

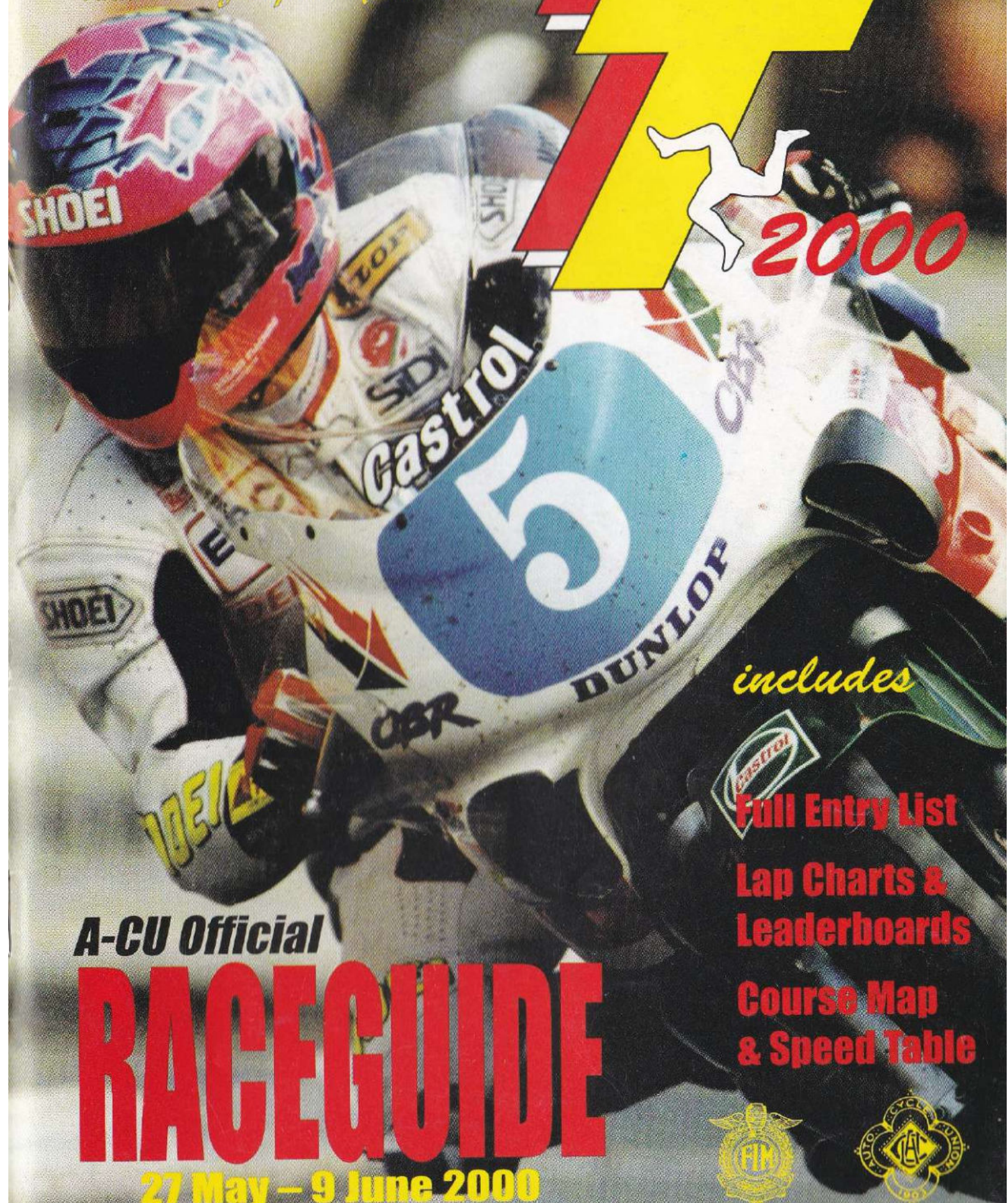

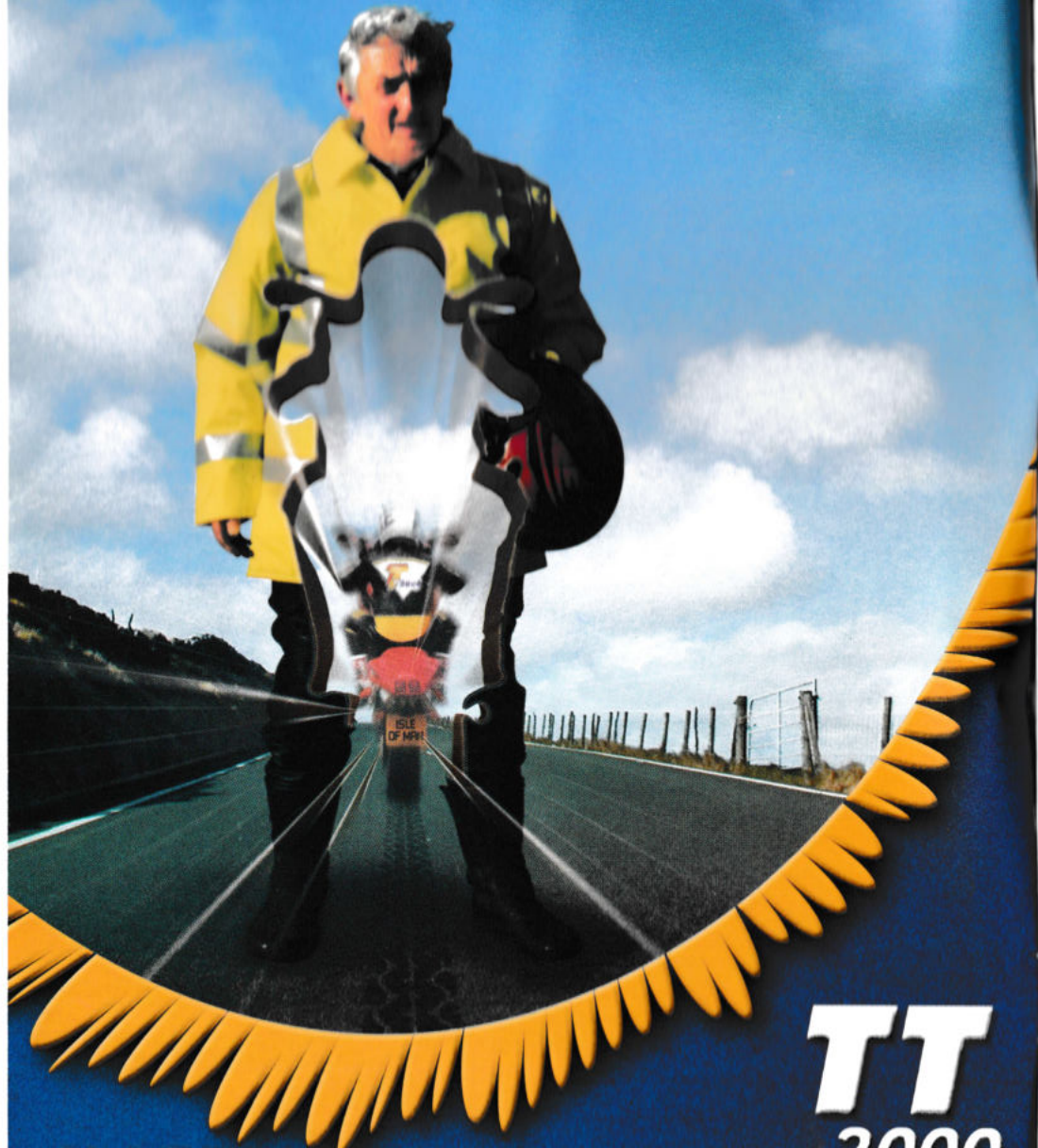

FORMER WINNERS

A TT2000 preview by

PETER KNEALE



JOEY DUNLOP: From Ballymoney. Now the most successful rider in the all time TT winners table with 23 victories, he made his first appearance in the TT in 1976 and finished 16th in the Junior and 18th in the Senior. His first victory came in the 1977 Jubilee Classic Race which he won at 108.86 mph with a lap at over 110 mph. His best placing in 1978 was fifth in the Formula 2 and the following year he took sixth place in the Senior. Victory again in 1980 in the Classic with ninth in the Senior and 12th in the Junior. It was third in the 1981 Formula 1 and second the following year. Then he began a record breaking sequence in the Formula 1 with victory in 1983, which he repeated for the next five years. In 1984 he set the then absolute lap record at 118.47 mph. He scored his first hat-trick in 1985 when he added the Junior and Senior to the Formula 1. 1986 saw him take fourth place in the Senior. In 1987 he won the Senior and finished eighth in the Junior, and the following year added the Senior and Junior to the Formula 1 for his second hat-trick. In 1989 he missed the TT due to an Easter spill at Brands Hatch. In 1990 he rode again, but was obviously not 100% fit, but finished eighth in the Formula 1, winning a silver and 16th in the Senior for a bronze. In 1991 he almost scored that elusive 14th win when he led the 125cc race for the first two laps, only to be pipped by brother Robert. He finished fifth in the Junior and sixth in the Supersport 400, and with the VFR Honda for the Senior finished second at 119.66 mph. In 1992 he got his 14th victory with a record breaking 125cc win, raising the lap record to 108.69 mph. He took third place in the Formula 1 and ninth in the Supersport 600. It was the 125 race in 1993 that gave him that historic 15th win, and he also finished third in the Junior, 11th in the Senior and 14th in the Formula 1. In 1994 he scored a double with victory in the 125cc race, for the third year in succession, and the Junior. He also took third