




Our mission at Bennetts is for riders to get more from motorcycling and we do that at BSB by getting you - the fans - closer to the action.





Three rounds into the 25th Anniversary season of Bennetts BSB and already four different riders have topped the podium with plenty more knocking on the door...

ine races into a thrilling 2021 Bennetts British Superbike Championship and it's as tight at the top as it's ever been with the top two riders separated by just six points.

VisionTrack Ducati's Christian Iddon leads the way following his victories at Knockhill and again last weekend at Brands Hatch, which is complemented by four further visits to the podium at the opening three rounds. Aboard Paul Bird's factorysupported machine, Iddon is riding the best he's ever done in his bid to capture the team's ninth Bennetts BSB crown.

But hot on his heels is the McAMS Yamaha of Jason O'Halloran who has been in scintillating form this season. In addition to his season-opening treble at Oulton Park in June, he added a fourth win to his tally at a thoroughly thrilling Brands Hatch a week ago to trail Iddon by those narrow six points.

It might have been a different story had 'The O'Show' not crashed out of the middle race at Knockhill. However, such has been his consistency that both him and Iddon, have been on the podium in all but three races so far in 2021.

Those two have a slight advantage over third placed rider Tarran Mackenzie, who bolstered his claims to the title with his first win of the season seven days ago. and added a pair of podium finishes also to sit just 26 points behind Iddon. But after missing Thruxton through injury last time we were here two years ago, the diminutive McAMS Yamaha rider will be looking to make amends.

Fourth placed Danny Buchan is proving to be a major threat on the brand-new SYNETIQ BMW M 1000 RR and the tall Essex rider is just seven points adrift of Mackenzie. The BMW has been



traditionally strong at Thruxton, and in front of some important sponsors here this weekend, expect him to be in the fight to add to that double victory up in Scotland.

If there's one thing Tommy Bridewell can count on this weekend it's the support of the partisan local crowd who will be willing the Oxford Products Racing Ducati rider onto victory. But his local track hasn't been to kind to the Devizes flyer in recent years, so how sweet would it be for him to land his first win of the season here at Thruxton?

The FS-3 Kawasaki duo of Rory Skinner and Lee Jackson will hope to put their distinctive lime green liveries on the podium, plus don't rule out nine-times Thruxton winner and defending champion Josh Brookes aboard the VisionTrack Ducati now it seems he's turning the corner after a disastrous start to the

Peter Hickman (FHO Racing BMW) and the SYNETIQ BMW of Andrew Irwin are race winners here at Thruxton and both are determined to bag crucial points here to launch themselves up the standings, whilst Bradley Ray (Rich Energy OMG BMW) and Glenn Irwin (Honda Racing) hope to kickstart their seasons this weekend.

Welcome back, everyone, we've missed you but in case you'd forgotten. this is Bennetts BSB after all, the only thing certain is there'll be a twist or two once again this weekend. Expect the unexpected and hold on for one heck of

EVENT FORMAT

The event programme will take on a new format for 2021 with the opening day of the event returning to two BSB SUPERPICKS 12 free practice sessions for the Bennetts BSB class. The fastest 12 riders overall will be seeded directly to the Day 2 Qualifying 2 (Q2) session. The second day of action will begin with a third, shorter Bennetts BSB free practice session in the morning, followed by Qualifying 1 (Q1), where the fastest six riders will progress through to the Q2 session to join the 12 pre-qualifiers from the opening day in the final fight for the pole position for the opening Bennetts BSB race. Later in the afternoon or Day 2, the first Bennetts BSB race will blast off, designated as the BikeSocial race. The third and final day of competition will feature a morning warm up and the second and third Bennetts BSB races of the weekend.

