# One's To Watch.....

# NG Road Racing - Thruxton - Saturday 4th October The Final Championship Round

One to Watch - Rowan Miller - No 110 Metrakit GP80XL - Formula 125



New rules by the sports governing body, the ACU were brought in a few years ago to allow riders in their early teens to start road racing in a class for up to 125cc production based machines and also for smaller purpose built bikes. Portsmouth schoolboy Rowan Miller took the chance and started road racing career this year aged just 12, pitting his 80cc Metrakit against the class favourite mount 125cc Aprilia. Although giving away a bit in the way of power, especially at the faster circuits Rowan has ridden the wheels off the little 80. He took his first race win at Snetterton aged just 12 years and 236 days, and now needs just 8 points from this final round to secure the title ..... And that will be over Sam Coventry ... who is Rowan's slightly older cousin. Now that's what you call by a family having racing in the blood!!

Let's just hope that the Rowan and the Miller Team manage to bag a benevolent sponsor during the closed season to allow the young man to fulfil his racing promise. After all the ACU brought in the lower age limit to get youngsters on race bikes to compete with the Italians and Spanish. so lets get behind our young Brits. It's not just here that his talent has been spotted, Rowan has

made it thought to the final selection stage for the prestigious Red Bull Rookies, which is great recognition for the young man, and all the work, he and the team have put in.

### Class by Class

A strong grid of 125GP machines this year sees Corey Lewis at the age of 14 on the Dave Bushby RS125 taking the title at his first attempt. He will once more have Luke Harvey and defending '07 champ Freddie Nickless for company along with Sam Burman and Ross Ashman in a bid for more race wins. The Junior Formula 125's see Rowan Miller on top, on his 80 Metrakit against a host of 125 Aprilias headed by Sam Coventry. Whilst the 400 open has Tony Davies, on his TZ250 Yamaha heads the way and is safe in the knowledge that he has won the title.

When it comes to the 600 class there are no easy race wins with possible 6 or 8 winners each weekend. Grahame Frear, Daniel Frear, Joshua Day are the men-most-likely, with the Frear brothers looking good on CBR-RR and R6 respectively. Keep an eye though for last year's top newcomer David Thomson for an upset, who rides the wheels of the unfavoured Kawasaki. The bigger Superbike Open and Powerbike classes too have a whole host of talent on the grid, Joe Symonds with Yamaha's R1, and Michael Blank on a GSXR Suzuki are the pick of the grid. However Darren Neal, Mark Compton, Lee Keeble, Paul Shook and Shaun Hennessey are all proven winners. Chris Pope too has now hit a run of good form as the season hits its climax.

Chris Beverley (CBR400), Josh Leaning and Tony Meredith (ZXR400) and Tim Bradley (FZR400) show that no one bike is able to dominate the Formula 400 class. However the same can't be said for the riders as Beverley has already taken the pressure off himself by taking the title with this round in hand. He now contemplates a change of class for '09.

James Parry on his 675 Triumph heads the Sound of Thunder class, but former champ Andy Peck is still in the hunt and in good form. Justin Waite took time to get used to the 675 but now is just looking for more wins. In the Mini Twins battle it's Darryl Alexander with his SV650 that has dominated the second half of the year after taking an unbroken string of 10 wins in a row.

Streetstocks racing for road legal machines is really strong at present with Dan Kift his CBR 1000 RR Honda on top at present, but expect to see a strong challenge from the in form Hilary Philips and Jer Thomas. The 700's see '07 runner up Andy Hayes wanting to go one better this year on his R6, but Marlon Butcher and Nicholas Andrews trying to stop him...just 3 points separate them with just this one race to go. In the 400 division though Richard Troth was having a relatively easy run of things with a string of convincing wins, but three no-scores in a row have brought Nic Pullen, Ben Marsden and Craig Neve into the reckoning.

Matt Dix and Rob Beere are definitely the pick on the sidecar crop so far in this year on their F2 600 Baker. They head both the F2 and Open classes, Ian Drowne/Gary Andrews and Rod Robinson/Shellie Smithies are their nearest challengers for glory,

As far as final rounds go this one is going to be a real cracker with championship titles still up far grabs.....don't miss it!!!

