





# RACECHAT

Solo and Sidecar Racing returns to Thruxton today for what will be a full National Road Race programme. There are thirteen events throughout the afternoon, including 250cc, 350cc, 500cc, Unlimited cc, Formula One, up to 1000cc Sidecars and a round of the Kenning Classic Championship, which is hotly contested, and all the machines raced in this event are of a single cylinder capacity.

One of the main attractions of the day is that the Classic Racing Motor-Cycle Club will be in attendance to parade and race machines of yesteryear, such as the Manx Nortons, AJS 7Rs, MV Agustas, and many more of the well-known bikes of the fifties and sixties. There will also be a static display of historic racing machines and included in this will be such bikes as the 125cc LCH, built and raced by Len Harfield, also a 500cc Paton, Rudge and many more.

The 250cc event will be very competitive, with local rider Barry Seward on his Armstrong giving Brendan McKenna on his TZ Yamaha stiff opposition. Local rider Trevor Nation on his Duffield Yamaha will surely be the one to beat in the 350cc event, although with a grid containing such riders as Kieron Hunt and again Barry Seward, both on similar Yamahas, this could prove to be a real battle for first place. The 500cc proves to be as unpredictable as they come, with David Pither on the 500cc RG Suzuki, favourite, being pushed hard by a field of riders that includes Gary Lingham and Brendan McKenna, both on Suzuki 500cc machines. Favourites for the Kenning Classic Championship, Richard Cutts and John Witt-Mann, make a welcome return to Thruxton, having raced in the same event in the past years, but are sure to be pushed hard by Tom Robinson, who has been getting some good results

in the Classic Bike Championship.

The sidecar event will be closely contended by the Yamahas, with partnerships like Terry Weedy/Alan Hosey and Richard Brigden/Martin Woods, and the Kawasaki 998cc of Derek Plummer/Roger Tomlinson.

The Unlimited event should be dominated by that long-time campaigner and local rider Bill Marks on the Ridewood Yamaha but,

with Mick Hunt on the Oxford Kawasaki, things will not be made easy for him.

The Formula One event — always a favourite with spectators — should be led by Trevor Nation, with the main opposition coming from riders Mick Hunt, Colin Aldridge, Nigel Haddon, all on Kawasakis, and Pete Hodson on the Suzuki 998cc.

#### GRAND PARADE OF HISTORIC RACING MACHINES - 12.00 p.m.

Before the commencement of racing it is with great delight that we the organisers, can offer you, the spectators, a chance to relive

the sights and sounds of yesteryear.

With us today is the Classic Racing Motor-Cycle Club to present an array of racing machinery, such as was seen on the race circuits of the fifties and sixties. Many of these machines are still being raced in Classic Club events throughout the country, as you will be able to witness this afternoon in event 5.

During the parade you will be able to hear and see such machines as the AJS 7R, the BSA DBD 34 and the Manx Norton, to mention just a few. Keep an eye open for the 344cc Aermacchi which was built by Syd Lawton from new spares and, after changing hands a few times, was restored to its present condition by F.C.L. and is presently owned and raced by Dave Varney, who incidently informs me that he is getting too old for a works ride now he has passed twenty-one. Dave says he now rides to enjoy himself and to keep alive a bike of the classic era along with many others — such is the spirit of the Classic Club — and with this we wish him all the best for the

Another one of the Classics to look out for is Gerry Brown's Manx Norton. Gerry has owned the Manx for 5 years and has raced it himself at one or two North Gloucester meetings. He actually started racing in 1949 in grass track and had his first road race at Brands Hatch in 1950 on a pre-war 500cc Vincent Comet. Gerry modestly describes himself as an also-ran during his racing days, but he once actually finished third behind John Surtees and Bob McIntyre at Aberdare. He last rode here at Thruxton in 1952 and we're very

pleased he has been able to make it here today.

Look out for the 1956 Featherbed International — built by tuner Reg Dearden, it is in clubman trim with ex Gary Hocking tanks. The present owner Tom Melia restored it from a rusting wreck to use as a sprint machine and, as you will see, now gives great credit

to its owner.

Maurice Ogier has come from Guernsey to parade and race his 125cc and 203cc MV Agustas and will, we hope, also have his 500cc

Then there's the DBD 34 1958 — originally in clubman trim but now prepared for racing, the engine, I am told, is tuned to run on 100 octane petrol and is ridden and owned by Peter Reynolds, whose son Paul also races it.

Terry Grotefeld, whose racing successes throughout this country and in the U.S.A. are too numerous to mention in this article, will be on his beautiful emerald green 1963 Aermacchi, which has one of the dry clutch motors. Terry will also be riding this machine in the Isle of Man on the Classic lap, and we all wish him well.

Well, these are just a few of the many people and machines you will see today, and I would personally like to thank all the Classic Club members for being here today. Finally, I would like to thank Barry Lawton for arranging the parade, and also the Classic Racing Club as a body for keeping alive the memories of these superb machines, as I am sure a few memories will be stirred today - a credit





THRUXTON CIRCUIT Home of the British Automobile Racing Club and second fastest racetrack in Britain. Thruxton this year celebrates its 13th year of BARC motor racing. It was reopened in 1968 by the BARC, and has since been the scene of some of Europe's best Formula 1 and 2 motor racing. The outright circuit record stands to Switzerland's Marc Surer in his Formula 2 March 812 Heidegger-BMW, in a time of 1 m 08.00s, 124.73 mph (200.73 kmh) at the Easter Monday 1981 meeting.

This year there are nine BARC meetings including Easter's third round of the European F2 Championship. There are also Motorcycle and Kart meetings and the annual MVCG War Day.

COMMENTARIES There are three commentary points on the circuit:

near the P&O Ferries bridge, at the Campbell/Cobb/Segrave complex

and from the winner's rostrum.

CATERING AND BARS With the Circuit under new caterers for 1980, racegoers can be assured of a general improvement in all facilities with new-look restaurants and increased snack and other con-cessionaires around the circuit. There are two restaurants and two bars at all meetings, plus extra bars and snack facilities. The Paddock Restaurant is open from 8.00am for breakfasts and throughout the day.
