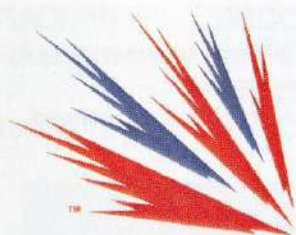

## FLAG SIGNALS

**Blue/ Steady:** Another competitor is close.

**Blue/Waved:** Another competitor is trying to pass.

**White:** Service vehicle or very slow moving car on circuit.

**Yellow/Steady:** Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down.

**Yellow/Waved:** Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down and be prepared to stop.

**Yellow with Red stripes:** Slippery surface ahead.

**Green:** Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared. Also shown at marshals posts to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions.

**Red:** Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals.

**Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number:** Warning of mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. Call into pits immediately.

**Black/White Rectangular displayed with White number:** Warning to driver that his behaviour is suspect and he may be black flagged.

**Black displayed with White number:** Driver must return immediately to the paddock and report to the Clerk of Course.

**Black and White Chequered:** End of race.

**National Flag:** This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

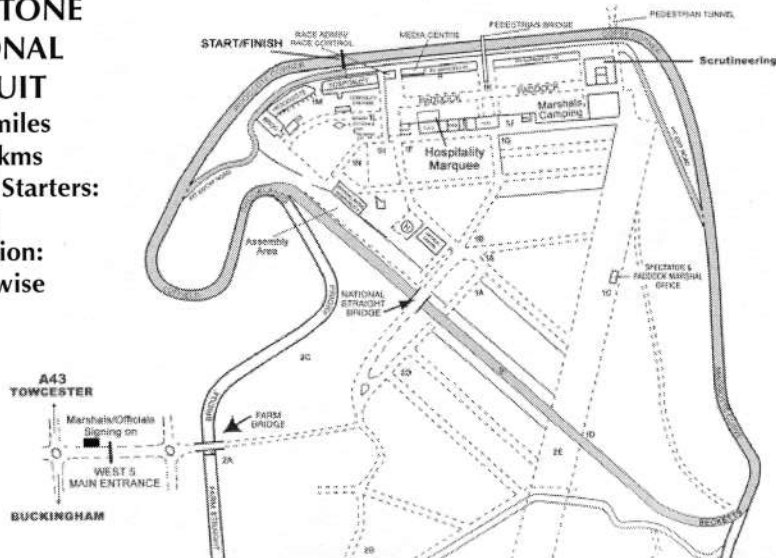

# TODAY'S RACING



## Varied Field - and Power

BOTH ENDS of the power range feature in this weekend's programme organised by the British Automobile Racing Club, South Eastern Centre.

At the lower extreme are the massed ranks of the Citroen 2CV racers boasting a massive 602cc each and at the other Kevin Clarke's VSR Mercedes powered by its raucous 5,700cc Ford V8.

Between these the BARC has attracted a truly varied field out to enjoy one of the final circuit race meetings of the year.

Each day features races for Silverstone Race School, organised by the BARC on behalf of Silverstone Drive. Saturday's races see graduates from recent four-day intensive courses for drivers.

Silverstone Drive is an ideal stepping stone for drivers wishing to move up from karting and for those starting afresh. The drivers have spent their time learning race craft from experienced racers and have proved themselves fit to take to the circuit in competition conditions.

Sunday sees a round of the BRDC Winter series for drivers in 1800cc Formula Ford Van Diemen and Zeus cars.

Starting the racing action on Saturday are races for a variety of Caterhams. The bottom

rung of the of the Caterham ladder of success is the Caterham Academy which introduces newcomers to the sport with sprints at a variety of venues before moving onto races.

Most Caterham racers have started on this path and four of those who have taken part in the Academy this year are out in the Roadsport categories preparing for next year's races.

Moving up from Roadsports to Superlight next year are Darren Ashley and John Gaw who are running with the successful Arrowstar team.

Hero of the Weekend Award will perhaps go to Caterham Graduates Club Chairman Graeme Smith who is tackling all seven races open to him: two Caterhams; three 2CVs and two Saloons and Sports Cars races.