Race report - Oulton Park 20th September 2008 - Round 12

#### Local man Davis shines at Oulton

NG Road Racing's first visit to the Cheshire parkland was graced with warm autumn sunshine, and a mouth watering situation in the 250 National Championship title hunt. With 5 riders still in contention and only 50 points on offer, there was simply no room for error at the sharp end of the table.

When timed qualifying settled down it was Bedfordshire's Andrew Sawford who set the early pace on the St Neots Motorcycles Yamaha. continuing on from his previous round domination at Castle Combe. But within a couple of laps, local man Jason Davis put his 1946. Marquis Demolition TZ onto the all important pole position with a 1:44.59 lap which was enough to keep him there for the remainder of the session.

Barnsley's Mark Davies was third on another TZ supported by Signs Xtra and Somerset's Alex Kenchington – Championship leader by just 1 point from Sawford - rounded out the front row on the Dennis Trollope Yamaha. Ben Johnson, sitting third in the series and only 3 points activity of the leader could only put his Double M Racing Honda in 8th on the grid. Chesterfield's Johnson was feeling the pressure after leading the series for the majority of the year only to see it slip away following a disastrous Castle Combe points duck! Ant Hodson's Yamaha, Newath's Rich Grinling and Peterborough's Bruce Dunn -returning from injury made up the 2nd row with Johnson. The NG Cup challenge on the National runners was headed by Mike Wilson on his CLV Racing RS Honda. Wilson sat in a very respectable 12th on the grid with newly crowned Cup Champion Paul Lumb back in 16th following a difficult qualifying session on a track he was not familiar with.

The 10 lap Championship race got away in sunshine and it was Jason Davis who took the lead with fast starting Mark Davies quickly settling into second. Ben Johnson got away with the leaders from his second row slot and set about staying with the ultra fast Yamaha duo. Alex Kenchington and Andrew Sawford were well in the hunt at the end of the first lap but on lap 2 the Championship took a twist as Sawford's Yamaha crawled into pit lane and out of the race. A simple broken spade connector to one of the ignition coils being the culprit. With the race settling into a pattern, Davis and Davies fought for the lead with Jason always just in control but by no means able to relax, once Johnson and Kenchington had been dropped off the back of the two leaders they also settled into a race long battle and on lap 6 Kenchington took over the final podium slot with Ant Hodson a lonely 5th with Rich Grinling, Ben Miller Darrell Higgins and Bruce Dunn having a good battle for 6th. The luckless Miller was another victim of mechanical gremlins and retired his Yamaha from 7th position with just 2 laps remaining.

Paul Lumb struggled from his low starting position but lapped consistently to pick off his rivals and moved to 10th with a lap to go, and found himself in a real dog fight with Steve Pond, Tony Davies and Paul McCullagh on the road.

At the flag, Jason Davis won it by 2 seconds from Mark Davies with Alex Kenchington holding off the intentions of Ben Johnson in 4th. Aut Hodson secured 5th with another strong performance making him one of the most consistent scorers in the series. Rich Grinling held off Wiltshire's Darriell Higgins in 6th and 7th respectively, and then Peterborough's Bruce Dunn in 8th, Steve Pond and Tony Davies rounded out the top 10. Jason also set the fastest lap of the race almost a full second inside his pole time.

Paul McCullagh won the NG Cup battle by mugging Paul Lumb on the last lap in a determined struggle to beat his championship rival, which he has only seen the back of so far this year! McCullagh from Chippenham in Wiltshire was delighted with his 11th on the road and to have, at long last ushered his Amethys T Yamaha home ahead of the Cup Champion. Jonathan Stamper took the final step on the Cup podium in third place with his best performance of the year on the Graham File Tuning TZ. Paul McCullagh was delighted to receive the Dunlop performance of the day award for his efforts and collected his rear GP tyre courtesy of Dunlop Motorsport.

