# THRUXTON CIRCUIT

Motor and Motor Cycle racing has taken place at Thruxton since the late 1940's, the first event ever being promoted by the Ringwood Motor Cycle and Light Car Club in 1947. This was their only meeting here as they then moved to the now defunct Ibsley circuit near Ringwood. Various circuits have been used in the past and the Southampton and District Motor Cycle Club have promoted here for some 20 years under the very able guidance of Neville Goss. The Bristol Motor Cycle and Light Car Club promoted some two or three car meetings here in the mid 1950's most of the named British drivers having appeared here in those days. The named Motor Cyclists who have ridden here over the years would fill a book.

During the winter months of 1967/68 the present circuit was designed and put here the first meeting taking place at the beginning of March in 1968. This was followed by the first of the now established Easter Monday Internationals for F2 cars. Since the closure of Goodwood Thruxton has become the home of the British Automobile Racing Club and their recently formed subsidiary company, Thruxton (BARC) Ltd., are now responsible for promoting Motor and Motor Cycle racing here. This is also the home of the Southampton and District Motor Cycle Club who have had such a long association with the circuit in its many forms over the years.

Thruxton is now one of the leading circuits in the country and also one of the safest. Most of the leading Motor Racing drivers and Motor Cycle riders have appeared at the circuit over the past three years. The main meeting of the year is at Easter, this being one of the rounds of the European F2 Championship. For the past three years Jochen Rindt has won this event and he will be very sadly missed by all regular spectators. The major Motor Cycle

event of the year is the International 500 mile GP d'Endurance race for Production Motor Cycles. This always attracts a very good entry to do battle during the only really long distance event in the British Motor Cycle calendar.



# HOW TO GET THERE

# BY ROAD . . .

The Thruxton motor circuit is situated 4 miles west of Andover, Hampshire, on the A.303. The entrance to the circuit is about a mile west of Thruxton village and is signposted by the R.A.C. Access from London is via the A.30 Staines—Bagshot—Basingstoke road or, from the south of London, on the A.25 through Redhill—Dorking—Guildford and then on to Basingstoke. Travellers from the south-east may take the A.272 through Haywards Heath—Petworth—Petersfield—Winchester. Routes from south-west are the A.303 taking in Ilminster—Ilchester—Wincanton—Amesbury and the A.30 or A.354 via Salisbury. Access from Bristol and Bath is via Devizes on the A.342, while the A.34/A.343 via Newbury provides a direct route from the Oxford area.

Thruxton is approximately 69 miles from London, 42 from Bath, 45 from Oxford, 76 from Brighton, 16 from Salisbury, 16 from Marlborough and 100 from Exeter, 70 from Bristol.

Thruxton is an Operational Airfield. Any one wishing to fly to any meeting should obtain permission in advance by phoning Weyhill 352 and ask for "Flying Control." Current landing fees will be charged when signing in. All pilots having report to "C" Hut, situated on the outside of the circuit by the Flying Control building. This can be reached by using the bridge across the circuit. All passengers must leave the Airfield during racing. The entrance to the Paddock and Spectators Areas is through the white gate near the bridge.

# PLAYGROUND


A Children's Play Area, fenced off, is provided free of charge. This is at the top of the Main Drive on the right hand side.


