THE clubmen's lap record at Snetterton was smashed in Saturday's British Formula Club race meeting when Pete Bailey, riding a 750 cc Triumph, fitted with a Rickman Eight Valve conversion, scorched round in Im 47.2s, a speed of 91.01 mph, during his winning ride in the third allcomers' event.

Earlier, he had won the first allcomers' race, the opening event in the 12-race programme, but had to be content with runner-up spot in the second allcomers' event, when he was beaten by Barry Tingley (650 Trinor).

Equally successful was John Banks (Yamaha), who took first place in both 250 cc races.
