



AMCA riders do well.

The 250/750 IMBA team scored well in France on Sunday at the 5th round of the IMBA European Championships. Alex Hartley followed his 3rd overall at the Elsworth meeting two weeks ago with another 3rd at Wingles. Patrick Crump won the opening race leading from the start and was 6th in the 2nd but failed in the 3rd race which was the similiar story for him at Elsworth. He took 4th overall while Andy Watkins scored a 4th, 7th and 11th to take 7th place. Richard Du'feu having his first ride abroad did well to take 12th place finishing 6th in the second race while Gary Parker despite machine problems was 2nd in the second race to finish 11th. Aaron Crowder also scored well with a 7th, 5th and 8th place.

Hartley is now 6th with Belgian riders leading with one round to go in Germany on 27th September.

Future for Championships

Despite increasing the number of 4 Stroke rounds to 8 there was a poor turn out at the Boraston round on Sunday with about a dozen riders. Meanwhile the 750cc class next year looks uncertain as very few riders have contacted the Office to express an interest in the Qualifiers due to be held this season. In fact a decision will have to be made about the qualifying events for 1999 whether to postpone them to early next year.

Superclass

There is a clash of dates with the first round at Rugby's event at Long Buckby now clashing with a 250/750 Nations Cup event the same day 4th October 1998.

Team Events

Both the Inter Club and Inter Group team events are proving difficult to arrange due to clashes with other events including the Weymouth Beach race due on 25th October 1998.

Extra Event 27th Sept

The Warley club are willing to organise a Motocross at Boraston if any riders are interested, it clashes with the Foxhills International but for those riders who prefer to ride rather then watch they will run, clubs have the details.

Trials Modern

The Midland clubs have arranged the Winter Trials season fixtures which start on Sunday with the Wyre Forest club using the Boraston venue follwed by the Brownhills club at Hartlebury on the 13th and the Moseley club Annual Welshpool trial which includes both open and closed circuit trials with Steve Goode the organiser. Ten Championship rounds are held starting on 4th October at Bewdly and only 1998 AMCA Licence holders can score points in the Championship events.
