However, this year's No. 1 Plate Holder, Jon Hope from Rugeley, Staffs., has decided to concentrate on "Pure Road Circuits" and will not be racing today. As the No. 1 Plate for 1994 has not yet been awarded, it has given us the opportunity to let ANN GRIFFITHS wear the much coveted Plate on her bike for this meeting. It has been awarded in recognition of her outstanding effort and achievement in September's Manx Grand Prix Races.

Ann, a 28-year-old teacher from Crosby, Liverpool, overcame immense Personal and Machine problems to claim a "Finishers" Award in the four-lap Junior Manx Grand Prix Race. This was just two days after retiring from the Newcomers Lightweight Race on the second lap whilst lying 12th and having completed her fastest-ever lap of the famous T.T. Course at over 94m.p.h. on her 1990 Kawasaki KR1 — and that was from a "Standing Start!"

Just for the record, she averaged nearly 88m.p.h. for one hour and 43 minutes over the greatest and most demanding circuit in the world.

In addition to her Isle-of-Man conquest, Ann has won eight races over this tricky Three Sisters Circuit during the year and is hoping to increase that figure today.

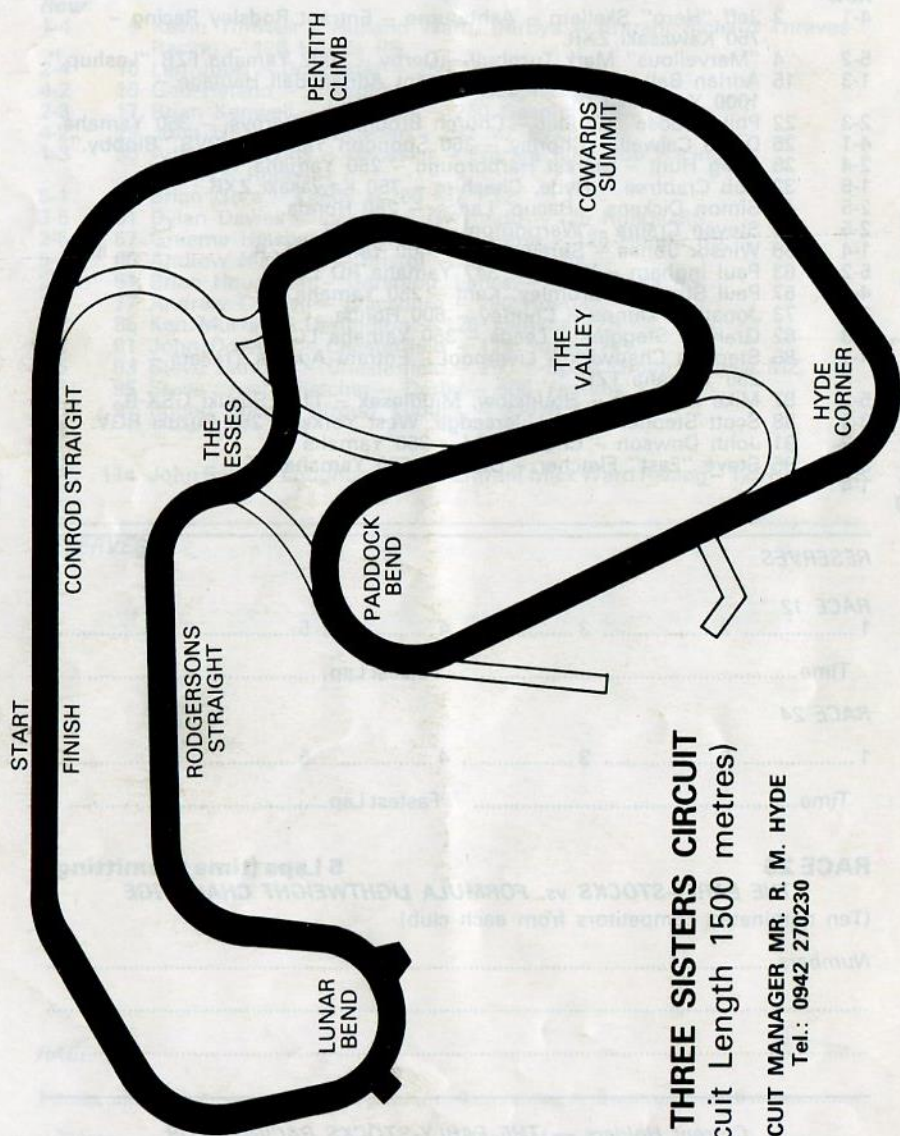
