Marking is on the following basis :

- 0 Clean
- 1 If a rider puts a foot to the ground once (1 dab)
- 2 If a rider puts a foot to the ground twice (2 dabs)
- 3 Anything more than two dabs, provided that the bike and rider continue to move through the section in the correct direction
- 5 A failure as outlined below

A failure will be deemed to have occurred when :

- a. The machine ceases to move in a forward direction relative to the course
- b. The driver dismounts
- c. Any wheel of the machine crosses an artificial boundary
- d. The machine travels outside any marker, or if the driver is responsible for breaking or removing a tape or marker
- e. The machine or driver receives outside help.

Artificial boundaries may be used to define the limits of an observed section. A driver whose machine crosses any boundary with any wheel, or who passes the wrong side of any boundary marker will be deemed to have failed in that section. A machine will be deemed to be in the section when the front wheel spindle has passed the begins card and until the front wheel spindle has passed the end card.
