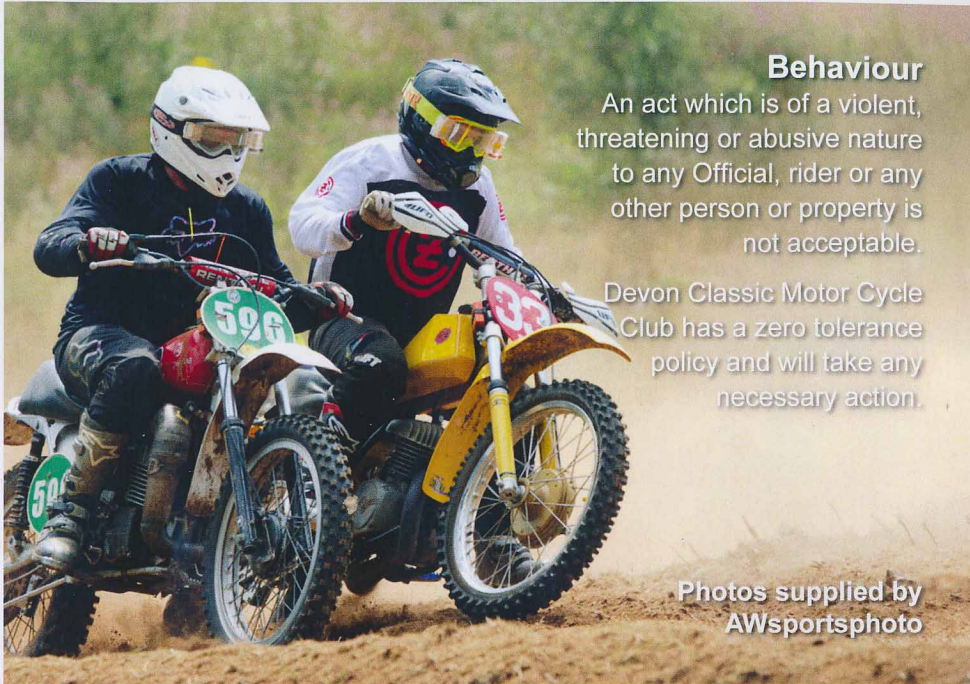

WELCOME ONCE AGAIN TO THE SMEATHARPE FLYER

Just a recap on the inspiration behind the name. It relates to the activities of the brave men and women who were based around, and flew from, Smeatharpe (RAF Upottery) during World War 2.

The airfield was opened in 1944, and was used by the USAAF and the US Navy. It was from here that, on the 6th of June 1944, The East Company of The 506th Parachute Infantry Regiment 101st Airborne Division made their first combat jump into Normandy. Later, the airfield became used as a transport airfield, and as a base for antisubmarine patrols.

In 2001, these events were depicted in the acclaimed TV mini-series "Band of Brothers".

Our own John Heal has a strong connection as his father, Mr Harold Heal, was involved in the construction of the both the Smeatharpe Airfield and the Dunkeswell Airfield.

The land is now owned by Mike Spiller and his family, and it is with their kind cooperation that we are able to present to you this event today.

We have a full line-up of Twin shock motor cycles and riders, plus the older classic machines, for your enjoyment. We also have a novice class for those who don't wish to race, but want to experience riding their bikes around a proper track.

Devon Classic would also like to draw your attention to our next meeting here at Smeatharpe. It will attract the best Classic riders from all over the country - some of which, we are proud to say, hail from here in the South West.

We have been invited to host the "Jubilee Classic Masters" event, incorporating the AMCA Classic Club Trophy.

This event on the weekend of the 10th & 11th September is part of the British Classic Motocross Championship Committee's project to enhance and improve the British classic championship from 2023.

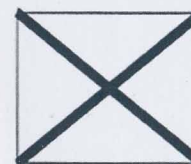

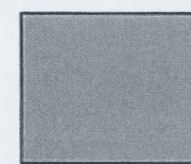

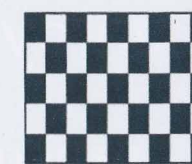