place in the TT Formula 1 and Senior. In 1995 he took his total of victories to 19 with victory in the Lightweight and Senior races. He also finished second in the Formula 1 and fourth in the Junior. His total of wins rose to 21 in 1996 with victory in the Lightweight and 125cc races. He also finished 2nd in the Senior and 7th in the Formula 1. His

fastest lap of the course is at 123.06 mph. In 1997 he won his 22nd TT with victory in the Lightweight, he also took fifth place in the Junior, sixth in the Formula 1, seventh in the Senior and 10th in the 125cc. In 1998 he notched up victory number 23 in the Lightweight Race and finished ninth in the Ultra-Lightweight Race. Last year he finished second in the Formula 1, fifth in the Lightweight 250, Junior and Senior, and after a problematic 125cc race finished 27th but set the fastest lap of the race. This year he rides for Honda Britain in the Formula 1, Production and Senior, and has Hondas for the Junior, Lightweight 250 and 125cc races.

ROBERT DUNLOP: From Ballymoney. A winner on the TT Course at his first attempt when he won the 1983 Newcomers 350cc Manx Grand Prix, with Steve Hislop second. In the 1984 TT he finished 14th in the Senior and 12th in the Classic. His first top six placing came in 1985 when he finished sixth in the Production 250 Race. A spill ended his TT Meeting in 1986, but he was back the following year finishing fifth in the Formula 2 and sixth in the Production 250. 1988 saw him take 12th in the Senior, 13th in the Formula 1 and 16th in the Production 1300. In 1989 he scored his first TT win in the 125cc class with a new lap record at 103.02 mph. He also rode brilliantly on a RC30 Honda in the Senior to take fourth place and seventh place in the Formula 1. In 1990 he repeated his success in the 125 race at a new record speed of 103.41 mph and a new lap record at 104.09 mph. He rode JPS Nortons in the Formula 1 and Senior races, taking third place in the former, but retired on lap five at Kirk Michael when in fifth place in the Senior. In 1991 he scored a double victory, taking the 125cc race for the third year in succession at a