## THE SECRETARIES BLOG . . .

**Jimmy Thompson**, a stalwart marshal at the Iron Gate for over 35 years, has had to unfortunately miss this years event as he has had to go to England for an operation

On behalf of everyone involved with the Southern 100 we wish Jimmy a speedy recovery and hope to see him back in 2008.

**Will the Southern 100 Championship go to England for the first time in 10 years.** Bob Jackson was the last English rider to lift the Ennett Memorial Trophy in 1998, since then it has gone to Joey Dunlop, Northern Ireland (99), Blair Degerholm, New Zealand (00), Foot and Mouth claimed the title in 01, Ian Lougher, Wales (02, 04 and 05), Ryan Farquhar, Northern Ireland (07) and Cameron Donald, Australia (03 and 06).

By Contrast the Sidecar Championship has been won by only three drivers and four passengers since 1998. Dave Molyneux, Isle of Man has won it three times with Craig Hallam, England as ballast (98, 02 and 03), Ian Bell, England won (99 and 00) with Neil Carpenter, England as passenger. Local hero Nick Crowe, Isle of Man has won it for the last four year (04, 05 and 06) with Darren Hope, Isle of Man as passenger, and last year with Dan Sayle, Isle of Man.

## RACEGUARD DONATION TO SOUTHERN 100 ORGANISERS

The RaceGuard organisation was conceived in 2005 with charitable status both in the UK and the Isle of Man being granted in September 2006.

Just over twelve months later, Southern '100' Racing, organisers of the road races held annually on the Billown Course, in the Isle of Man have become the first beneficiary of the RaceGuard Charity.

Charlie Hulse, one of the Trustees of RaceGuard said:

**"At our AGM in September it was recognised that the Southern 100 was a particularly appropriate recipient of the first donation from RaceGuard."**

He continued: **"The 'Friendly Racing' circuit is growing in stature and has ambitious plans to upgrade circuit safety. RaceGuard is very pleased to be able to contribute to this project."**

In accepting the cheque, Southern 100 Club President, Derek Nicholson said:

**"The club were honoured to be the first recipient of a donation from RaceGuard, which is a very worthwhile charity."**

**"The donation will go towards purchasing more of the Recticel Safety Barriers, which will gradually replace the bagged straw-bales around the 4.25-mile Billown Course."**

Since the presentation last November, the club have purchased a number of Recticel Barriers with RaceGuard's generous donation, which are now out on the Billown Course providing added protection to all competitors should they require it.

# Lougher regains Solo Championship

**C**halking up his 36th success on the Billown Course, Ian Lougher

won the Southern 100 Solo Championship title for the fourth time in six years by a surprisingly comfortable margin.

In a week of considerable highs and lows the likeable Welshman crashed twice at the same corner in separate races on different bikes, broke down while vying for the lead in the lead 250cc race and celebrated his 44th birthday.

After grabbing a hat-trick of wins in the Senior races, all eyes were on Hydrex Honda's Guy Martin to take the honours in the main event at the conclusion of the Isle of Man Steam Packet sponsored four day meeting, but Lougher's prayers were answered by showers of heavy rain leading up to the start.

The roads all round the 4.25-mile public road course were still largely wet as the reduced eight lapper got underway.

Lougher grabbed the all-important hole-shot into Ballakeighan Corner and still had his nose in front of young guns Guy Martin and Conor Cummins as he braked for Iron Gate.

Stobart Honda man Lougher had a 1.3 seconds lead at the end of the first circuit, extended to 4.2 seconds by the end of lap three.

Lougher had the luxury of taking a breather mid-race before piling on the coals again in the closing stages to extend his lead to a winning margin of 14.8 seconds over his fellow Honda pilot Martin on rapidly drying roads.

Cummins overhauled fellow Islander Chris Palmer for third place, with local fireman Paul Hunt grabbing fifth on the ex Tommy Hill Virgin Yamaha.

