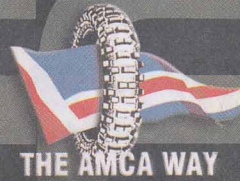

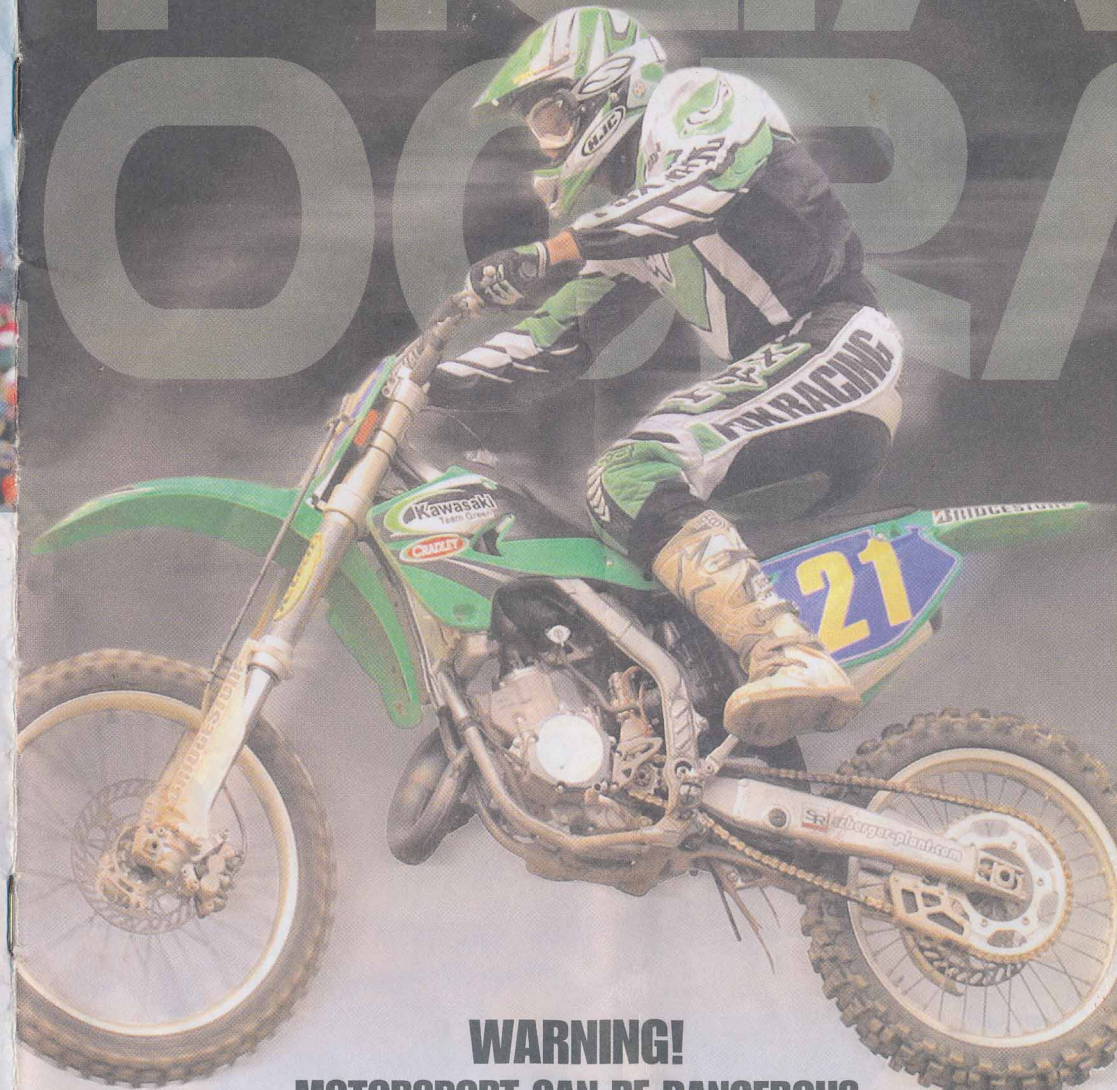

#### 125cc

Rick Du'Feu (DK Off Road Honda) fresh from his recent 125cc IMBA European Championship triumph currently heads the 125cc Championship on 297 points ahead of Brad O'Leary (Excel Honda) on 289. The two have had some awesome battles this year and will no doubt be banging bars again in the chase for the title. Jamie Powell (Yamaha) sits in third on 237 and is waiting to pounce should Du'Feu and O'Leary make a mistake. James Lane has been having an excellent season and is currently fourth ahead of Lee Dunham and David Harrison.