record 103.68 mph with a new lap record at 106.71 mph and won the Junior TT at 114.89 mph. A damaged collarbone in a spill at Donington just prior to the TT made it difficult for him to ride the Norton in the Formula 1 and Senior races and he retired from both. In 1992 he finished second in the 125, and third in the Junior and Senior and in 1993 he finished second in the 125 and 10th in the Junior. In 1994 an accident at Ballaugh in the Formula 1 ended his week

and he was unable to race in 1995 and 1996. His lap at 121.53 mph makes him the 13th fastest rider ever. He made a popular return in 1997 on a Honda in the 125cc race and took a fine third place at 107.14 mph. In 1998 he won the Ultra-Lightweight race, and last year finished fifth. This year he rides a Honda in the Ultra-Lightweight.

IAIN DUFFUS: From Glenrothes. A regular TT competitor who achieved his ambition in 1994 with his first TT victory. Looking at his record over the past five years, we see he finished 16th in the 1990 Supersport 400 and 14th in the Senior. His success in 1991 was a 10th place in the Formula One, but 1992 saw him score four top ten places - fifth in the Supersport 400, seventh in the Senior, ninth in the Formula One and 10th in the Supersport 600. He came close to winning in 1993 when he finished second in the Supersport 400 and added eighth place in the Supersport 600 and 17th in the Formula One. His 1994 win came in the Supersport 600. Race at a record 115.30 mph and he also took fifth place in the Formula One. In 1995 he won the Junior 600 at a record 116.58 mph and set a new lap record at 117.87 mph - he also took second place in the Senior on a 955 Ducati. In 1996 he finished second in the Production and Junior Races and fourth in the Formula One. He missed 1997 and 1998 due to injury. Last year he finished second in the Senior and third in the Formula One and Junior Races. He retired on the last lap of the Production Race when leading, but set a new lap record at 121.32 mph. His fastest lap of the course is at 123.87 mph. This year he rides for Honda Britain in the Formula One, Senior, Production and Junior Races.

