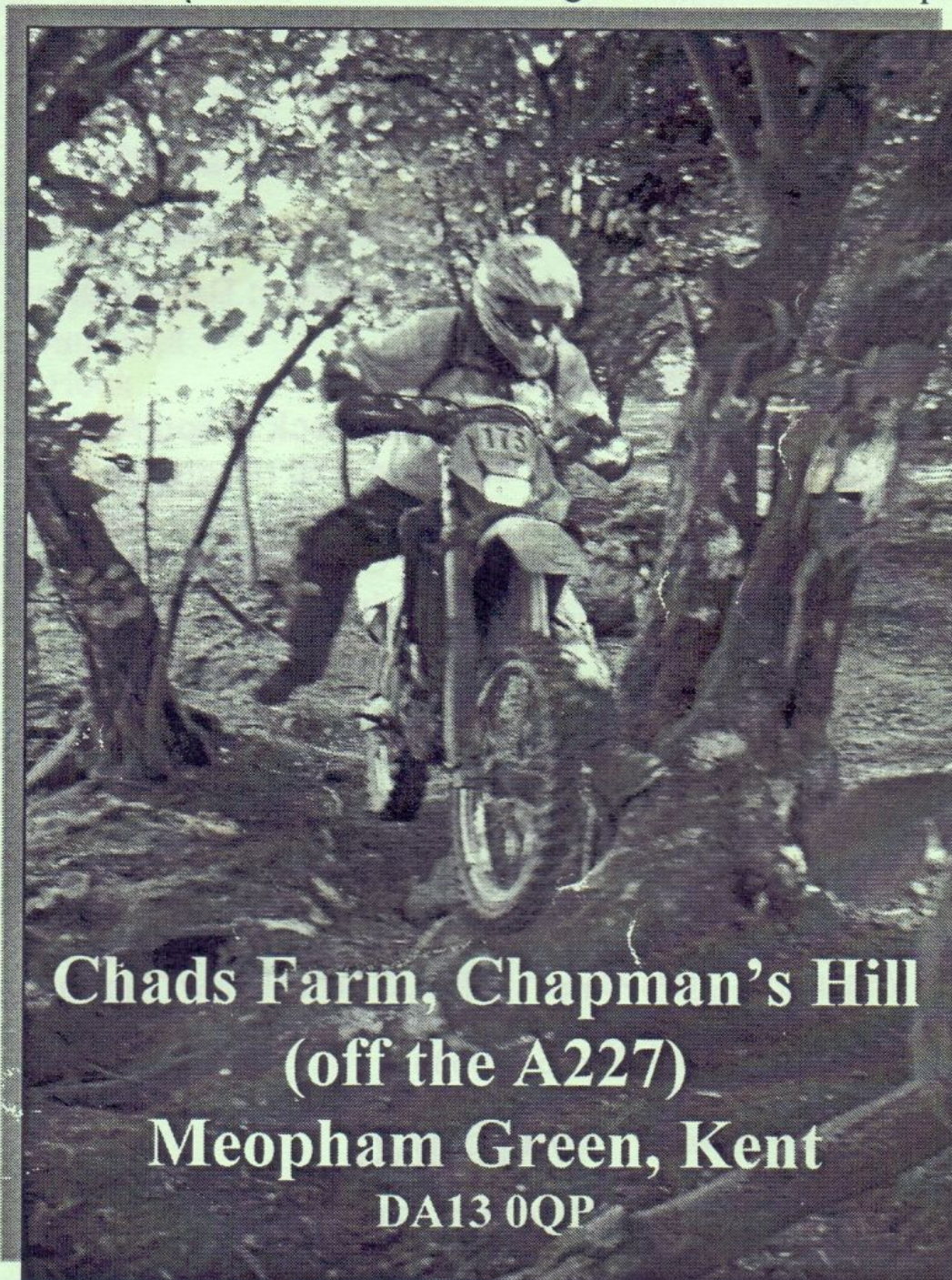

Directions to the start: Postcode for SatNavs: DA13 0QP

From the M25 Swanley Junction:

- Take the **M20** towards Maidstone.
- After Leave the **M20** at Junction 2 (Paddock Wood A20).
- At the roundabout, bear right onto the **A20** (Paddock Wood A20).
- After 0.9 miles at the roundabout, turn **LEFT** onto the **A227**
(signed for Gravesend, Meopham, Vigo).
- Continue on the **A227** for 3.2 miles (passing Esso garage on the left after 2.8 miles), then turn **LEFT** into **CHAPMAN'S HILL** – just before '40' signs.

GO SLOWLY – it is a **VERY NARROW ROAD** with house entrances and blind bends.

- After 0.3 miles, turn **RIGHT** into field.

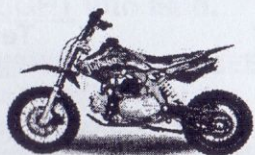

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Arrive at the start with sufficient time for signing on, scrutineering and affixing your Road Book sheets.

