The Championship Finals

Today is the final round for our season long Club Championships which this year were held over 15 rounds at 3 different circuits, with only the best 12 rounds to count. You will see the points positions listed elsewhere in the programme, the points in brackets are those accumulated after dropping each riders 3 worst scores, this can obviously change if a rider scores less points today than his or her worst points previously scored. I will do my best to give you the possibilities in each class which should add even more interest to today's racing. Starting with the 125 class, whatever happens today Martin Cox can not be beaten the same goes for Julian Hembrough in 2nd place, Nick Mitton in 3rd place can be caught by Martin New on points if Martin wins and Nick does not score, however Nick would still finish 3rd by virtue of more wins. Matt Ford-Dunn only needs to gain 4 more points than Martin New to move up to 4th place.

The 250 Dennis Trollope Open class shows Mark Whiting in 1st place who can not be beaten, Conor Brennan is 2nd 6 points ahead of Jason Griffiths and 7 points ahead of Nigel Froud in 3rd. If Jason gets a 4th place or better with Conor not scoring he would take 2nd place or if Nigel gets 3rd or better with Conor and Jason not scoring he could take 2nd place. Mark Wainwright in 5th place can improve to no higher standard than 3rd but would need a win to do with those above him not scoring high points.

The 350 Dennis Trollope Open class as last year will go to the wire with strangely enough the same contestants as last year, on total points scored Andy Young leads on 132 points but Andy scored in every round so at present he has to drop 18 points his worst score being a 6th place therefore any position above 6th would raise his total of 114 points. In 2nd place on actual points is Les Brace with 129 with Del Boy Spenceley 3rd on 121 however, after dropping their worst scores both are on 116, 2 points ahead of Andy. The permutations for the overall winner are vast but I will try to assess the situation for you. It would appear that only Les and Del can win but if Andy wins and Les and Del are not in the first few then things would go Andy's way, should there be a tie on points Del holds the whip hand with 8 wins, Les and Andy have 2 wins a piece which then goes to places where Andy would win on countback down to 6th place where he has one 6th and Les has nothing below 5th place. Hopefully they will make things easy by one or other actually winning today. Whilst the top 3 do battle watch out for 4th and 5th place men, Ivan Hildige and Dougie Dean who are separated by only 3 points a tie here would go to Ivan who has one 2nd place to his credit.

The 600 Open class is in the hands of Steve Marks with an unassailable score, however 2nd place is a different matter with only 1 point separating the next 3 with Jon Wright holding the advantage of one point over Steve Pullman and Wade Martin, should any of these tie on points Steve would win by virtue of more wins than Wade, Jon not having a win at all.

The 750 Open class goes to Neil Dove with Brett Sampson in 2nd and Vince Bennett 3rd, Jason Sear in 4th and Colin Leeder in 5th can only improve their scores but not their positions.

The 1300 Mobike Bromley Open class gives a win to Nev Lewendon, who can not be beaten, Bob Fowler has a secure 2nd place but Mick Jenner and Brian Tucker have it all to go for only being separated by 6 points, 5th place man Jon Power would need to win with Mick not scoring to equal him on points, if that happened Jon would take 1st by virtue of the most wins but I think Brian might have something to say about that!

On to the Proddies starting with the 250 Stan Stephens class, fortunately the top 5 are all on actual points so it makes life a little easier although the closeness of the points will make things very interesting. On the face of it, it would appear that Justin Harwood and Adrian Thomas are the only two in contention but if Barry Rudd wins with Justin or Adrian not scoring he would win, that is Barry's only chance. If Adrian beats Justin and ties on points it would go to Adrian by virtue of more wins, the best solution is for them to finish as they are in the points in the actual race but things are never that simple.

Here we have a winner, Roger Lovelock and Fraser Sutcliffe on 51 points, 2nd place goes to Tony Body and Dudley Tomlinson on 38 points, 3rd is Jeff Loveland on 30 points, 4th is Kevin Cable and Peter Carter on 26 points, 5th place at present goes to Paul and Joy Rider on 22 points.

On behalf of the Club and its Directors I would like to thank you all for supporting us this year and look forward to seeing you at our final meeting of the season here at Snetterton on 24th November and your continued support in the future. I would also like to offer our thanks to our Sponsors and Marshals and Officials without whom we would not be able to operate at the level to which you have become accustomed.

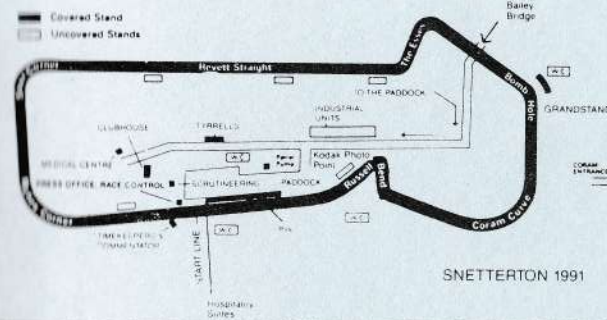

Red: When shown at marshals points around the circuit all riders must immediately cease racing and return with extreme caution to the Start/Finish line.

Yellow (waved): Great danger in section of track ahead, slow down, proceed with caution.

Yellow (motionless): Danger in section of track ahead; take care, no overtaking, maintain positions until clear of section displaying yellow flag.

Green: Course clear. Used on marshals' posts to indicate their position to riders on first lap of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been shown.

Black: Accompanied by riders number on separate board. That rider to stop in pits next time round. Always shown at

Yellow with red stripes: Oil flag. Displayed when oil has been dropped on the circuit in that section, displayed until the

White: Ambulance or course car on circuit.
Blue: Overtaking signal. The blue flag informs the rider that

Black/white chequered: Denotes finish of race, usually waved
