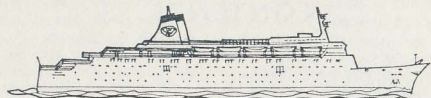

THRUXTON CIRCUIT

Motor and Motor Cycle racing has taken place at Thruxton since the late 1940's, the first event ever being promoted by the Ringwood Motor Cycle and Light Car Club in 1947. This was their only meeting here as they then moved to the now defunct Ibsley Circuit near Ringwood. Various circuits have been used here in the past according to the runways which were most usable and the Southampton and District Motor Cycle Club have promoted at Thruxton for some 20 years under the very able guidance of Neville Goss. Two or three car meetings were promoted here in the mid 1950's by the British Motor Cycle and Light Car Club and nearly all of the leading British drivers at that time appeared here. The named Motor Cyclists to have ridden here over the years are legion.

During the winter months of 1967/68 the present circuit was designed and built in five months using most of the existing perimeter track. The first meeting on this new circuit was promoted by the BARC in March 1968, followed by the now traditional Easter Monday F2 meeting which is a round of the European Championship. Since the closure of Goodwood, Thruxton has become the home of the BARC and their subsidiary company Thruxton (BARC) Ltd. are responsible for promoting Car and Motor Cycle meetings here. It is also the home of the Southampton and District Motor Cycle Club who have had such a long and successful association with the circuit in its many forms over the years.

Thruxton is one of the leading circuits in the country and regarded by many as one of the safest. During the past four years most of the leading Motor Racing drivers and Motor Cycle riders have appeared at the circuit. The major meeting of the year is on Easter Monday this being for Formula 2 cars. For the first three years the late

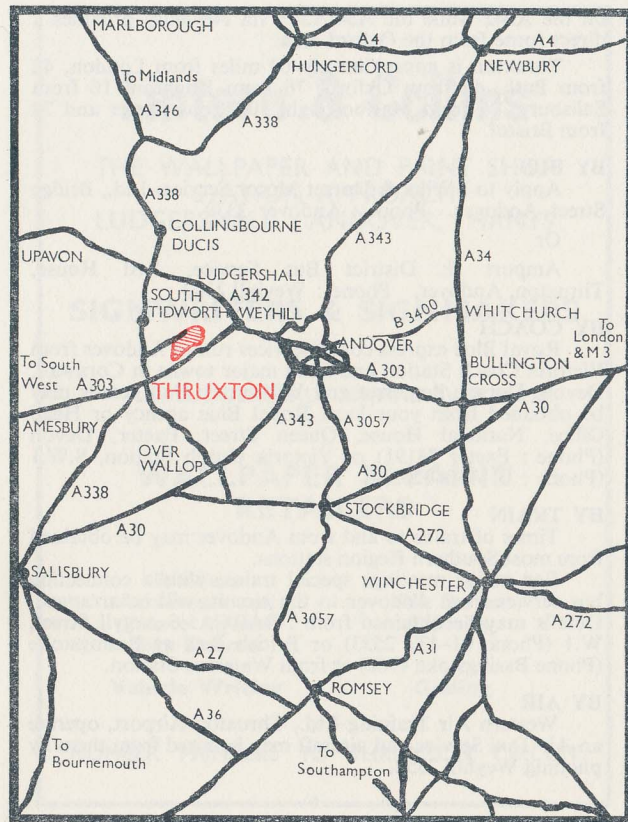
Jochen Rindt won this event and last year Graham Hill pulled it off after a thrilling race long duel with Ronnie Peterson. The major Motor Cycle meeting of the year is the International 500 mile G.P. d'Endurance race for Production Motor Cycles. This always attracts a very good entry to do battle during the only really long distance event in the British Motor Cycle calendar and this year is the last of the World long distance races. This year Sprint meetings have had to be dropped and three extra Car meetings will be taking their place.

HOW TO GET THERE

BY ROAD . . .

The Thruxton motor circuit is situated 4 miles West of Andover, Hampshire, on the North side of the A303. The entrance to the circuit is about a mile to the West of Thruxton village and is signposted by the R.A.C. Access from London is via the A30 Staines—Bagshot road and then on to the M3 or from the South of London on the A25 through Redhill—Dorking—Guildford and then on to A31 to Farnham from here on the A287 to Odiham and from here on to the A30. Travellers from the South-East may take the A272 through Haywards Heath—Petworth—Petersfield—Winchester and then on to the A303 via the A34. Routes from the South-West are on the A303 taking in Ilminster—Ilchester—Wincanton—Amesbury and the A30 or A354 via Salisbury. Access from Bristol and Bath is via Devizes



on the A342 while the A34/A343 via Newbury provides a direct route to the Oxford area.

Thrupton is approximately 69 miles from London, 42 from Bath, 45 from Oxford, 76 from Brighton, 16 from Salisbury, 16 from Marlborough, 100 from Exeter and 70 from Bristol.

NUMBER PAINTERS TO THRUPTON CIRCUIT

Thruxton is an Operational Airfield and those wishing to fly in to a meeting should obtain permission to land in advance by phoning "Flying Control" at Weyhill 2352. Current landing fees will be charged when signing on. All Pilots must report to the "C" hut which is on the outside of the circuit near the bridge. All passengers must leave the Aircraft and Airfield during racing. The entrance to the Paddock and the Spectator Enclosures is through the white gate near the bridge.

Fuel supplies are available on request. No refuelling will be done during racing.

SKID CONTROL CENTRE

This is at the top of the Main drive on the right hand side. Michael Dashwood runs this. Courses in handling vehicles under all conditions are available to all members of the general public. No special equipment is required but Ladies should bring with them a pair of flat shoes. The School provides the vehicles but encourages pupils to try their own cars towards the end of the session.

Courses last from 2 to 3 hours costing £4.25 (Roadcraft) and £5.25 (Advanced). Club courses at £2.50 per member for groups of 10 or more. A similar centre is also operated at Crystal Palace.

DRIVING SCHOOL

Full courses in driving instruction (1 week residential if convenient) for any age or experience. Off the highway courses for those aged 16 and upwards. The courses are all biased around road safety in all its aspects, specifically aiming at preparing the pupils for driving in the future instead of in the past.

CATERING—There are adequate catering points with licensed bars and kiosks in all enclosures.

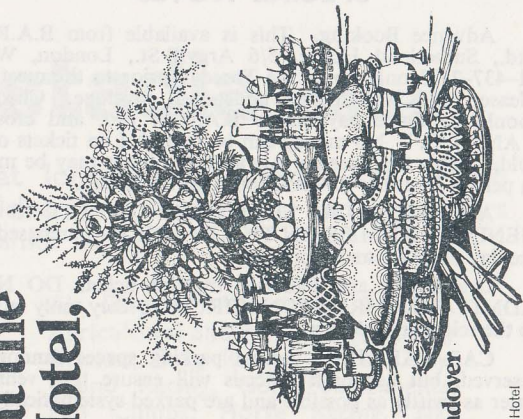