DAVID JEFFERIES: From Baildon. Made his TT debut in 1996 and took the Newcomers Award for 10th in the Production Race and 16th in the Senior and Junior. After missing the 1997 Meeting due to injury he was back in 1998 to take fourth in the Senior and Production Races and 11th in the Formula 1. Last year he joined the elite band of riders to win three races in a week with victories in the Formula 1, Senior and Production Races and he also finished second in the Junior. He has lapped the course at 123.69 mph. This year he rides Yamahas in the Formula 1, Senior, Junior and Production Races.

IAN LOUGHER: From Rhoose. Made his TT Course debut in 1983 in the Manx Grand Prix Newcomers Races and finished third in the 350cc Class. Turning to the TT in 1984 he finished second in the Historic 500cc Race on a Matchless and took seventh place in the Production 250 Race. In 1985 he took 12th place in the Formula 2 and 11th place the following year. For 1987 his results were 10th in the Formula 2 and 15th in Production "D". In 1989 he took second place in the 125cc Race, 15.8

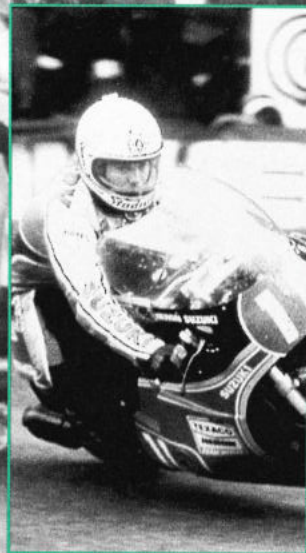
seconds down on the winner. In 1990 he shattered the record books in the Junior in his titanic battle with Steve Hislop. He won by 1.8 seconds at 115.16 mph with a new lap record at 117.80 mph. In 1991 he retired on the second lap of the Junior when holding fifth place, but took ninth place in the Supersport 400. In 1992 he finished 12th in the Formula 1, seventh in the 125, 14th in the Supersport 600 and 15th in the Senior, and in 1993 took 12th place in the Junior and 24th in the Senior. In 1994 he finished fifth in the Junior and in 1995 he finished 10th. In 1996 he won the 750cc Class of the Production Race, finished fourth in the 125cc, 11th in the Junior and Lightweight and 19th in the Formula 1. In 1997 he set a new lap record in the 125cc Race at 109.25 mph on his way to victory and he finished second in the Lightweight Race. In 1998 he took second place in the 125cc Race. Last year he won the Ultra-Lightweight Race, finished third in the Senior, fifth in the Formula 1 and 11th in the Junior. He has lapped the Course at 122.93 mph. This year he rides Yamahas in the Formula 1 and Senior, and Hondas in both Lightweight Races.

JIM MOODIE: From Hamilton. Seven times a winner at the TT - the 1993 Supersport 600 and 400 Races, the 1994 Supersport 400 and Singles Races and in 1996 he won the Singles TT again. He also took second place in the Lightweight, sixth in the Formula One, seventh in the Junior, 13th in the Production and was holding second place in the Senior until retiring on lap five. In 1997 he took second place in the Senior, 10th in the Production and 11th in the Junior. In 1998 he made history when he became the first rider to lap at 120 mph plus in winning the Production Race. He also took second place in the Singles Race and sixth in the Junior. He was holding third place in the Senior but retired on the fourth lap. Last year he won the Junior, and set the absolute lap record in the Senior at 124.45 mph before retiring. This year he rides for Honda Britain in the Formula One, Senior, Junior and Production Races.

JOHN MCGUINNESS: From Heysham. Made his debut in the TT Races in 1996 and with 15th place in the Junior won a bronze replica and took the Newcomers Award. In 1997 he finished third in the Lightweight Race and set the fastest lap of the race at 116.83 mph. He also took 12th place in the Ultra-Lightweight Race. In 1998 he finished third in the Lightweight Race and was holding seventh place in the Senior when he retired on the last lap. Last year he won the Lightweight 250 Race, setting new lap and race records. This year he rides a 500 Honda in the Formula One and Senior, a Vimto Honda in the Lightweight 250 and a Chrysalis AMDM in the Singles Race. He has lapped at 121.15 mph.