2006 champion Cameron Donald was satisfied enough to get a top six finish after a week plagued by electrical problems on the Uel Duncan Racing Honda Fireblade.

**Nick Crowe and Dan Sayle won the Sidecar Championship by a country mile.**

It was Crowe's fourth consecutive title; the previous three coming with Darren Hope, but his ambition of becoming the first drive to circulate Billown at 100mph on a three-wheeler were scuppered by the damp conditions, having lapped at 99.778mph in the dry the previous evening.

With the obvious exception of the weather, both of the sidecar races were remarkably similar.

Crowe and Sayle made easy work of them, chased home at a discreet distance on each occasion by course newcomers Nigel Connole and Jamie Winn who rode extremely well to beat seasoned campaigners Roy Hanks and Dave Wells.

At one stage in the first encounter, the two outfits were virtually inseparable after a brief coming-together at Cross Four Ways.

Another crew making their first appearance on the course were LCR Honda-mounted former world champions Klaus Klaffenbock and Christian Parzer, firmly gripped by the road racing bug despite a fruitless time at this year's TT.

Klaffenbock and Parzer finished fourth in the support race and fifth in the Championship event after being demoted a place by Steve Coombes and Crowe's ex passenger Darren Hope.

The ever-consistent Kenny Howles and Doug Jewell finish fifth and sixth.

**Guy Martin scored a double success in the Senior Solo events, later adding a third victory in the 600cc Solo class.**

The opening race of the week, the Senior Solo Founders, was red flagged after four laps when French newcomer Erwen Erkelens crashed his Suzuki 750 heavily at Stadium Corner fracturing a leg.

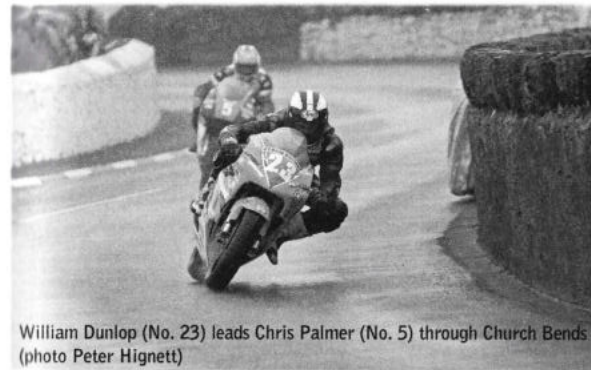

The result was declared on the positions at the end of lap three, with Martin leading Manxman Conor Cummins and Chris Palmer.

Martin also rode to victory in the second Superbike event 24 hours later, when Loughier (who had been high-sided from the Stobart Honda the previous evening,) finished second ahead of Cummins and Cameron Donald.

**Rounding off his hat-trick,** Guy Martin also won the 600cc event on the final day after shaking off early leader Palmer, while Donald eventually claimed his best result of the week in second spot.

William Dunlop recorded his first outright win on the course in the thoroughly wet 250cc race.

Palmer again set the early pace, but he slowed in the conditions to leave Dunlop in a two-way tussle with Loughier for the lead.

Loughier's Stewart Smith Racing Honda rolled to a halt with a seized engine on the final lap, leaving Dunlop a delighted winner.

Palmer did get a brace of deserved wins in the 125cc events, run concurrently with the 400s, enjoying close tussles with Loughier on each occasion.

Former British 125GP Champion Palmer was lucky to survive a massive slide in the wet on the final lap of the second race when his feet came off the foot rests as he took to the gutter in fifth gear at Williams Corner!

**New Zealander Paul Dobbs won a thrilling three-way dogfight** with Alan Oversby and Roy Richardson for the 400cc honours in the opening encounter, while Tim Poole (who retired after one lap in the first race) was the clear winner in the rain-hit second event.

Alan Oversby produced two faultless rides to win both Classic races on his Craven Manx Norton.

Chris McGahan was runner-up in the first on the 850cc class-winning Miles Trident, while Manxman Allan Brew was runner-up in the second on the Seeley G50 – Alec Whitwell taking the Open capacity honours on this occasion aboard a 560cc Bates Honda.

