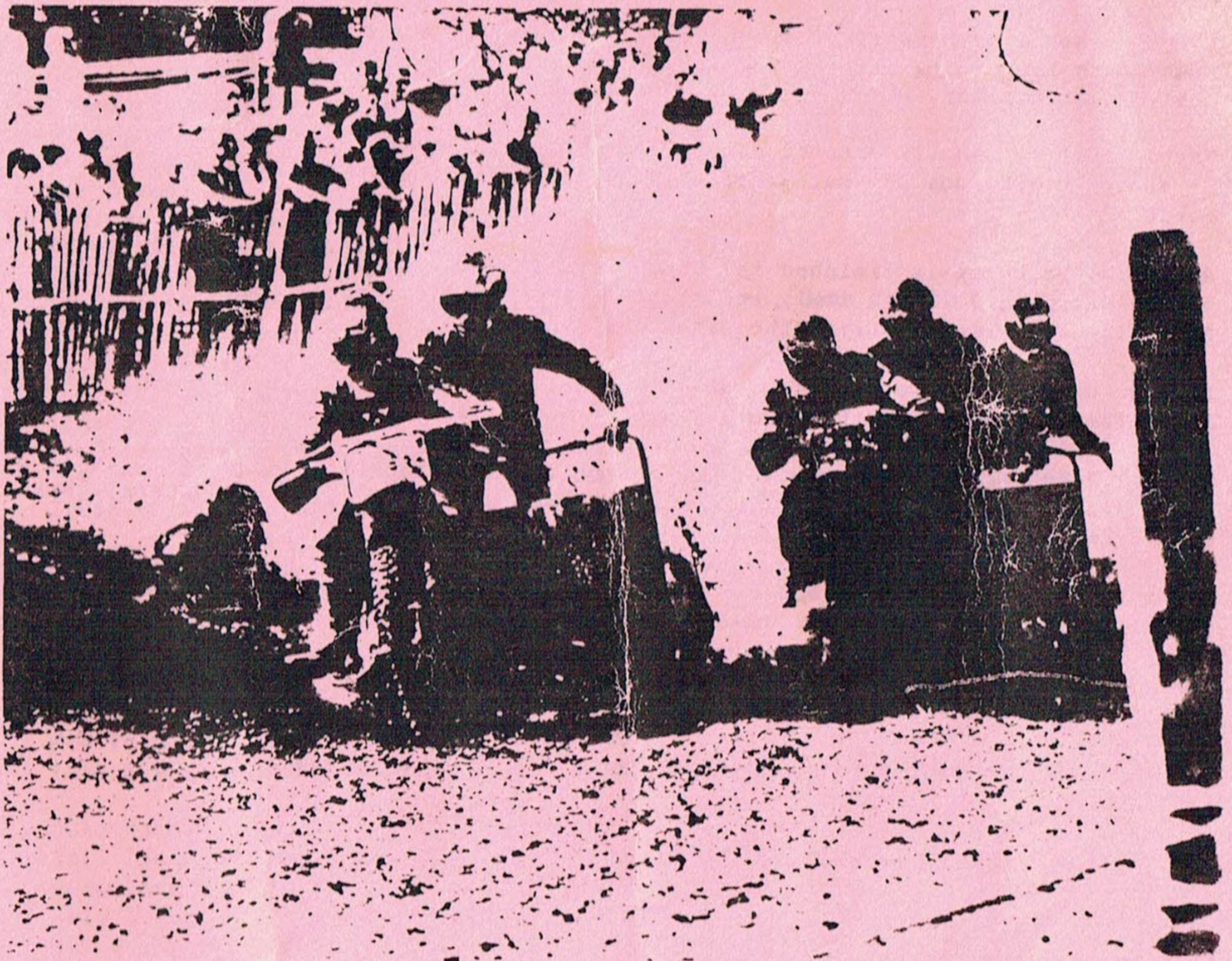

The above timings are for guidance only.

All vehicles will be allowed to leave the pits area until racing has finished as this will jeopardise the chances of the race programme being completed.

Any rider touching or breaking the start tapes WILL be excluded, this will be strictly enforced. You cannot protest against the decision of the starter. (National Sporting Code 5.19)

Any rider found guilty of overtaking on a waved yellow flag will be excluded. Any rider ignoring a red flag will be excluded from the meeting and will face further disciplinary action. There are three red flags on the circuit, each holder is in radio contact, the RED FLAG is the OFFICIAL signal that a race has been stopped.

All machines are to be started before 12:10 due to the close proximity of the church.

No power washers are to be used, any rider found using one will be excluded from the meeting and or be subject to further disciplinary action. (National Sporting Code 5.22)

In the event of there being insufficient marshalls a ballot will take place to determine the riders that will be called upon to supply a marshall, if they cannot supply a marshall they will not ride.

There is to be no riding in the pits, this includes the practice of riding side saddle or walking with the bike whilst feathering the clutch, when not on the track the engine should be dead unless in the pit box or warming up whilst out of gear.

Please assist the lap scorers by ensuring your numbers are clean when you start each lap.