THE SHOWDOWN

As the regular length season returns, the established Showdown format will apply with some changes for 2021. The Main Season will now consist of eight events and 24 races. Points will be awarded to the first 15 finishers using the regular format of 25-20-16-13-11-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. After the 24th race, the top eight riders in the championship standings will graduate as Title Fighters and be elevated to 1000 points together with any Podium Points accrued in the Main Season, Podium Points will be awarded for each main season race as follows: 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 1 point. For the remaining three events (nine races), points will be awarded to the first 15 finishers using the regular format of 25-20-16-13-11-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. The BSB Riders Cup will continue to be awarded to the first rider outside of the Title Fighters in the final

BOOM TIME!

DANNY BUCHAN

As if anyone needed reminding, Danny Buchan is rapidly proving a force to be reckoned with in this year's Bennetts British Superbike Championship.

fter signing for Philip and Hector Neill's SYNETIQ BMW team this year to ride the brand-new BMW M 1000 RR, great things were expected of the tall guy from Essex.

The 28-year-old nicknamed 'Boom!' had been knocking on the door in Bennetts BSB for a few years and up until this season, had delivered just two wins. But all that changed when the series visited Knockhill three weeks ago.

At the Fife track, Buchan - with proud Scottish ancestry - romped to a career first double victory to thrust himself firmly back into the title race, which he backed that up with another podium for good

The result had massive ramifications all round as not only was it a landmark moment for Buchan, but it also represented the first European victory for the new BMW model. Not only that, but it ended the lean spell in Bennetts BSB - the previous victory for the German marque was back in 2017, when Peter Hickman won a thrilling race here at Thruxton.

And it meant that for the first time since Michael Laverty took the spoils back in 2016, again ironically here at Thruxton, that the wellestablished TAS team from Northern Ireland got their hands on a Bennetts BSB winner's trophy.

Of course, celebrations were planned, none more so than in the Buchan household where the family were shipped off to Butlins at Bognor Regis. There, Danny treated the kids to a couple of

days in the amusement arcade, which promptly got rid of most of his winning

Danny couldn't quite replicate his Knockhill heroics at Brands Hatch where he came away with a trio of fourth places, despite frontrunning in all of the races.

However, those solid points were enough to keep the SYNETIQ BMW rider well in


touch with the three riders ahead of him in the title chase coming into this weekend.

"It was great to do the double at Knockhill but as far as the championship goes, they were only two wins and points towards the ultimate goal of being champion. Don't get me wrong, it was very special, but the focus is on consistency.

I just want to keep racking up the points and although we didn't manage a podium at Brands Hatch, we scored well.

"It will be crazy this weekend at Thruxton as it's always a bit of a free for all as it's so fast and grippy. No one has been there for two years, so it's anyone's guess what will happen but all I know is we'll be as strong as anyone."





Jack back in charge

ollowing a superb performance in difficult conditions at Brands Hatch last weekend, Irishman Jack Kennedy took over the lead in the Quattro Group British Supersport Championship to head the standings by 23 points.

Aboard the HEL Performance/ Bournemouth Kawasaki, the former double champion followed up a second place in the Sprint race, with a victory in the Feature race, to lead the series for the first time since he won the opening race of the season at Oulton Park.

His cause was aided by previous leader Bradley Perie not enjoying the best of weekends in the changeable conditions at the Kent track. The Appleyard Macadam Yamaha had won three races on the bounce going into Brands Hatch, but crashed in the Sprint race and could only manage eighth in the Feature



race, meaning he needs to regain lost ground this weekend.


Ashcourt Racing's Lee Johnston occupies third in the title race just 17 points behind Perie as he continued his consistent start to the season by scoring in every round. Ben Currie has also been racking up the points, but just has an opening race podium to his credit aboard his Gearlink Kawasaki.

The only rider other than Perie or Kennedy to win a race is Spanish-

based Yorkshireman Kyle Smith who romped to victory aboard his Dynavolt Triumph last weekend. adding another podium to thrust himself back into contention. Eunan McGlinchey got a double podium at the last round to move the Gearlink Kawasaki up to sixth in the standings heading into this weekend.

