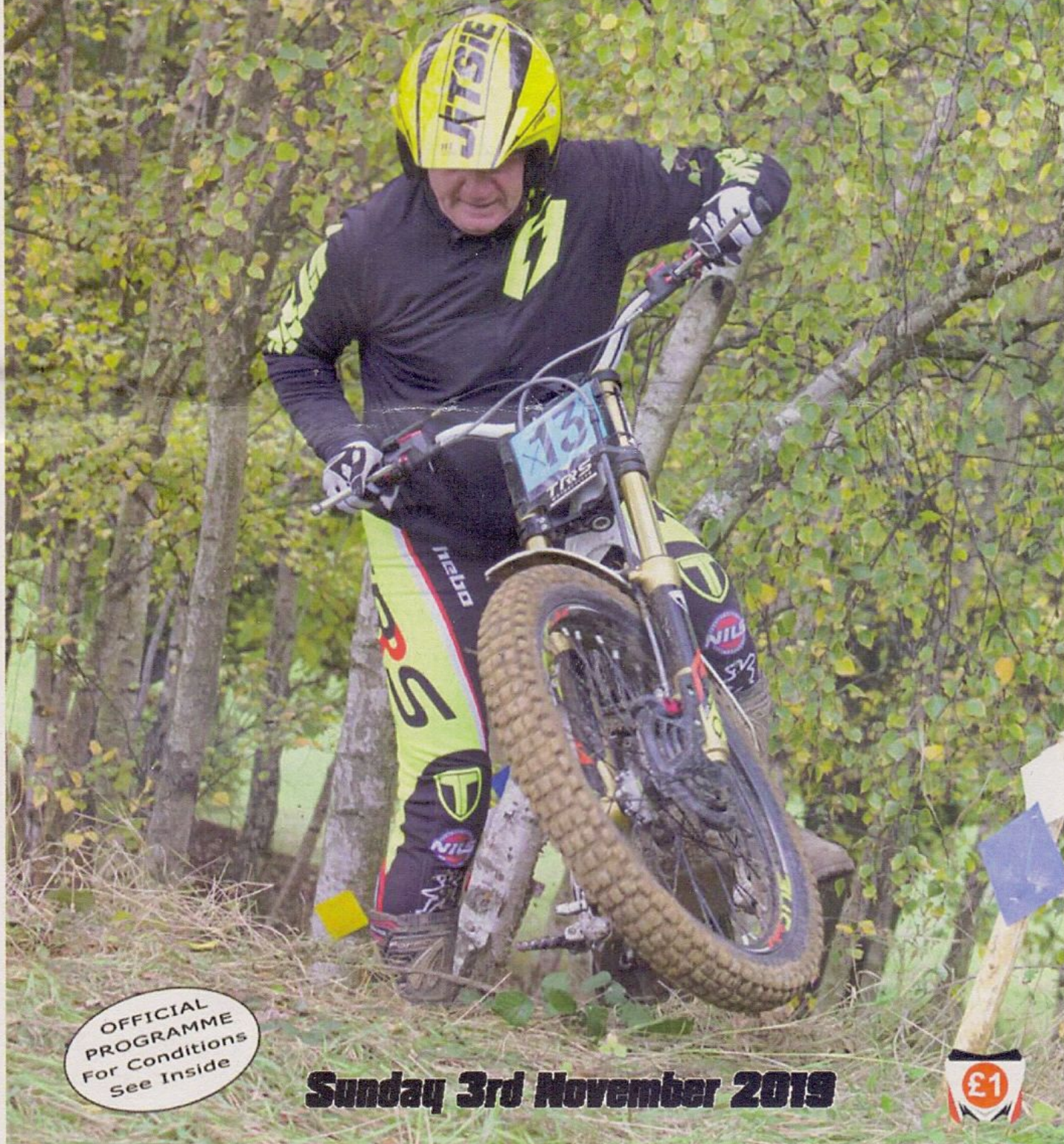

Straight on at the "Teardrop Centre" roundabout, then turn left 300 yards later into Button Street, signposted **Swanley Village**. Canada Heights is on the right after one mile.

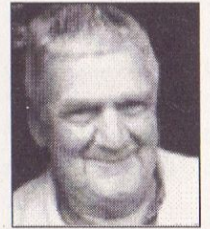

**Final Instructions**

- The paddock will be at the top of the hill, with signing on in the Barn.
- There will be **THREE** laps of **14** sections per lap. Two riders will start each minute and will be directed by the starter either to **Section 1** or **Section 8**.
- Sections will be clearly numbered - please make sure you visit each one on all three laps. Because of the "compact" nature of Canada Heights, awards have been missed by bypassing a section by mistake.
- Machines are not to be ridden before that rider's start. Engines may be started to warm up, but **NO** riding, except to the start by the shortest route

**W**elcome to the fourth running of the Dick Dickenson Trial for the Simmons Cup, named in memory of Sidcup's Trials Secretary for many years until his death in 2014.



The first Simmons Cup Trial was almost exactly 90 years ago, in 1929 and just 9 months before Dick was born! The start was the "Wings of the Morning" filling station on Wrotham Hill.

The Club Bulletin of October 1929 states that many observers are needed and all who send their names to the Secretary will receive their card, route card and map by post, but they must report to the start on their way to their sections. Strangely, the following Club Bulletin makes no mention of the trial and no programme exists, so the winner will forever remain a mystery.

The second Simmons Cup Trial in November 1930 started from the Lion Hotel, Farningham. The entry fee was 4/6d (22½p), with teams of 3 for 6 shillings (30p). Invited clubs were Bexleyheath, Owls, Greenwich, Sydenham and Erith.

In more recent Simmons Cup Trials, Dick Dickenson would spend days at Canada Heights planning and setting out sections. On many occasions he would be accompanied by his friend from the Erith Club, Lou Roberts. Sadly, Lou died two weeks ago at the age of 85. The Sidcup Club will continue Dick and Lou's good work in running our trial for the North Kent Trials Combine.
