THE WILTSHIRE SCHOOL OF FLYING LIMITED, who operate this Aerodrome, have pleasure in announcing the first system of Hire Purchase flying instruction in the United Kingdom.

FROM OUR EXPERIENCE we find that the average pupil requires seven to eight hours' dual instruction before qualifying; our "Student Pilot's Course," total cost £24, therefore, covers seven hours' flying instruction, either dual or solo flying.

IN OUR NEW SYSTEM this can be paid under any of the following instalment plans:—

- (a) £3 down and 34 instalments of 12/6—£24 5s. 0d.
- (b) £6 down and 30 instalments of 12/-—£24 0s. 0d.
- (c) £9 down and 20 instalments of 14/6—£23 10s. 0d.
- (d) £12 down and 20 instalments of 11/-—£23 0s. 0d.

THESE CHARGES include membership of the Wiltshire Flying Club during the period of the contract, which entitles you to all Club facilities, with accommodation and meals at Club rates. It also covers all ground instruction and the loan of Instructional Handbooks.

IN ORDER TO QUALIFY under this scheme, continuity is very desirable, and therefore you should attend, if possible, at least once a week for flying instruction. This, however, need not occasion you any great inconvenience as during the Summer Months flying instruction takes place until sunset seven days a week, so that you could attend here any evening after normal business hours.

ONCE YOU HAVE OBTAINED your Student Pilot's Licence and satisfied your Instructor that you are capable of cross-country flights, you will then be able to fly anywhere in the United Kingdom.

