TRIALS AND MOTOCROSS NEWS

Welcome to Streatley Hills, home of Mortimer Motorcycle Club and the venue for the opening round of the 1987 British 500cc Motocross Championships.

Aiming for his fifth consecutive British crown will be Berkshire's David Thorpe, world 500cc champion for the past two seasons. Thorpe will be aiming to get his campaign off to the best possible start here today at Streatley, a track which he rates as being good enough to host a solo GP.

But with the quality of his opposition, works Honda star Thorpe knows that he won't be able to make any slips on the Streatley hillsides.

Heading that opposition will be East Anglian Kurt Nicoll, with the full backing that his position of Kawasaki number one entails. Kurt finished second in the home series last season and seventh in the world rankings, despite the fact that he was slowly recovering from a nasty thigh injury at the end of the previous season. Back to full form he will be anxious to let Thorpe and everyone else know that he means business this year.

Highest placed privateer in the world series in '86 – 10th – Mervyn Anstie has recently taken delivery of full works KTMs for his campaigns. His outings even on standard production mounts early in the season showed that he will be a force to be reckoned with.

Another rider who has landed works machinery for '87 is Greg Hanson from High Wycombe, who has just returned from a very successful campaign in New Zealand, where he won all but one race over six meetings.

Returning to the Heron Suzuki fold Jeremy Whatley will start his campaign on a 250, not that that is a great disadvantage these days. He finished fifth in the home series last season on a quarter-litre machine and can really turn it on when he puts his mind to the job in hand.

Rob Andrews and Banks Honda team-mate Mark Banks have prepared for the season in the sunny climes of California, hopeful of lifting their pace to that of the Yanks.

Dave Watson has been trying out his new power-valved 355cc 'intermediate capacity' KTM in recent weeks and praying that he can stay clear of the niggling injuries which harassed him throughout '86, when he finally claimed a British title – the 250cc crown.

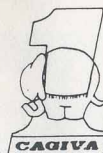
Kawasaki man Andy Nicholls will campaign a full factory "Greenie" just to show everyone what he can do on an open classer, while Scot Willie Simpson will continue to get mongst them despite being one of the longest serving Grade One riders.

No one could discount new ACU licence-holder Laurence Spence who seems to quietly get on with things unperturbed by the antics of others around him, and another Irishman Alan Morrison who could be the surprise of the season! Others worth watching include the flamboyant youngster Rob Herring (Mitsui Yamaha), Russ Jarman (Goss KTM), Perry Leask (F&E Kawasaki) who will only be contesting the main championship series in Britain, Stuart Coyle (Mitsui Yamaha), Mark Bennett (KTM), Barry Johnson (Cradley Kawasaki), Jared Smith (Bikesport Kawasaki).

In the qualifying championship 128 hopefuls will line up for battle but the men most likely to be in contention for top points will include Dave Dormer, Simon Wyse, Chris Bowd, Garry Woollam, Paul Bickers and Mike Francis.

What ever happens, have a good day, enjoy the racing and try and bring a few friends next time you come!
