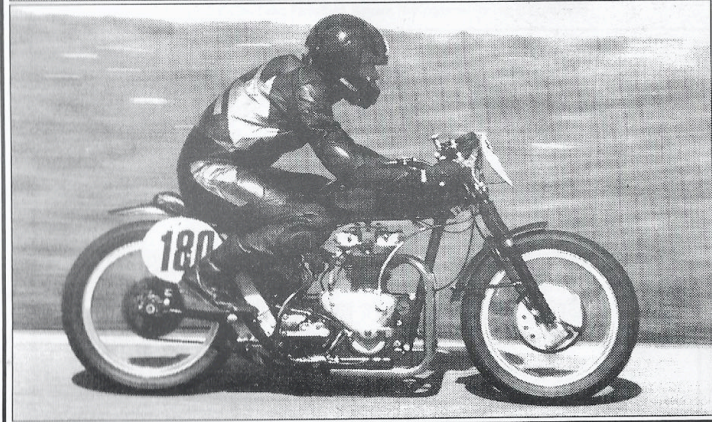
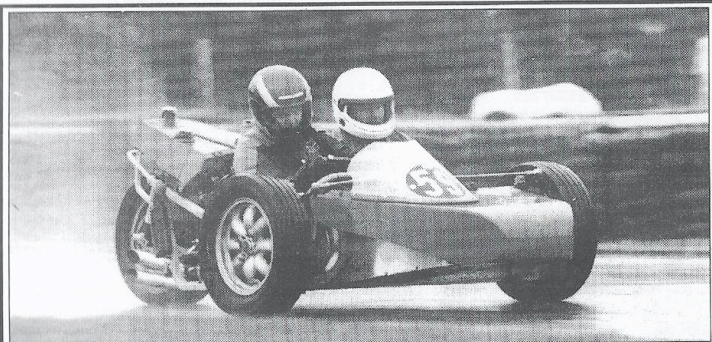

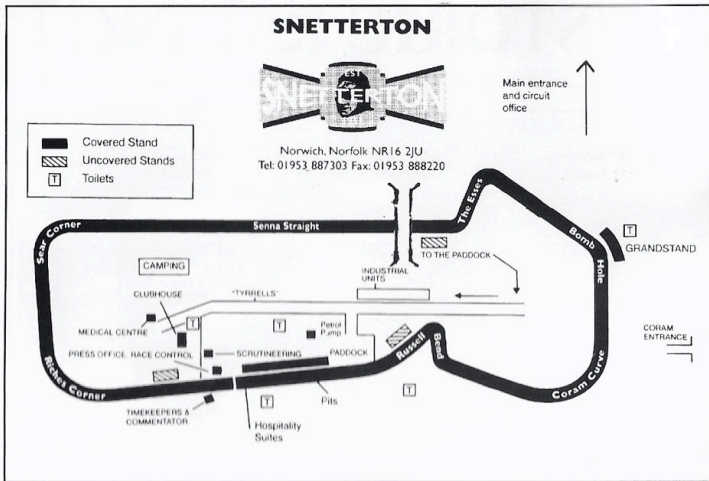

## RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS

Welcome everyone to what looks to be a very interesting and exciting meeting. With the season now under way following our Easter start at Mallory Park the riders have now started to sort out any teething problems they have had with their machines and should now be ready to fight hard for their championship points.

The Historic Racing circus did not have a meeting here at Snetterton last year, so riders will need to refresh their memories as to where the braking and acceleration points are to give them the maximum advantages against their fellow competitors.

Let's start by having a look at the championship standings so far after the first round at Mallory Park.

In the Tuers Garage Championship it was Tim Johnson taking the win in both rounds with Toby Smedley hot on his wheels. In the M.A.N Flying Systems Championship for Formula Bantams Mike Powell took the flags with Peter Tibbitts finishing second.

In the Old Bike Mart Championship John McMahon lost vital points when he was involved in an incident on the first race but managed to win the second, but again Toby Smedley was there again to take first in the first race and settled for second in the second race. The Edwards Christiansen Championship for the 250's saw last year's championship winner Stu Noble take both firsts with Ray Hemming close on his tail taking two second places. It will be interesting to see if places are reversed at all in these races today.

The Ossie Neal Championship ( event 8 ) saw Nick Weston and passenger Kerry Williams also take two wins. In the Consort Ltd Championship which was also on the circuit at the same time as event 8 it was Paul Kent and passenger Karl Webb that took two wins and Paul Tutchter and Martin Watkinson had to settle for two seconds.

In the Bennetts Championship Paul Wade took two chequered flags giving him a few points clear over Mark Capewell. In the GB Motor Company Championship any one of four riders will stand a chance today as both rounds at Mallory had different riders down to fourth. Some are here today others are not so this championship will possibly be clearer after today. The Dresda Autos Championship had first and second places in race one different to those in race two. Len Homer is in first place having taken a first and a second and Martin Page and Cliff Ransley in joint second place. Stu Tonge and Phil Jobbom should be joint leaders of this Championship after reversing their results with both of them gaining a win and a second place.

The Janic Antiques championship saw the Morgans battle together with Bill Tuer and Maggie Tuer take two wins from Greg Bibby and Katie Bain. In the Big Shots Championship John Butcher took both wins and has put a few points between him and the second man.

The Peremps Recruitment Partnership Solo Champion of Champions race ended up being ran in the rain, but this did not seem to bother Tim Johnson as he started at the back of the grid with all of the other competitors starting before him with time handicaps. He managed to work his way through the field to take the chequered flag.

The Bonham & Brooks Sidecar and Three-wheeler Champion of Champions race was won by Bill and Maggie Tuer.

Sadly, though time was against us due to the weather and we were unable to run the Norvil Motorcycle Championship for the Novice riders. This will not be rerun at another meeting as we cannot guarantee the same riders being present. Sorry guys!

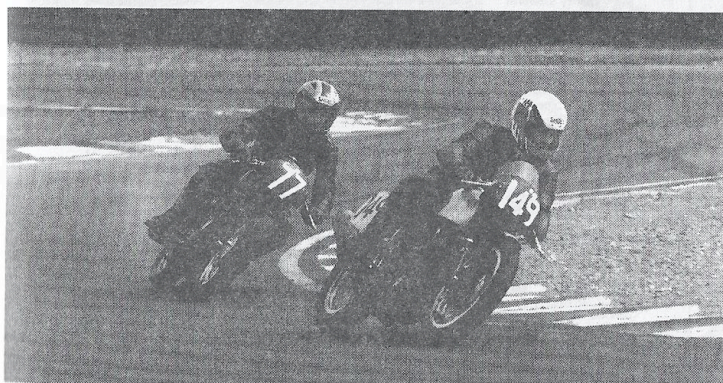
Spectators, please feel free to wander round the paddock and admire the machines. A lot of time and money goes into keeping them going and keeping them looking just like they did when they were made.