Citroen's little 2CV is probably the most unlikely of racing cars, but they always put on the best of entertainment in either the BARC-run 2CVParts.com championship or the AVO Endurance Championship.

The 2CVParts.com Championship has now been decided in favour Pete Sparrow ahead of Gary Adnitt and Wayne Cowling and it is

no surprise that these three are also at the top of the Endurance Championship, although this is headed by Ainslie Bousfield who normally co-drives with Gary Adnit.

This weekend's two Challenge races and One-Hour Endurance race have attracted all the leading contenders and so we can expect some close racing in all three events.

There is a real treat in store on both days for fans of Saloon and Sports car racing. Saturday sees a packed grid covering a wide variety of machinery.

The entry has been separated into classes based on known, or expected, performance on Silverstone's National Circuit and it should result in some good battles for class honours.

Power against nimbleness will feature on Saturday with John Gaw and Pete James in Caterhams expected to give the grunt of Kevin Clarke's VSR, Rod Birley's turbo-charged Escort WRC and Kenneth Blair's Pro Motorsport-run Sierra Cosworth something to think about.

Kevin's Mercedes look-alike is one of three VSRs racing with the BARC SEC for the first time. VSR cars, built by Sonny Howard's SHP Motorsport organisation, have a tubular space frame chassis with a Kevlar/fibre glass body. They run in two classes, the V8 using either Ford or Chevrolet 5.7 litre engines and the V6 utilising a Ford 2.9 litre unit.

Joining Kevin are two of the V6-engined cars in the hands of

Mark Turicky and this year's Champion Steve Dance.

Pro Motorsport are also making the trip from Scotland worthwhile by giving 16-year-old Derek Palmer his first car race outing in one of their Ford Fiestas.

It is also good to see some of the BARC's friends from the Classic Touring Car Racing Club joining the fun.

Among the weekend's entry are some of the most interesting Classic Saloon cars racing, such as Pete Hallford's mighty 5-litre Chevrolet Camaro and Tony Crudgington's Triumph Dolomite Sprint.

Joining the grid for Sunday's race will be Bob Ross in another Escort WRC who will be looking to have a repeat of his success at Brands Hatch last weekend when he carved through the field from the back to finish second to Rod Birley.

Many of the saloon cars are also taking part in the final rounds of this year's BARC SEC Formula One Motorsport Saloon Car Championship.

Unless anything goes seriously wrong over the weekend the title looks to be safe in the hands of Birley who recently notched up his 350th race win.

The Formula One Motorsport contenders will run alongside the All-comers cars and then the results will be reclassified.

## 2CV Racing - Big Thrills, Small Bills

2CV circuit racing started in the UK in 1989 with the first event at Mallory Park.

In 1990 a full season of races was run including the 24 hour race at Mondello Park in Ireland. The 2CV Racing club has gone from strength to strength, currently has over 70 registered racing members and full grids are the order of the day.

There are two types of events run, Sprints which are around 15 laps and endurance races which generally last one hour and include a driver change.

The 24 Hour race at Mondello Park in Ireland remains the jewel in the crown. Anyone interested in racing should have a go at this, it is truly infectious.

The cars are stripped out, lowered and stiffened. The minimum weight including the driver is 630kgs; entrants with a pie

fetish are immediately disadvantaged.