Tony Cawte won both of the 350cc events on a Honda-4 finishing fifth and third respectively.

Newcomers Dan Kneen and Ross Johnson won the Senior and Junior Support races respectively.

Kneen also had a close battle with fellow IoM racer Tony Oates before ultimately accepting second best in the 600cc 'B' Final.

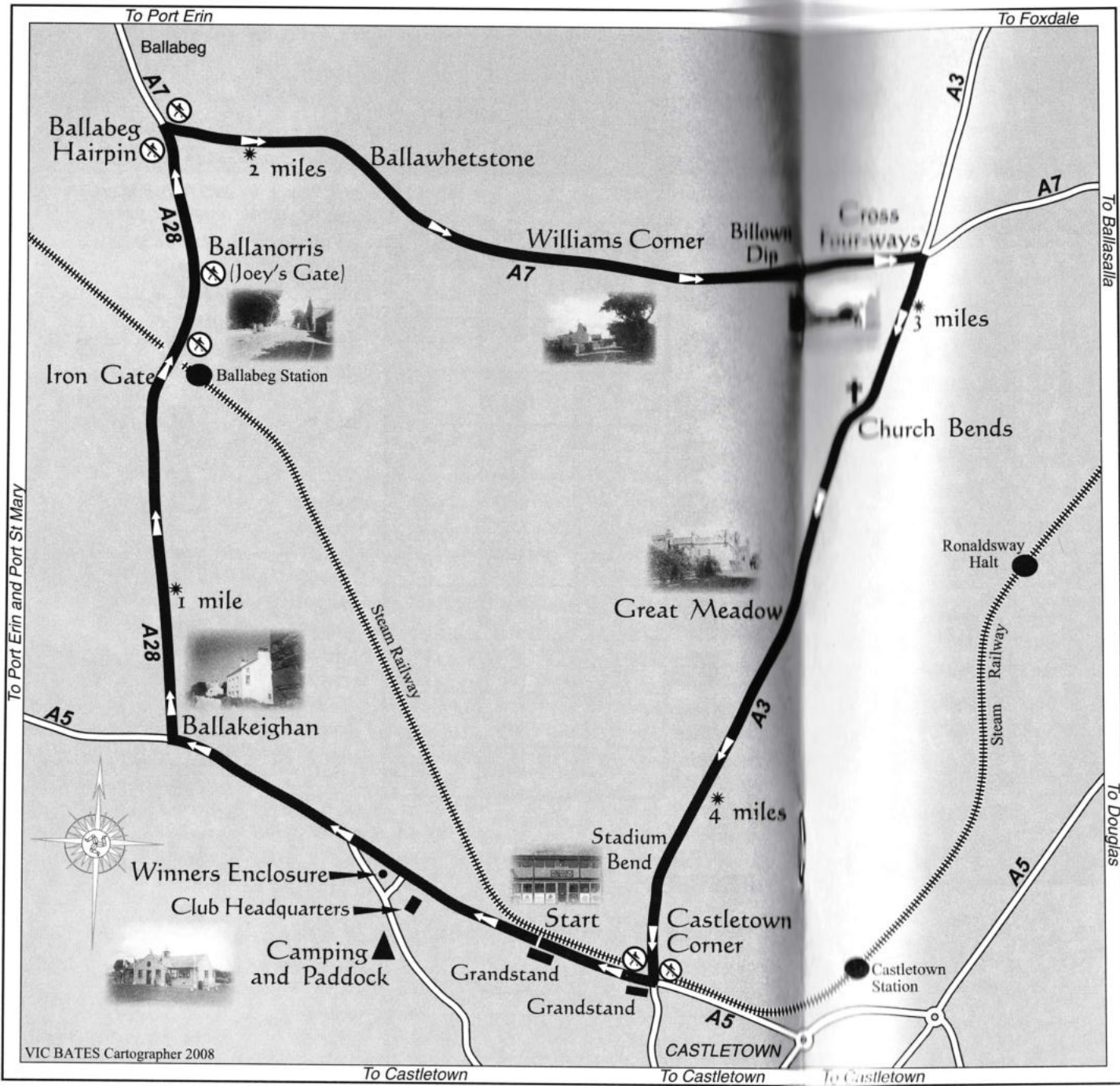

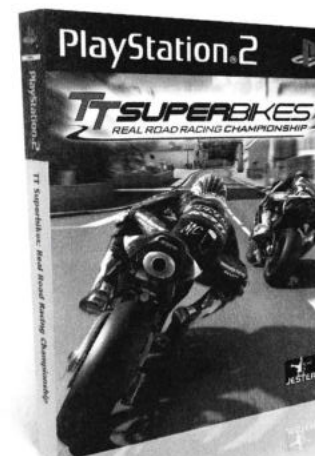

## A TRIBUTE TO BERTIE PAYNE

**Newtownards man Bertie Payne died suddenly on 30th May this year.**

A familiar sight at road race venues in his native Ulster and the Isle of Man, with the occasional sortie to UK circuits, Bertie had been a long time sponsor of one Joey Dunlop, providing the great-man with 250cc Honda machines for many seasons.

A quiet gentleman, Bertie, could be seen in the background assisting as requested, whereas in the Isle of Man, he was more often found out on the Mountain providing the all-important signalling information to 'Yer Maun' as he hurtled past towards the chequered flag.

