HOW TO FIND THE GLIDING CLUB:

(Coming from London direction) **Exit the M20 at Junction 8 (which is also the Junction for Maidstone Services).**

Turn right over the motorway, then turn left at the A20 roundabout towards Harrietsham and Lenham – *beware of the Speed Cameras in both Harrietsham and Lenham.*

After 8½ miles (from M20), turn LEFT at a roundabout onto the A252 towards Challock.

After 2½ miles, (i.e. well before Challock village) turn sharp RIGHT, signposted GLIDING CLUB.

After half a mile turn into the Gliding Club – follow orange arrows for parking area within the Club's ground.

WELCOME!

Here we go again for the fourth running of our "Timber Woods Long Distance Trial" – the second starting from the Kent Gliding Club at Challock. The route is more or less the reverse of the *planned* one of last year, but we are using the bit we had to cut out when we found it would have been too long to ride in one day! To compensate, we have omitted the bit to the west of Challock – which we have used in all three previous events.

As well as Byways, you will be riding on some "Roads used as Public Paths" (RuPPs), and if those in authority have their way, it will be for the last time. Proposals are already underway to reclassify all RuPPs as "Restricted Byways" – the restriction being to all motor vehicles.

Last year I had some 'complaints' before the trial from local residents who did not want us to use *their* byways. We had one complaint during the event about mud on a road, and one afterwards asking what we were going to do about "the two foot six deep ruts on a footpath through the woods". My letter in reply to the complainant must have been OK as I did not hear anything further.

There were no comments about any riders, which meant that everyone was on their best behaviour, for which I was very grateful. Please, please keep this up and there will probably be another "Timber Woods" next year. If you see a rider doing anything silly – speed, wheelies, noise, etc., you **MUST** tell them to stop it immediately. Then tell me their riding or Reg. number and they will not be accepted again.

You will see that some of the names in the riders list are in **bold** print. These 24 have either ridden in all four trials or ridden in some and have officiated in others. We'll give a special prize in some future year to the last person to be in **bold**!

Have a good and safe day – see you back at the Gliding Club, and then at the brand new Long Distance Trial run by the OWLS Club on 17th August. Have you entered yet.....?
