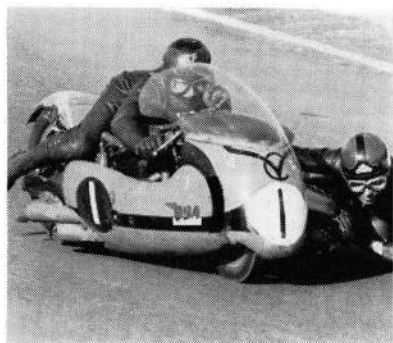

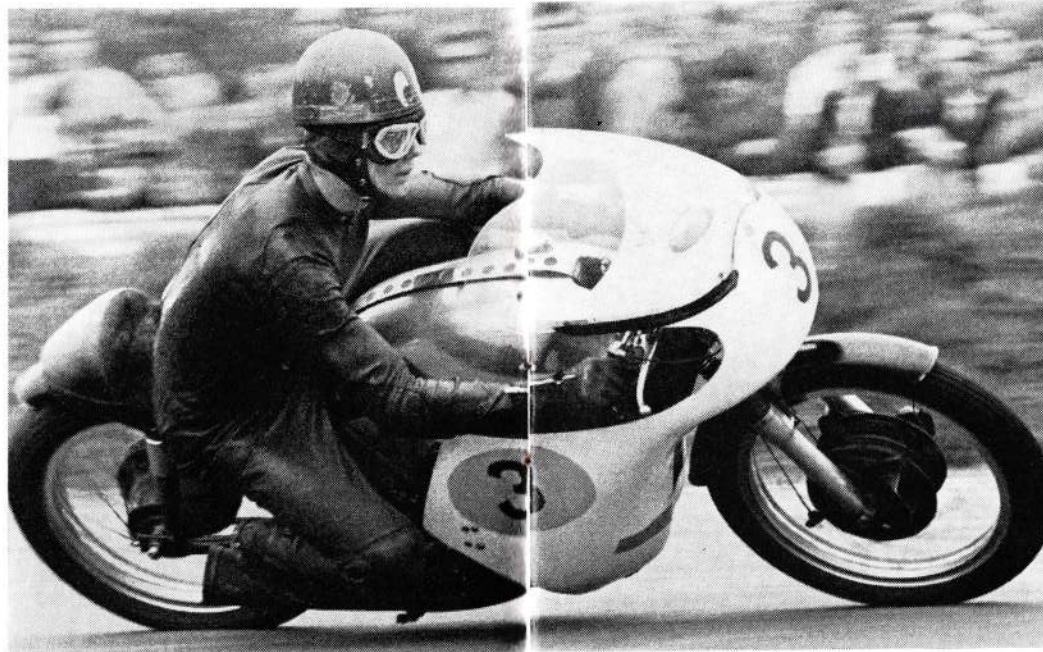


Top Stars for the East Anglian 1000 Guineas Races

Preview of today's racing

The 1968 motor-cycle road-racing season is now well under way. The new increased prize money system instituted by Motor Circuit Developments Ltd. for 1968 has been tested—and found very satisfactory. At least that must be the opinion of Ray Pickrell, a former Grovewood Award place-man from London, who romped away with the £120 cheque as a result of his convincing win at Mallory Park on 3rd March. And such stars as John Hartle (£90), British 125 c.c. Champion Martin Carney (£60) and John Cooper (£75) in the solo classes and 23-year-old sidcar ace Norman Hanks, who pocketed £75 for his three-wheeler win.

All are racing at Snetterton today for the East Anglian 1000 Guineas meeting.

New stars—new machines

It is early days yet, but outstanding riders in the opening meetings so often continue to set the pattern for the season. If this is again the case then Rex Butcher is going to be a happy man this year: riding the Eddie Crook's Suzuki 250 he finished second in the final, on the new heavy, but quick two-stroke Kawasaki 350 he was again second, while on his Norton Domi-

racer 650 he was ninth to cap a great first-meeting outing at Mallory. He rides these machines here, too.

Dave Simmonds rides the new threatening Kawasaki machines in the 250 and 350 classes. Derek Chatterton, the British 250 c.c. Champion, rides his own Yamaha in this class and will be riding the ultra-quick Italian-made water-cooled two-stroke Mondial in the 125 class and a Kawasaki in the 350 events.

New machinery for Chandler and Cooper

British 500 c.c. Champion Ron Chandler has already taken possession of his new ultra-low Colin Seeley-built A.J.S. 350—and is very pleased with it. Likewise John Cooper, the former British Champion, rides a Seeley-built Matchless-engined bike. British 350 c.c. Champion Dave Croxford is another with new equipment, his Oakley machines (A.J.S. and Matchless powered) being augmented by the Frank Sheene-prepared Bultaco water-cooled 250 on which he made a startling third-place debut at Mallory.

Going well

Already showing that they are intent on

making the most of the new prize money system are such outstanding riders as Alan Barnett, who is now number one Tom Kirby rider on the immaculate Metisse A.J.S. and Matchless machines. Snetterton favourite Dan Shorey will again be riding the Ray Petty-tuned Nortons which have previously won him so many events at the fast East Anglian circuit and Percy Tait, who tumbled at Mallory's opener, will add to the interest on his works Daytona Triumph 500.

And Ray Pickrell, the season's first big money winner, rides a quartet of machines that include his Dunstall 500 and 750 Dominators as well as an Aermacchi 350 and a 250 Greeves.