A retired contractor, his annual trip to the Island for the June TT races ceased after 2000, although he maintained his love affair with the Southside Billown Course, where his rider took a total of 31 victories including six Solo Championships in the Southern '100' Road Races, plus a further 11 in the Steam Packet event at the end of the TT period.

Bertie and his wife Jean were instrumental, along with Linda Dunlop in presenting the organizers of the Southern '100' with **The Joey Dunlop Trophy**, which is presented to the rider who sets the fastest lap of the meeting during the solo races.

Winners of this most prestigious trophy so far have been Ryan Farquhar, Guy Martin, Ian Lougher and Cameron Donald.

Guy Martin has collected the trophy personally from Bertie Payne twice, the first time in 2004 and most recently last year in 2007.

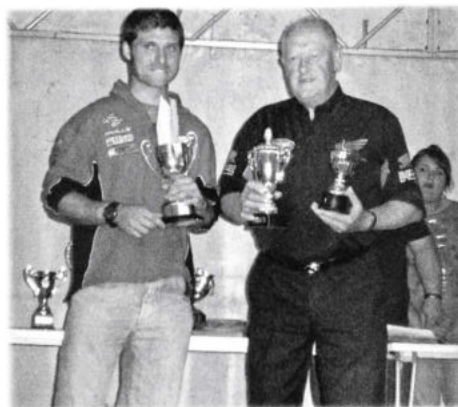

**All who have had the pleasure of knowing Bertie Payne will have very many pleasant memories to recall as past meetings are remembered with affection.**