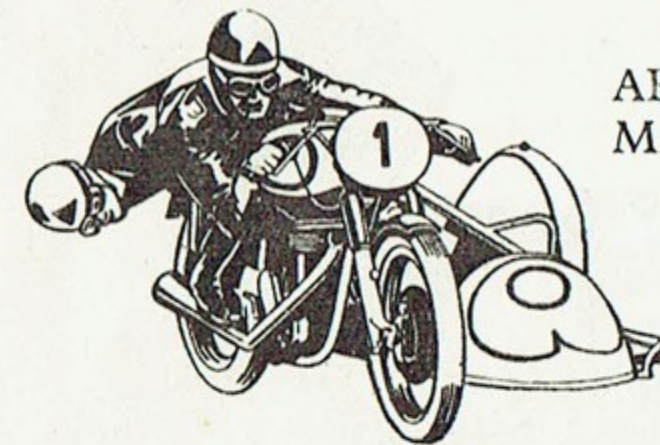

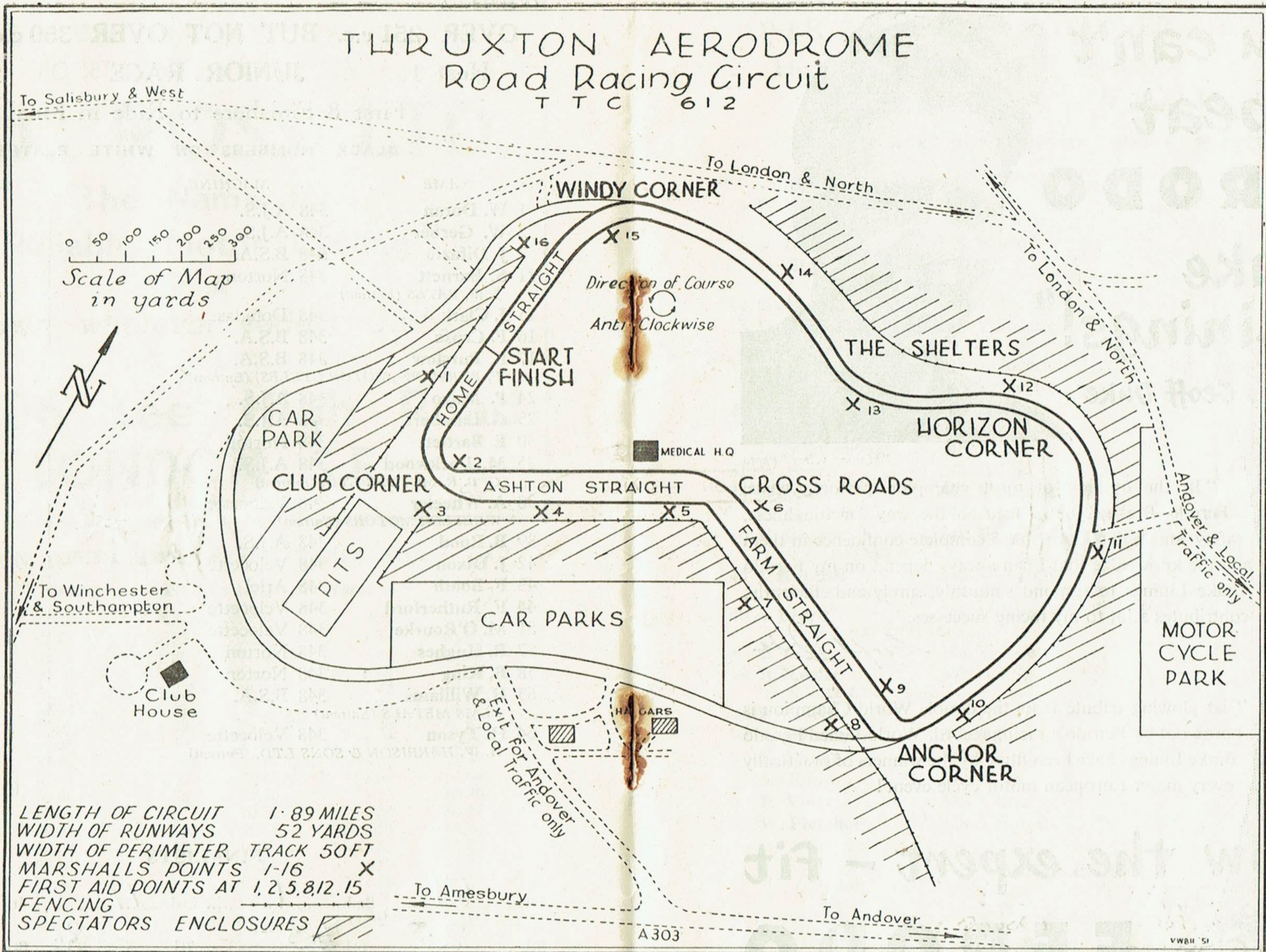

THRUXTON AERODROME Road Racing Circuit

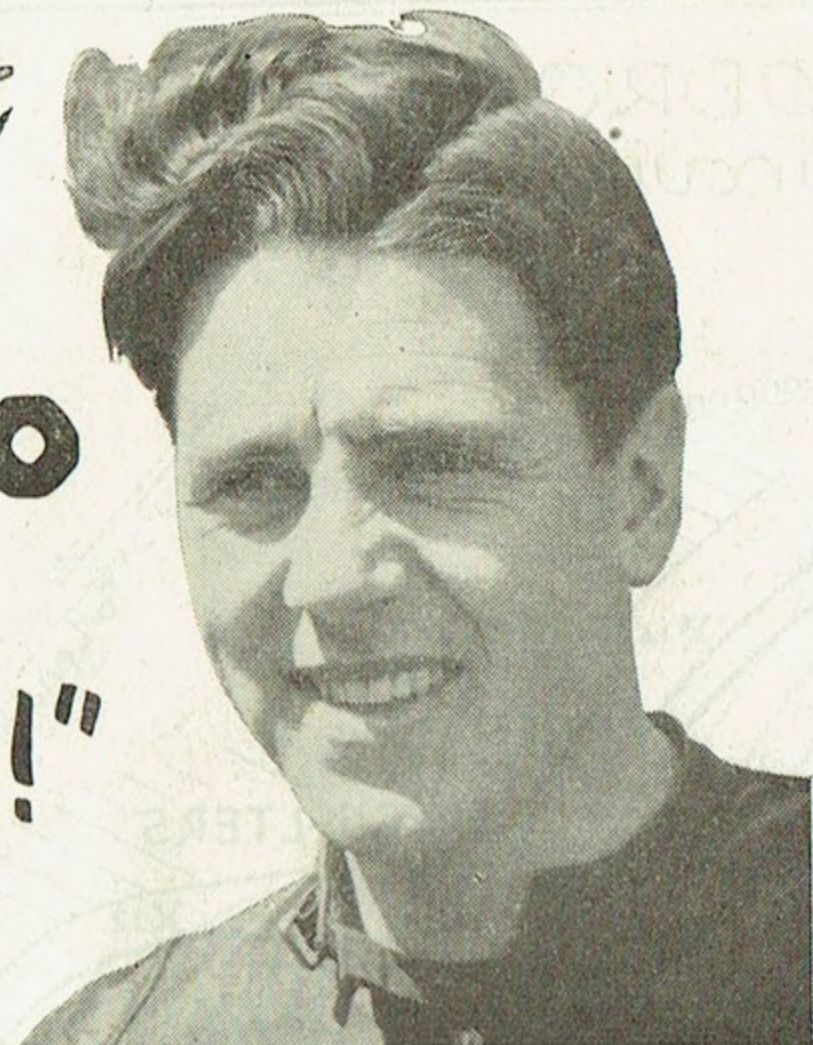

In consequence everyone is asked to observe the following plan which has been issued by the Hampshire County Police. All traffic for NEWBURY, LONDON and MIDLANDS leave by Snoddington Lane, Windy Corner and Horizon Corner Gates and follow the marked route via Fyfield, Penton, Grafton and Penton Mewsey to A343 and Newbury. All traffic for WINCHESTER and SOUTHAMPTON leave by exit to rear of Club House, cross straight over the main road and proceed via Quarley Greatley and the Wallops. If all traffic will drive round the perimeter track in the opposite direction to the course they will be able to find all exits marked with their appropriate destinations.