In the GP2 Championship, local Swindon rider Charlie Nesbitt has stolen a march on the opposition after six races following his four wins and two second places aboard the RS Racing/Kovaro Projects Kalex. He holds a 26-point advantage over defending champion Mason Law (Spirit Motocorsa) who matched Nesbitt's results at Brands Hatch. Third is JJ Racing Harris rider Jack Scott who will be looking for his first win after a string of four podiums

et to win a race this year, consistency is proving the key for Rich Energy OMG Racing's Billy McConnell who leads the Pirelli National Superstock Championship after five

The Australian followed up his third place at Oulton Park with a pair of runner-up spots at Knockhill and after finishing sixth in race one at Brands Hatch, 'Skippy' bounced back with another podium to lead by a slender three points.

Chasing him is former Superstock champion Taylor Mackenzie who won the opening two races of the season aboard the Bathams BMW. However, in the past three races he has only visited the podium once, as he looks to get back to winning ways this weekend.

Creeping up on the front two is Fraser Rogers whose new-found

confidence on the IN-Competition Aprilia is plain to see as he's scored a win and two second places in the last three races. Thruxton is Fraser's local circuit, so he'll be hoping to continue his good run this weekend.

FHO Racing BMW's Alex Olsen took an emotional victory at Brands Hatch last weekend to record Faye Ho her first win as a team owner and to somewhat erase the memories of his nasty crash at Silverstone last season. Meanwhile Luke Mossey has only finished two of the five races aboard his HEL Performance Bournemouth Kawasaki, but both were on the podium including a win at Brands Hatch a week ago.

Defending champion Chrissy Rouse goes in search of his first win of the season on his GR Motosport Kawasaki with Keith Farmer (Morello IMR by CPD Kawasaki) also a former winner in this class.

Expect the RAF Regular and Reserve Kawasaki of Lewis Rollo to be in the mix along with Tom Neave on the Honda Racing Fireblade who holds eighth in the standings. Twin brother Tim is ruled out this weekend with injury and has been replaced with Luke Stapleford on the Buildbase Suzuki.

Others to keep an eye on include Kiwis Shane Richardson (Astro-JJR BMW) and Damon Rees (Ashcourt Racing BMW), Aussie Levi Day (Powerslide AJN Steelstock Suzuki). veteran Ian Hutchinson (Edwards Yamaha) and Irishman Richard Kerr who contests the series for new team AMD Motorsport.

There's an added attraction also this weekend with the overall winner being awarded the Completely Motorbikes trophy.

Fourth placed Zak Corderoy celebrated his debut victory at Donington Park to get the Binch Yamaha's challenge back on track and to add to his Oulton Park podium, but just missed out on silverware last time out.

Completely Motorbikes Affinity Academy Kawasaki ace Eugene McManus trails Liam Delves (JR Performance Kawasaki) in fifth position by a single point, whilst the likes of Adam Hartgrove (AHR Yamaha), Team XG Kawasaki brothers Kade and Luke Verwey and Simon Reid (Reid Yamaha) are all contenders.

The winner of last season's dramatic HEL Performance British Junior Supersport title was local rider

Owen Jenner, so he'll be hoping for a good result on the Completely Motorbikes Affinity Sports Academy Kawasaki, where he is mentored by Ron and Leon Haslam along with John Laverty.

Lewis Blackstock and Paddy Rosney sit fourth in the table behind an impressive return to British Championship action by Scott Lawrie and his passenger Shelley Smithies. They were on the podium last time out, and Scott will not be afraid to keep it pinned on the fastest track in the calendar.

Veteran John Holden (Barnes Racing Adolf RS) and his new passenger Jason Pitt sit fifth and will surely be in the hunt for big points. His son George, with local lad Oscar Lawrence in the hot seat, has yet to establish consistency, but that could well come this weekend.

Keen to make up lost ground are Tommy Philp/Tom Bryant who can certainly run at the pace, but a mixture of mechanical and ontrack incidents have dented their aspirations up to this point. Local ace Ben Holland and passenger Tom Christie could turn their season around this weekend too.