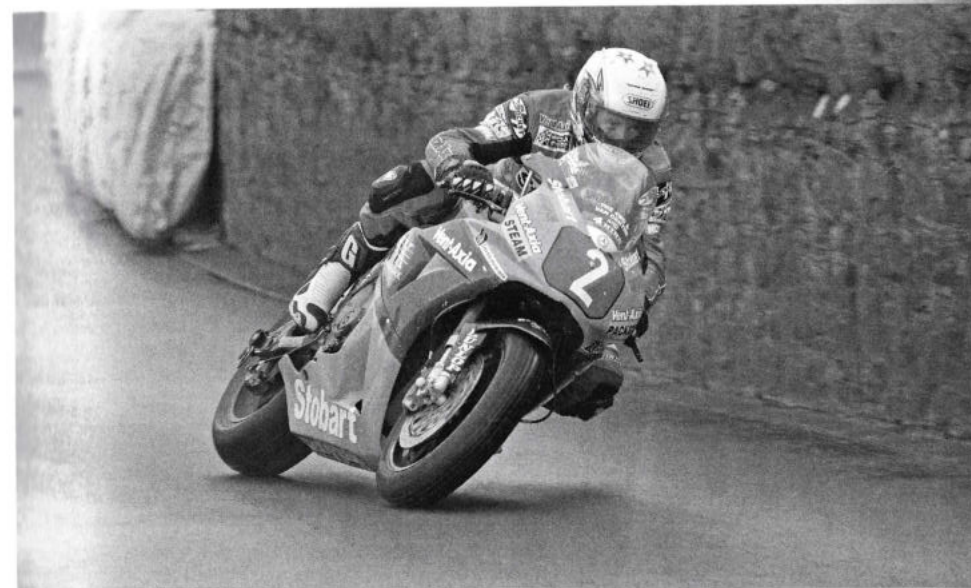

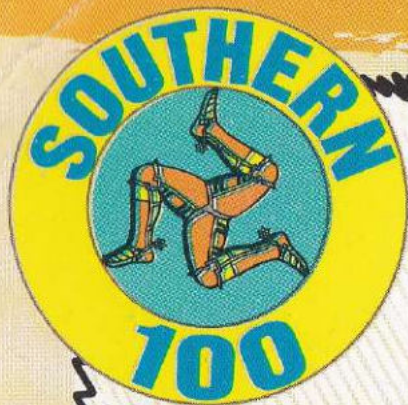

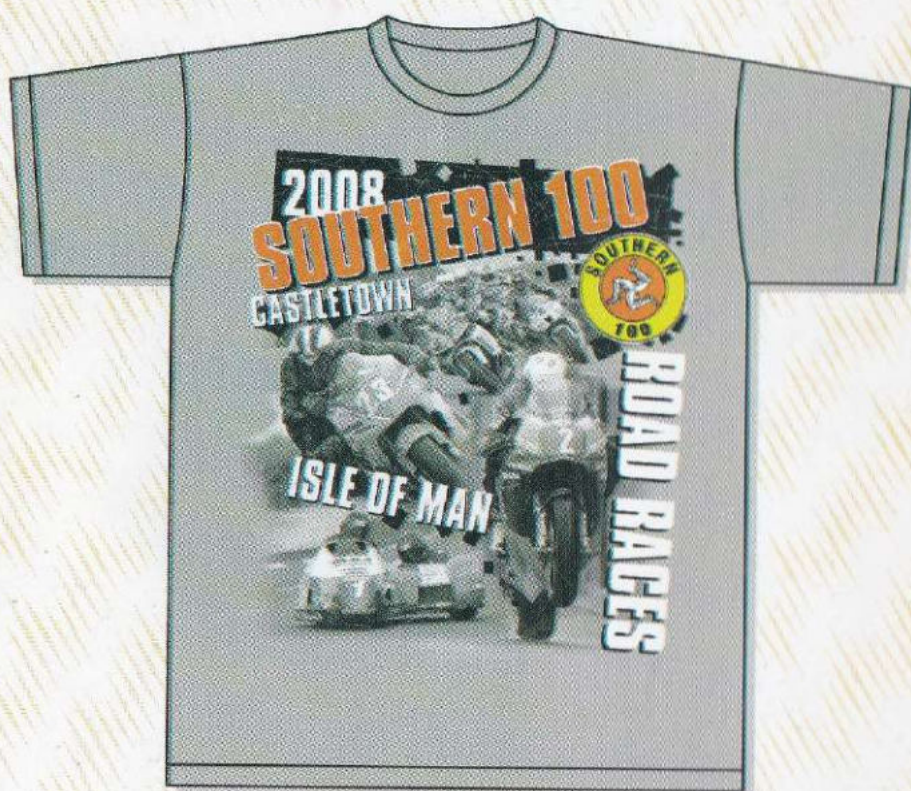