The series heads to Thruxton in Hampshire for the Championship finale on Saturday 4th October and what a superb end to the season we have in store! The point's situation is nicely poised with Kenchington leading on 152, Ben Johnson up to second on 146, Jason Davis up to 141 and Andrew Sawford still has an outside chance in 4th on 135. All 4 have 2 wins each! The ultra fast Mark Davises has promised revenge for being beaten at Oulton and will take the start and although he is out of contention for the championship, you can bet he will be up there at the end of the race upsetting the series leaders points calculations. Don't miss it – a fitting showdown to a superb Championship.

# "A below par day.... but Joe still grabs Championship Glory"

Inday test days at a circuit can prove very valuable, getting familiarised with a new circuit, setting up a new bike, or simply just getting track time. However they can also be costly. Not just in time off work and Imancially.... But more so if something goes wrong. It's the latter that happened to Michael Blank this weekend at Oulton. He had a new GSXR to test, and he wanted to get himself in fine form because he had a battle on his bands in both the *Phoenix Open* and *L & J Powerbike* championships. After a poor last round he was desperate to keep the pressure on Joe Symonds, who led both title classes, and was showing excellent end of season form.

Blank was circulating on Friday with laps comfortably in the 1min 45's pushing into the 43's when needed and was looking forward to keeping the pressure on loc. But in the final session of the day 3 riders went slown...one of them was the number 138 Gemini Fire buzuki of Blank. Now although the bike came out relatively unscathed Michael was not so lucky, with rib and hand injuries. Now we all know many riders that will race through the pain barrier and the hard as nails Blank is usually one of them, but unfortunately it was the concussion that he sustained that kept him out of the weekend's action. He sported a huge bruise on his head where he contacted tarmac.



Now usually his main rival Joe Symonds would have breathed a sigh of relief, safe in the knowledge that his main rival was out... the pressure was off... and both littles were now his, including the main NG Road Racing

overall Phoenix Open Club title. But Joe was definitely out of sorts. He said he had wanted to "...Fight for the title out on track, racing against your rivals" and felt "decidedly flat". That certainly reflected in his riding, finishing a lowly 12<sup>th</sup> in the Powerbike and amazingly some way out of the points in the Open. He said that "...it was almost like he had forgotten how to ride.... lapping 4 seconds a lap slower than he was earlier". But regardless of his mental state (....some say dubious at the best of times!!!.... only joking, Joe) both championships were won with one round still to go.



lan Mackman set the *Phoenix Open* alight with a run of sub 44 laps on his GSXR 1000 that took him to the win, but it was Phil Bevan, the outgoing NG Open Champ on the Co-Ordit R1 that had everyone on their toes as. After a poor start he set about catching the leaders. Despatching Lee Keeble, Paul Shook, Grahame Frear, John Nisill and Charlie Bishop on the way, setting lap after lap in the 43's before dipping down to a 42.40 on the last lap to finish just 1 second behind Mackman.

Bevan was in no mood to mess about in the *L & J Mechanical Powerbike* and after qualifying on the front row set off with PBM Phoenix R1 rider Charlie Bishop for company. A string of '43 eventually saw Bevan take the flag by some 7 seconds from Bishop with Paul Shook storming through in the later stages to grab third ahead of Angelo Derosa, Adrian Williams, Peter Golden and John Nisill.

James Parry is one of those riders that seems on some occasions to court bad luck, being caught up in other riders accidents, or being taken out, through no fault of his own. Even a switch from the F400 class to the Team Spidey Sound of Thunder didn't seemingly see a change of fortune early on this year with problems at Pembrey and Brands Hatch. However James on the Loki Racing 675 has kept his head down and with rides like he has produced in the second half of the year has elevated himself to the top of the table. This weekend he, along with Justin Waite on the STP 675 and Andy Peck on the Spidey Aprilia Mille conducted the Thunder final more like a bare-knuckle boxing match, with no quarter being asked, or definitely not given. Each had turns at the front...each made mistakes, but Parry eventually came out of the final turn crossing the line 0.3 second behind Peck who hit the front on the last lap, with Waite just third after making a detour at Hislops on the final lap. Unfortunately for Peck though it turned out he had been penalised a jump start and the 10 seconds dropped him down to third, handing Parry his maiden 675 victory, but more importantly a 9 point points advantage as we go into the final round.