Scrutineering will be from 8:00am. You may be asked to start your engine and any bikes with what we decide is an excessively noisy exhaust will not be allowed to start the event.

Please do not have competition numbers on your bike – it gives the locals the impression that the trial is a race. You will be given a trials number card to stick on your front number plate.

Sign on before you start when you will be given a Road Book. This will be eleven A4 sheets and uses the 'box diagram' system showing junctions with Direction Posts (DP) and kilometres and miles from one junction to the next.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT INSURANCE: Almost all insurance policies have the exclusion "...racing, pace making, speed testing, rallies, COMPETITIONS and TRIALS" That means you have no Road Traffic Act insurance during this trial. The ACU offers a one-day RTA cover, and if all riders in an event take this out, it is £5 per rider. We included the £5 in your entry fee, so all you have to do is sign the form at signing-on and you are covered.

TOILETS and REFRESHMENTS will be available at the start/finish before, during and after the event.

PETROL ON THE ROUTE: The road book will indicate filling stations on the route and those just off the route.

All observers have mobile phones and can contact the start for you. The Secretary of Meeting will be at the start/finish all day. Her mobile number is **07703 725478**.

TEAMS: To enter a team of 3 riders for the Team Award is free. More team entries will be accepted up to 9:00am on the day.

START TIMES: To keep the start area orderly, there is a 5 point penalty for any riders who start more than 5 minutes later than their programmed time.

TYRES: Any Road Legal tyres will be OK..

FINISH To be classified as a finisher, you must sign off at the end of the event.

SPECIAL TEST Ties will be decided by a Special Test. This is on private land at the finish and clearly marked when you are there.

SECTIONS These will open and close at times shown on the Roadbook.

We will ensure the section markers are large and clear.

Inspection of sections on foot is not allowed. 10 marks if you do!

Marking will be as ACU Trials Standing Rule 22(b), which is:

Clean	0 marks
Footing once	1 mark
Footing twice	2 marks
Footing more than twice	3 marks
Failure	5 marks
Personal request not to attempt a Section	5 marks
Not attempting a Section when called upon to do so by an Official	10 marks
Missing a Section for any reason	10 marks

Section markers are **RED** on the **RIGHT**, **BLUE** on the **LEFT**. You must ride between these markers that define section boundaries.

REGISTRATION NUMBERS Please ensure your Reg. Number is legal before the start and clean it before leaving byways for more normal roads.

ROUTE MARKING: Orange enduro arrows with the Road Book box number will be put up at a few places to emphasise the route. Otherwise, it's down to you to follow the Road Book directions.

EXCLUSION Any riders noted as riding dangerously or with excessive speed or noise will be immediately excluded. *Any such riders will not be accepted at any future Sidcup L.D. Trial, Enduro or Cross Country, and other clubs will be asked to reject their entries.*

Any rider who is accompanied by rider(s) who are not taking part in the event will be excluded.

Any breach of the ACU Sporting Code, MSA Rules, Supplementary Regulations or Final Instructions may result in exclusion.

Unlike some other LDT organisers, we do not ask for roadbooks back at the end. Feel free to ride the route again, but for Bredhurst Wood you **must** apply to Kent Council for a Permit (it's free). Go to www.kent.gov.uk, then Search for "Bredhurst KH94" for info and the permit form (KH94 is the byway number).

Have a good and safe ride, and see you back at Chads Farm.

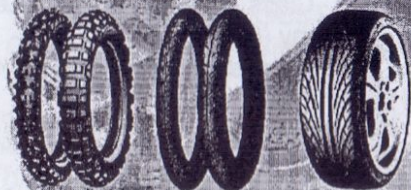
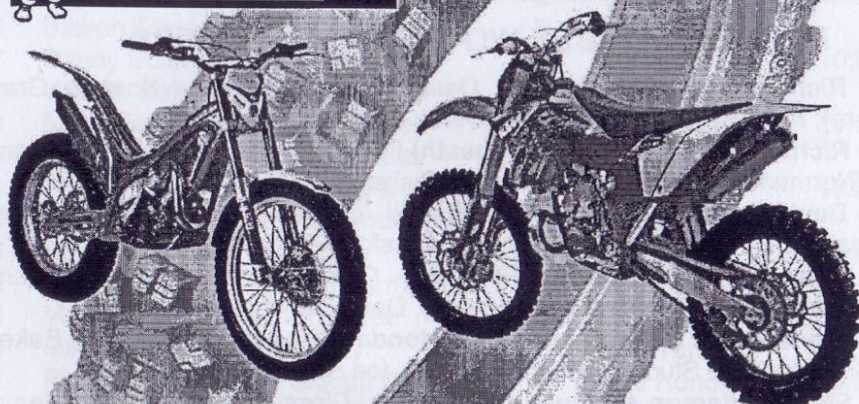
