HISTORY OF TRIALS RIDING IN RUNNYMEDE

In 1975 I approached the council for a piece of land which I could use for training young trials riders.

The Pit Stop Youth Scramble Club was already in existence, and using a piece of land at Lyne, which they offered to share with the S.S.T.C.

In 1978 Mr. Tollet and Mr. Elliot both donated a shield to the club, to be awarded to the best rider over a period of six months.

The land at Lyne is used for boys and girls, who are just starting to ride, and I feel that any training given to youngsters before they are old enough to ride on the road must be beneficial.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Location: Lyne Lane, Thorpe, Runnymede.

A30 to Virginia Water turn off to Chertsey B389, $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles follow S.S.T.C. signs.

Competitors are required to sign ON and OFF.

First competitor leaves at 2.01 remainder at $\frac{1}{2}$ minute intervals.

Course: 10 sections—5 laps.

INSTRUCTIONS TO OBSERVERS

A competitor is in the section when his front wheel spindle passes the Begins card, and has completed the section when his front wheel spindle passes the Ends card.

- 0 for a feet up ride through the section.
- 1 for foot touching the ground once only.
- 2 for foot touching the ground twice only.
- 3 for foot touching the ground more than twice.
- 5 for stopping in the section.