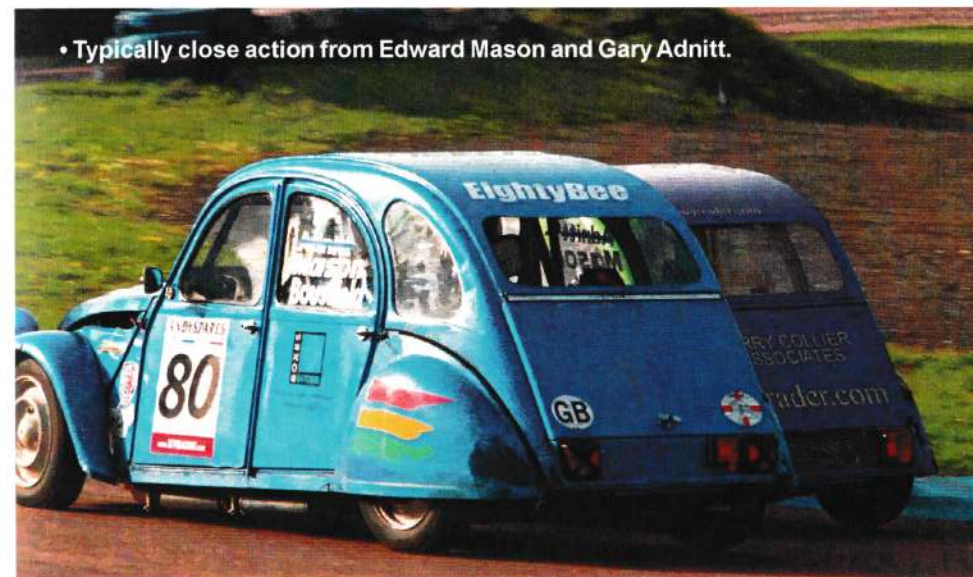
Gearboxes and brakes are standard while engines can have their compression ratio increased and heads ported. Otherwise they are standard. Top speed is limited by the supersonic shock wave to around 90mph.

The relatively slow speed makes for extremely close racing and generally there is more overtaking per lap than in a whole season of Formula One.

As well as the normal awards for the podium positions, a special "Glenfiddich" Award is presented to the driver who makes up the most places during the race. The 2CV Racing Club also provide a "Marshal of the Day" award.

So, expect fierce battles throughout the field from the "best of budget motorsport."

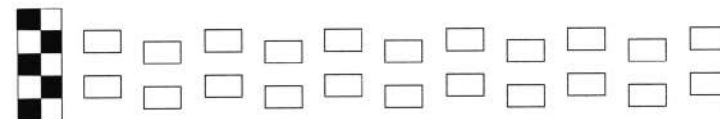

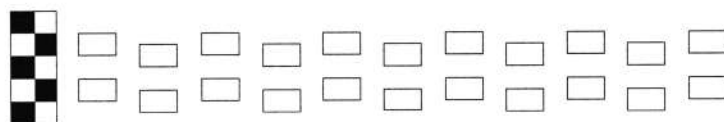

**Almost 90 years ago - on December 12 1912 to be precise - a group of cyclecar enthusiasts gathered at the Hut Hotel, Wisley, in Surrey to compare notes on their machines.**

Cyclecars (virtually four-wheeled powered cycles) provided the real enthusiasts motoring of those days, and the group decided there and then to form the Cyclecar Club.

The Hut Hotel was demolished in 1978 to make way for the old Portsmouth Road improvements, but the little acorns sown that day sprang into the mighty oak that is today's British Automobile Racing Club.

The Cycle Car Club was soon to become the Junior Car Club, racing at Brooklands and elsewhere in Britain, organising foreign tours and generally looking after the interests of the enthusiast. Brooklands was to play a big part in the BARC's childhood and adolescence, as the JCC was destined to merge with the Brooklands Automobile Racing Club to become the modern day British Automobile Racing Club.

The BARC's past is mile-stoned with all the great races at Brooklands, Donington, the Goodwood Formula One and Formula Two meetings, the British Grand Prix at Aintree and Crystal Palace.

Brooklands was its first home, Goodwood its

second and, since 1968, Thruxton its third. Housed in its headquarters at Thruxton the BARC now oversees race meetings at all the major circuits in the country and now runs the majority of the rounds of the British Touring Car Championship. In addition the club officiates at the highly-successful Goodwood Festival of Speed and the Goodwood Revival Race meetings.

In addition national race meetings are run throughout the country alongside sprint and hill climb championships in the hands of the successful network of local centres.

In 1955 the original South Eastern Centre was formed. Over the years a number of developments took place culminating in the formation in 1977 of the highly-successful London and Home Counties Centre.

**Recent years have seen the Centre spread its geographic area of activities and January 1st 2000 saw the Centre revert to the name South Eastern Centre to better reflect this.**

This year the Centre has organised three race meetings, four rallycross events and co-organise a sprint meeting with Sevenoaks and District MC at Lydden Circuit; organise two sprint meetings at Goodwood Circuit; and organise three championship sprint and four race meetings at Silverstone.