Daryl Alexander racked up his tenth win on the bounce in the *Big C Mini Twins* on the Monk Racing and Chrysler Jeep SV650, taking the win by almost 30 seconds from Stephen Sweetman. A fine 4<sup>th</sup> sport saw Rhys Davies elevate himself to second in the series, although Alexander's 29-point lead has him in an unassailable position.



It was an all family affair in the *Refined Recruitment* 125GP event with BSB 125 rider Jay Lewis taking the win on his SL Heating RS125, but with second place going to his younger brother Corey that was enough for Corey to take the title. Ross Ashman proved that he is now back to full fitness and form after breaking his arm in two places by grabbing third spot. Jay also had to follow little brother Corey home in the Dara Brady 400

final, but a safe third place was enough for Tony Davies on his New Road Garage TZ250 to take the title.

There is another family connection in the **Steve Lynham Formula 125** as Rowan Miller and his cousin Sam Coventry fight it out for the title. It was Lee Jackson this weekend though that took top points with Coventry and Miller 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, with the championship going on to Thruxton.

Chris Beverley had a one off ride in the Race Trader UK 400 Streetstock final on his CBR400 and took the win by 5 seconds from Dan Millard. Richard Troth who was dominating the series mid season has now allowed Nic Pullen, Ben Marsden and Craig Neve back into the running after three dnf's on the trot. Neve currently in 4th could have gone straight to the top of the table but fell from the lead. Troth must be breathing a huge sigh of relief. It is a similar close affair in the 700 Metzeler/DTR Streetstock with Andy Hayes taking this weekends win on his MFL R6 to hoist himself back to championship top spot, although he, Marlon Butcher and Nick Andrews are covered by just 3 points with one race left. In the big 1300 Metzeler/DTR Streetstock Hilary Phillips kept up the pressure on series leader Dan Kift. Phillips' win on his Fox Enterprises GSXR was his fourth from five races but Kift still hangs onto a slender 4 point lead on his Protint CBR with Thruxton still to come.



Pole sitter and long time race leader Andy Whitehead looked odds on with two laps to go to take the *A* and *R* Racing Formula 400 final, but paid the price for a minor mistake as he slid off his ZXR 400. That left the way open for Anthony Van Looy to take his first win on the RAFMSA and Ace Motorcycles ZXR setting the fastest lap in the process ahead of Tony Meredith. Just a handful of points were all that was needed for Chris Beverley to take the title and he said "....not to worry if it looked like he was wobbling round like an old woman". He "wobbled" round to take 4<sup>th</sup> place and safely secured the required points on his France and Li Asia CBR



losh Day took his Trevor Robins R6 to an emphatic 8 second win over current series leader Grahame Frear in the *George White 600* final. Frear set the pace in qualifying but Day found some extra pace for the final as the early laps battle between them dragged them 13 seconds clear of Mike Edwards. David Thomson and Lan Mann had a great battle for 4<sup>th</sup> place, but they were very nearly caught by Christian Hazell in the latter stages as the Welshman who started on the back row saythed his way past 33 riders to take a fine 6<sup>th</sup> place.



No one could match the pace of Leeds pairing on Stephen Williamson and Colin Two with their Windle Suzuki as they took the *CSC Racing Open Sidecar* final from Ian Drowne and Gary Andrews by some 14 seconds. Drowne/Andrews kept their championship hopes alive as they closed the gap slightly to now be just 3 points off the series lead. Matt Dix and Shaun Barker were once more the top Century 2000 F2 outfit taking their 8<sup>th</sup> win from the 12 rounds and giving themselves an unassailable lead on the ID and C Baker 600 as they headed home the experienced Mick Robson and Ken Edwards



With still eight of the sixteen class titles still to be decided I for one cannot wait for Thruxton and the final round on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> October


