Welcome to Rusper

On behalf of the Twickenham & District Motor Cycle Club may I welcome you to the penultimate round of the British Sidecar and Fourstroke Motocross Championships.

To say that both Championships are wide open is an understatement, current champions Perry Leask and Chris Etheridge/Garry Withers have only just gained top positions and it could change again today.

In the Fourstroke class Perry leads Brian Wheeler by a single point with Greg Hanson, himself a former 125 and Fourstroke champion, and Lee King both within striking distance of the top two. So it looks like Husqvarna v KTM but watch out for the Husabergs of Irwin, Robley, Sparkes and Pringle who could well upset the applecart.

In the Sidecar class Chris Etheridge/Garry Withers hold a 10 point lead over Martin Hagon/Mike Turner with Colin Philpott/Paul Henderson 34 points further down but Colin and Paul were on form two weeks ago at the Belgian Grand Prix whilst Garry Withers, at time of printing, was still sick with dehydration but don't rule the old boy out because, in his own words, he "only races to win". Also don't forget Peter Clarke/Jason Peters, Trevor Hollister/John Chambers or Stuart Brown/David Keane all of whom will be making sure that the top three don't have an easy time here at Rusper.

Backing up the six championship races we have 3 races for invited riders who have helped out at meetings but nevertheless, racing will be fast and furious. Most of the Twickenham team that won in France against our twinned club are in this race. Led by Scott Robinson, Warren Paine and Gary Jefferson but watch out for Scott Clayden, Rob Foden and of course our top club Juniors Dave Francis, Mark Cutbush and Simon Tidman.

Whichever class you support, whichever rider/crew you support give them all a rousing cheer and I am positive you will get value for money today.

No programme would be complete without a big thank you to the people who make these meetings possible. With over £2,000 in prize money a small club like Twickenham would not be able to run without sponsorship and with this in mind I would like to pass on the club's thanks to Chris & Roy Reilly of Berkshire Cycles who, once again, proved they are one of the best and are sponsoring the 3 sidecar races.

Peter and Mike Pearce never lose their enthusiasm for two wheels and they have kindly once again looked after one of the Fourstroke classes. 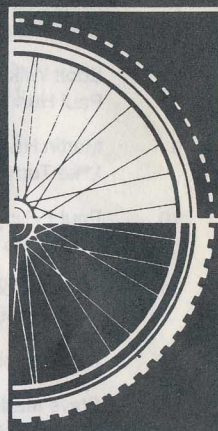

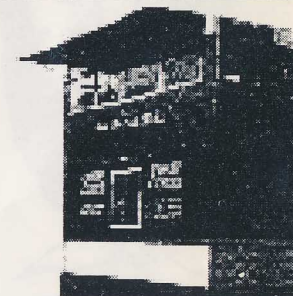