Three-wheelers

First victory of the season fell to Norman Hanks and his charming lady passenger Mrs. Rose Arnold who put their unfaired B.S.A. outfit to the fore in an action-packed race to be one up on their rivals. Norman's brother Roy and father Fred will also be seen in action—both were well placed behind him.

Last year's outstanding non-sponsored driver, Grovewood Award winner Mick

Boddice, started in spectacular fashion by looping his outfit at the Devil's Elbow following an oil leak, while Birmingham rival Peter Brown did likewise at the same spot a little earlier—both will be in action at Snetterton, although Boddice will be accompanied by a new passenger as regular Dave Loach injured his ankle in the fall.

But Snetterton is usually the favourite hunting ground of the B.M.W. duo Pip Harris and Tony Wakefield, and they will be using their very quick outfits against the bigger-capacity machines like Chris Vincent's low B.S.A. kneeler and Terry Vinicombe's similar device. Vincent is also riding a 500 c.c. machine.

New-style programme of events

The new-style programme includes races for 125, 250, 350 and 500 c.c. solo machines as well as an invitation event over 20 laps of the 2.71-mile course for the major race of the day—and the £100 first prize award. Money available to prize-winning competitors totals over £1120 and much of this (£30 and £40) is available to three-wheeler winners in the 500 and 1000 c.c. class events, both of which are six-lap affairs.

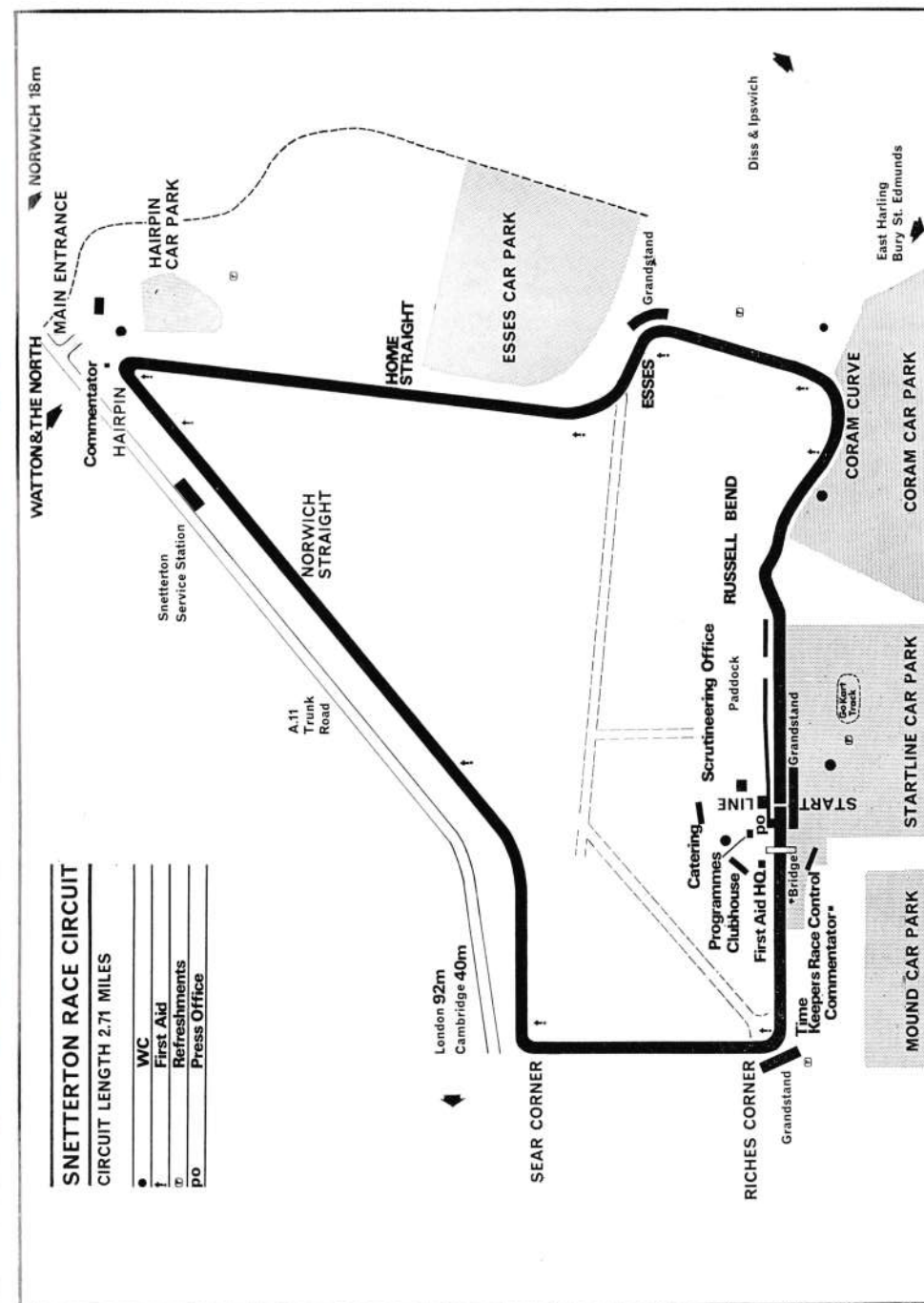
