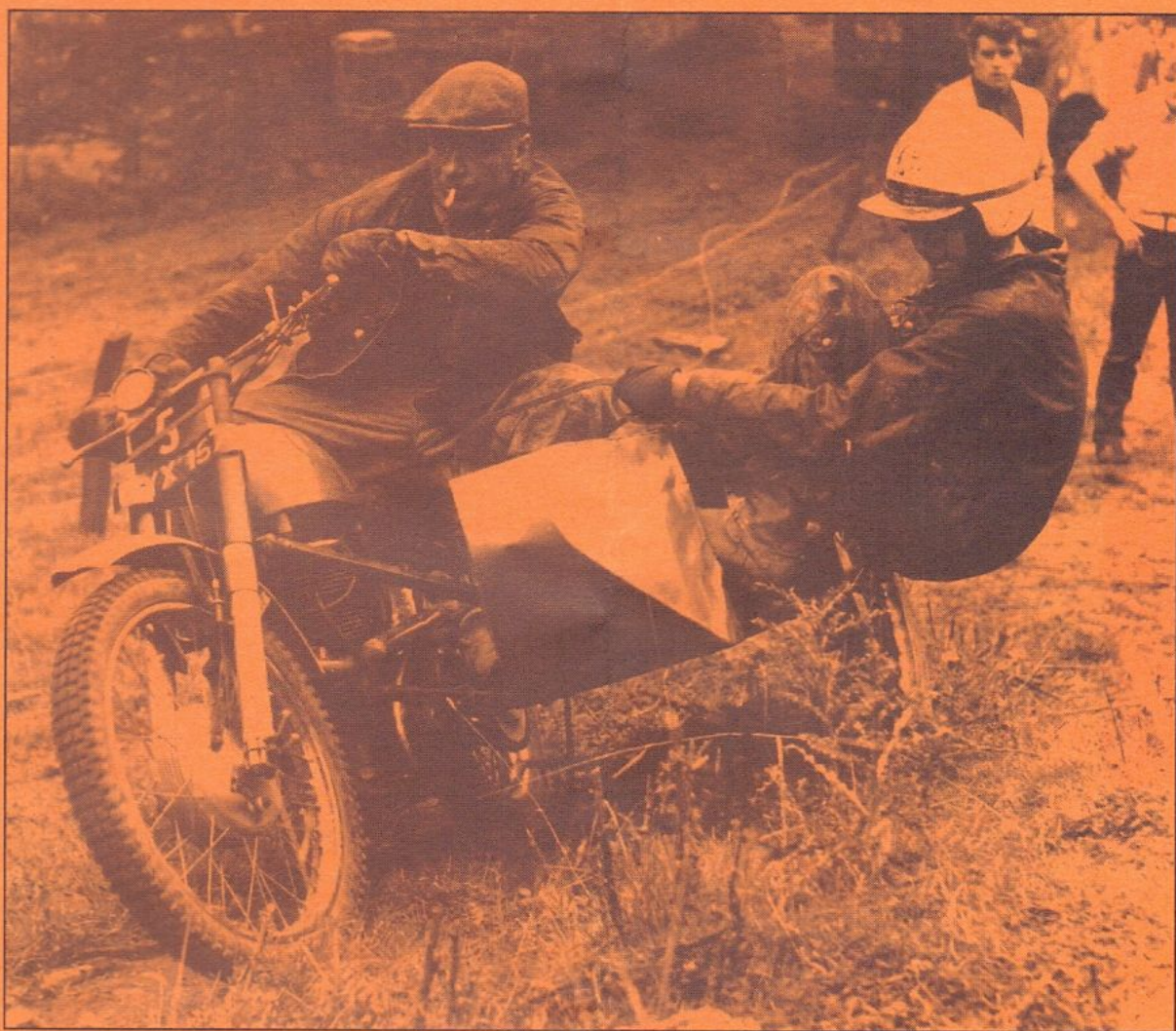

Start / Finish at Canada Heights International Motocross Circuit
Button Street, Swanley, Kent.
OS Map Reference TQ537689

HOW TO FIND CANADA HEIGHTS:

From the M25 (from north & QE2 Bridge) Leave the M25 at Junction 3, signposted Swanley (i.e. the SECOND slip road).

From the M25 (from south) Leave the M25 at Junction 3, signposted Swanley.

From the M20 (from Kent) Leave the M20 at Junction 1, signposted Swanley and M25 South (i.e. slip road off the slip road!).

From the M20 (from London) Leave the A20 on the slip road towards the M25.

THEN FROM EACH OF THE ABOVE:

Leave the traffic-light roundabout on the A20 towards Brands Hatch.

(NOT the M20 or you will have an 18 mile trip to get back!)

Straight on at the Teardrop Centre roundabout.

Next left into Button Street, signposted 'Swanley Village'.

PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY down the narrow second half of this road – there are blind bends. Canada Heights is on the right, before the M25 'tunnel'.

WELCOME!

After two years of starting from Challock, near Ashford, it's back to Canada Heights for 2004. It makes life easier for organisation and we can have two sections and the Special Test there without any problems. However, a look at the excellent Ordnance Survey 'Explorer' maps reveal very few byways in any other direction than south east – the Pilgrims Way and all that.

Between last year's Timber Woods and this, there have been two OWLS Club LD Trials, with one in the April 2004 in roughly the same area as this one. I tried to avoid as much as I could, but have had to duplicate some of their route, but not necessarily in the same direction.

I have avoided the blast up the A20 that we had in 2000 and 2001, and the total length is a bit shorter, so the overall time should be around the same. However, there won't be any time for leisurely pub lunches or even picnics beside the byway.

This year the Kent Council Rights of Way Department have asked us to avoid some 'sensitive' areas. We have done so in most cases, but there are still some included on the route. If the Roadbook says "**QUIET**" and "**SLOW**" we mean it. You must pootle past in a high gear with next to no throttle. You must be on your best behaviour and if residents or walkers express their displeasure to you, please be polite and don't retaliate.

The number of names in **bold** print in the programme is down to eighteen. These are riders who have taken part in all five Timber Woods Trials and there will be an award some time in the future to the last **bold** name. This assumes there are still some Byways we are allowed to use, of course!

Have a good and safe day – see you back at Canada Heights.

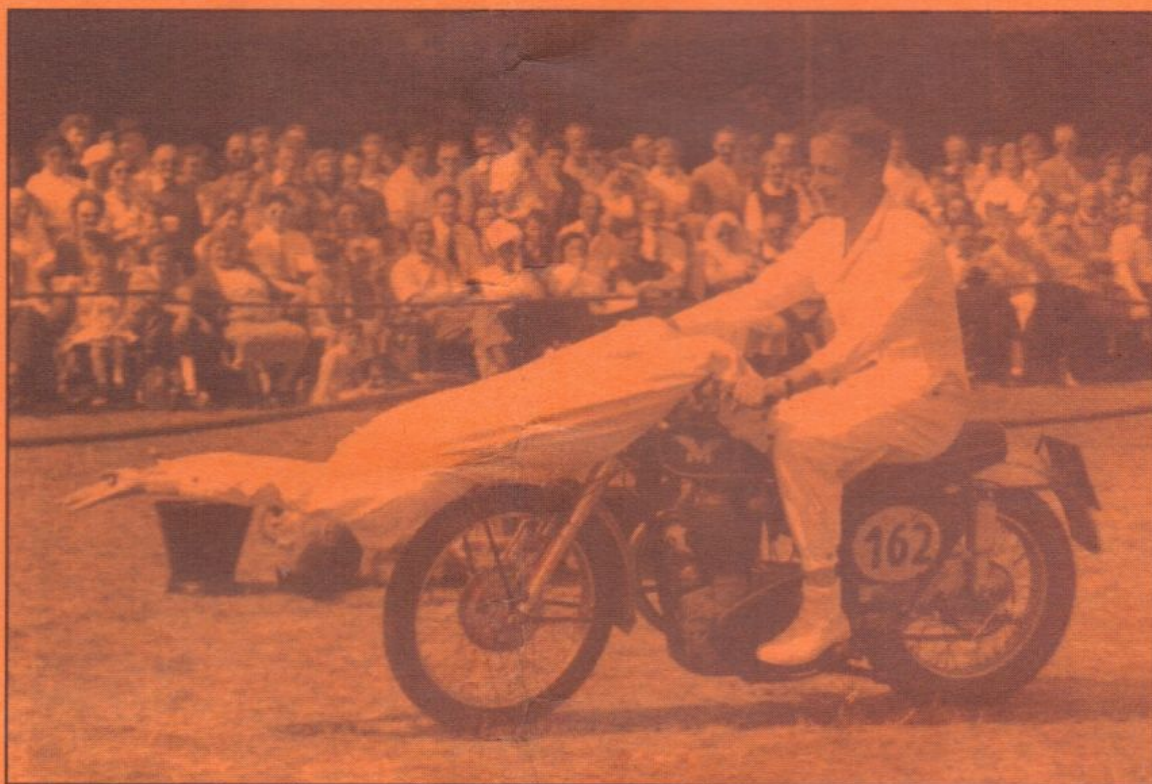
